Assembly Instruction

Friendly Reminders

- * Please keep children away from assembly area!
- * During assembly, place the empty carton beneath the casting parts to protect the finish from damage.
- * **HOUSEHOLD TOOLS REQUIRED: Adjustable wrench and Philips screwdriver.**
- * Do not over-tighten! Aluminum is a soft metal, insert bolts carefully and do not over-tighten.

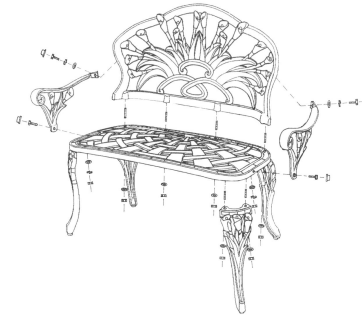
STEP 1

Insert 2 Short Steel Slotted Set Screws into the threaded receptacles on each legs and tighten with screwdriver. Attached 4 legs to seat, tighten with washer and nuts. * **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN!**

STEP 2

Insert 4 Long Steel Slotted Set Screws into the threaded receptacles and tighten with screwdriver. Attach Bench Back onto the Bench Seat using 4 sets Washers and Nuts. Tighten loosely with adjustable wrench.

* **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN! ARMS MUST BE ATTACHED WITH SLIGHTLY LOOSE BACK.**



STEP 3

Attach Bench Arms onto both sides of Seat and Back. Using Stainless Steel Long Bolts, Washers , Nuts , and Spring Washers for the front. Using Stainless Steel Short Bolts, washer and Spring Washers for the Back. Tighten with screwdriver and adjustable wrench. Cover 4 exposed bolts ends with the Safety Cap.

STEP 4

Make sure the bench stands level and straight (90° to floor) and **tighten each Bolt slightly at a time**, rotate for several times until all bolts are tightened.

CARE AND CLEANING:

- 1) This high quality furniture is made with an old world, traditional handcrafted look. The variations in color shading are characteristic of the single item production technique and are not to be considered a defect. Likewise, slight pinholes will be present in the metal castings that are customary to handcrafted original iron work. These irregularities enhance the individuality of this furniture and are not to be considered defects.
- 2) Should the powder coated finish get scratched down to the metal surface, it is recommended to cover the scratched area with enamel paint
- 3) Over time, fasteners may loosen. It is recommended that you periodically check and tighten fasteners.
- 4) Clean the furniture with soft bristle brush and rinse with water. Apply mild soap when it is needed.
* **Do not use any abrasive cleaning product to clean**
