2.2m Premium LED Square Parasol



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⚠ SAFETY AND CARE ADVICE ⚠

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

• **Warning:** This unit weighs approximately 6.5 kgs. Please lift with care.

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2 .

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.

• Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

• From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal center.

Note: If required the next page can be cut out and used as reference throughout the assembly. Keep this page with these instructions for future reference.

• We strongly recommend that you store your parasol when not in use, especially during winter months.

We do not recommend leaving your parasol out in poor weather or unattended in furniture when a gust of wind could cause damage.

You should ensure your parasol is clean and dry to prevent any mould or mildew forming when folded and stored.

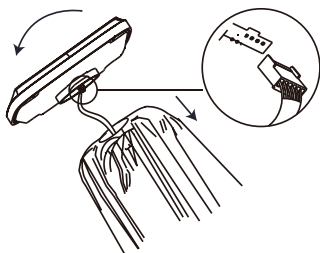


Solar Panel

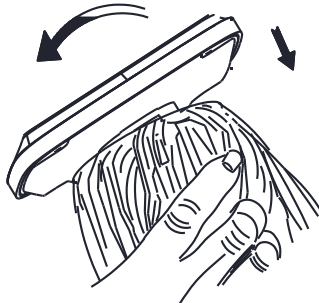


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

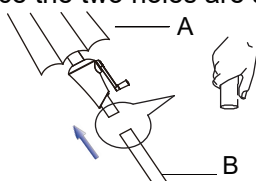
- Step 1** Locate the plug at the top of the umbrella. Carefully insert the plug into the socket located on the underside of the solar panel.



- Step 2** Place the solar panel on the top of the umbrella taking care to conceal the wires inside the gap at the top of the umbrella, then gently turn the solar panel in a clockwise direction to attach it to the umbrella. Take care not to over tighten as this may damage the umbrella and/or the solar panel.
Once the assembly is complete, remove the protective plastic film on the solar panel, this film is used to prevent damage during shipment.



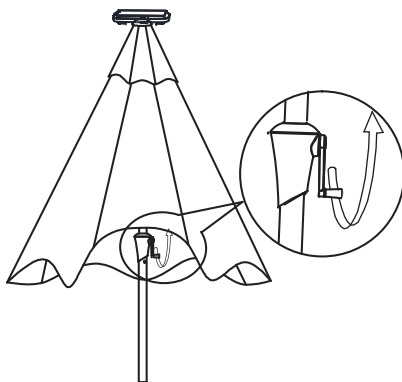
- Step 3** Insert the lower pole into the stem of the umbrella frame. Press the spring clip in whilst aligning the two holes, release the spring clip once the two holes are aligned.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1** To open the umbrella, unfasten the storage straps and gently pull out each of the umbrella ribs by hand, at the same time wind the crank handle in a clockwise direction.

CAUTION: Take care not to wind the crank in a counter clockwise direction to open as damage may occur.



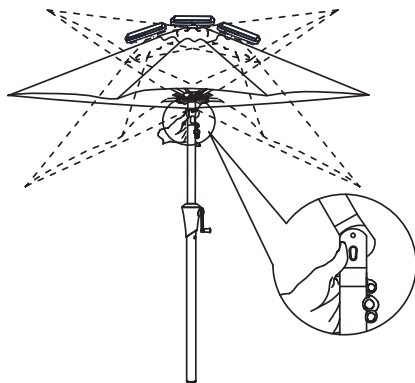
- Step 2** Continue to wind the crank handle until the umbrella canopy is fully open and taut. Take care as overwinding may damage the umbrella.



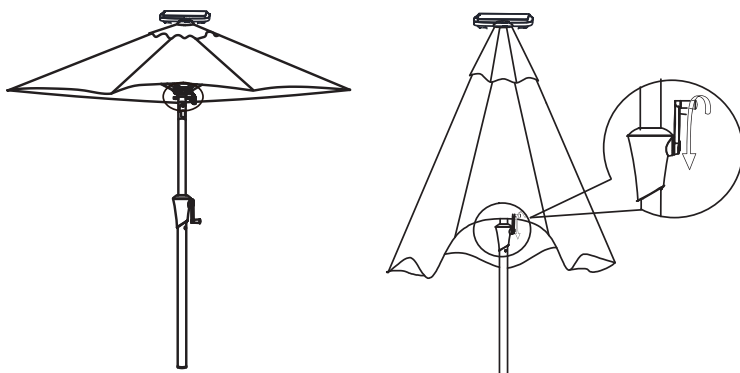
OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 3** To tilt the canopy push the tilt button with one hand gently allow the canopy to tilt with the other hand. Release the button to lock in the position.

CAUTION: The tilt option should only be used on days with no wind, use of the tilt function in even a light breeze is not recommended.

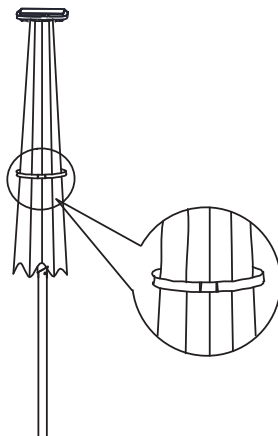


- Step 4** To close the umbrella, make sure the canopy is horizontal (never close the umbrella in the tilted position). Wind the crank handle in a counter clockwise direction until the canopy is fully closed.

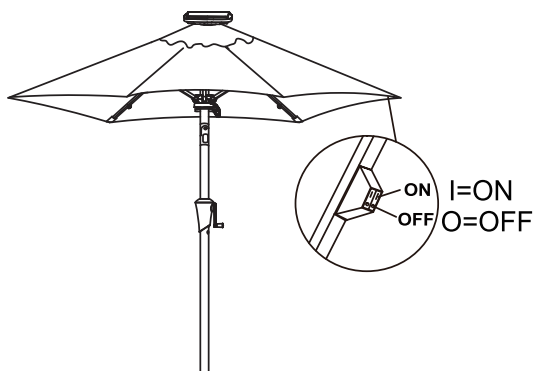
Step 5 Use the velcro ties to secure the umbrella when not in use.



OPERATING THE LIGHTS

To operate the lights, turn the switches (located on the end of one rib) to the ON 'I' position. Ensure the switches are in the OFF 'O' position when not using the lights.

CAUTION: If the lights are left on during the day the batteries will NOT charge.

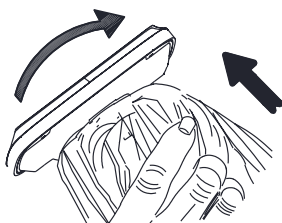


REPLACING THE BATTERY

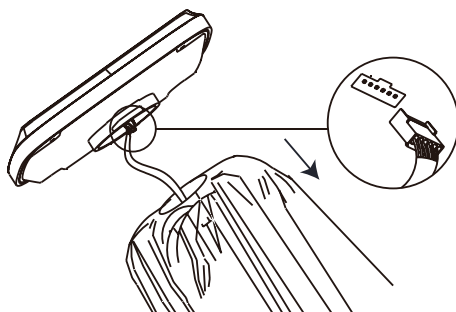
We recommend that you replace the batteries in your LED umbrella at least once every year (or when you feel that the light is fading more quickly). You can purchase replacement batteries at specialty retailers. You will need 1 pieces 18650 Lithium 2000mAh rechargeable batteries which are the same as have been supplied from new.

Failure to insert battery in the correct polarity, as indicated in the battery compartment may shorten the life of the battery or cause the battery to leak. Do not dispose of battery in fire. Battery should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines. Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix Alkaline, Standard (Carbon-Zinc) or rechargeable (Nickel Cadminum) or (Nickel Metal Hydride) batteries.

- Step 1** Twist the solar panel counter clockwise and remove it from the top of the umbrella.



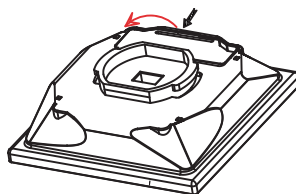
- Step 2** Carefully pull the plug out of the socket under the solar panel.
IMPORTANT: Do not pull the wire to remove the plug.



REPLACING THE BATTERY

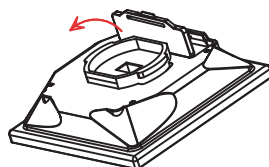
Step 3

Place the solar panel on a flat surface, then open the battery cover as shown.



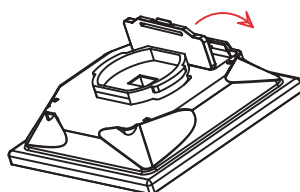
Step 4

Carefully open the solar panel. Replace the batteries, matching the +/- on the battery with the +/- on the battery case.



Step 5

Please ensure the O ring is correctly located before replacing the cover.
