

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully and save these instructions, as you may need them at a later date.

### CAUTION

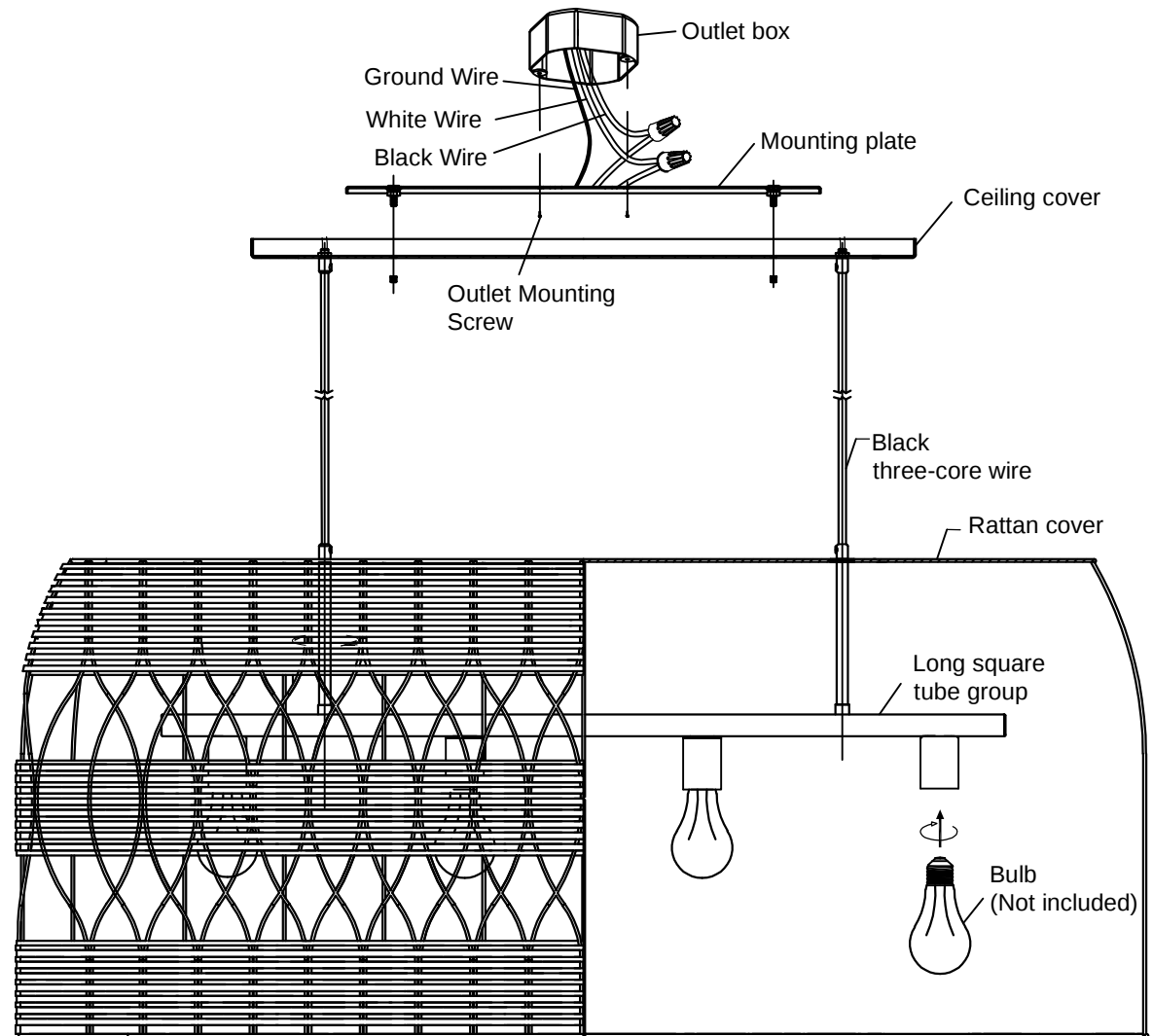
**WARNING:** Risk of Fire. Min 90°C supply conductors. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor. Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

### GENERAL

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.

1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and remove existing fixture, including the mounting hardware.
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Be careful not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
3. Now connect the electrical wires as follows: Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black house (hot) wire. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white (neutral) house wire. Make sure all wire nuts are secured. You may wrap the connections with electrical tape. If your outlet has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect fixture ground wire directly to the mounting plate using the green screw provided. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the outlet box.
4. Install the mounting plate onto the outlet box by strap mounting screw.
5. Install the bulb (not included). Please follow the wattage label located on the fixture body. Do not exceed the recommended wattage.
