- DO NOT USE ANY TOOLS OTHER THAN THOSE SHOWN.
- ANY SPANNERS OR ALLEN KEY REQUIRED ARE INCLUDED WITH THE FITTING KIT.
- DO NOT FOR ANY REASON USE A POWER TOOL TO ASSEMBLE THIS PRODUCT. ITS USE WILL INVALIDATE ANY CLAIM YOU MAY HAVE AND COULD MAKE THIS PRODUCT UNSAFE.
- DEPENDING ON THE AMOUNT OF USE, IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO TIGHTEN UP THE FIXING FROM TIME TO TIME. THIS IS COMPLETELY NORMAL FOR ANY KNOCK DOWN FURNITURE.
- FOR CLEANING YOU MAY USE A DAMP CLOTH (NOT WET) DRY DUSTER AND WOODEN FURNITURE POLISH.
- **FOR PRODUCT THAT INCLUDE SEAT PADS :** SEAT PADS MAY STAIN OR MARK IF ALLOWED TO COME INTO CONTACT WITH WET OR DAMP OBJECTS AS MATERIALS USED HAVE NOT BEEN SCOTCH GUARDED.
- THE SURFACE OF THIS ITEM IS NOT HEAT RESISTANT. ALWAYS USE A PLACEMAT UNDER HOT OR COLD ITEMS TO PREVENT MARKING.

- 1) Remove all wrapping materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
- 2) Refer to Parts List and Hardware List and ensure they are complete before you start assembling.
- 3) Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g carpet or rug) to prevent parts from being scratched.
- 4) Do not fully tighten bolts and nuts until all parts have been assembled.

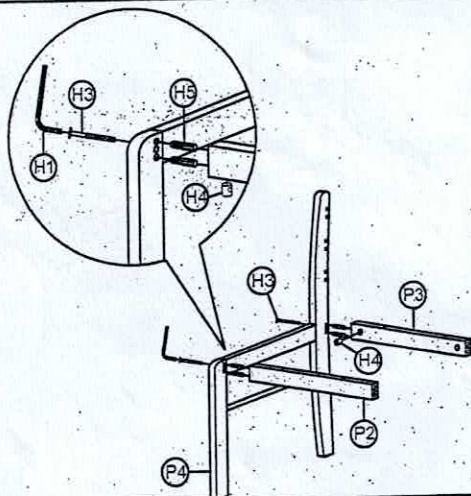
