
Assembly Instructions

We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws.











Step 1

Put the pieces on a soft flat flat surface e.g. a carpet to avoid scratching or bumping. Insert part Ax4 Into the assembly holes of part 1 (the table top).



Step 2


Insert the metal rods (part 3) into the table leg (part 2) as shown. Pay attention to the direction of the rods so that the base feet are facing downwards.



Step 3

Insert part 2/3 onto the table top using the parts shown. Please note DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS. Keep these screws slightly loose so the table angle can be adjusted and fixed once assembly Is complete.

Then use fixing K to cover the holes on the table legs (part 2) as shown



Step 4

Attach the table base (part 4) to the table legs using fixings G,E,C,F. Use fixing J to cover the holes on the table Base (part 4).

Step 5

Tighten all screws/bolts fully and then turn the table over using two people. Assembly is now complete
