





WARNING: Do not leave the gazebo where there is a risk of high wind, as possible damage will occur to the structure.








Connecting the Hook(N) to the Top Connector(J).



Attention: the Hook(N)should be under the Top Connector(J).


Please find the top tube we assembled in STEP 5(H1/H2).



Compare this drawing to assemble the pipe




And assemble this part into the Top Connector(J) with the end of H1.




Assemble this part into the Beam(C1/C2) with the end of H2 by using Screws BB.



Now we have to assemble I1/I2 which we have made in STEP 5 into the J with the side of I1.




Compare this drawing to assemble the pipe



And assemble it to Beam(D3) with the side of I2 by using Screws BB




Please note to assemble the part E1/E2/E3 together. This is the Slider for mosquito netting. And assemble it together by using Screws BB.





Please also connect each end (E1) of Slider to D1 by using Screws BB.




Please assemble G1 to J part, and please also put the small pole on the G2 into leg(A1) part as picture shows.





Now we have to assemble K2 into the small part of G1. This is a telescopic tube which will be used for easy assemble of Top canopy roof.


Please use the small pockets in the middle of the canopy's edges to cover the end of pole I2.
And those 4 pockets in the corner should cover the end of 4 telescopic tubes(K1) .

Expend the canopy(O1/O2) to the maximum by using K1/K2.


Now we have to assemble the 4 legs of gazebo.

You'd better ask for a helper to finish this step together.





Now we put the netting on the gazebo.
Please place O-Rings(LL) on 4 Beams evenly.
And then put on the netting by these O-Rings
Please note the netting should be on the inside of the Beams.




Sandbag


Open the bag and fill it with sand or something else heavy.




Place the sandbag next to the lower post.

Care and Maintenance

Our steel components for garden accessories and furniture are treated with rust inhibiting paint that protects it from rusting. However, due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur once these protective coatings are scratched. This is not a defect and thus not covered by the warranty.

To minimize this condition, we recommend care when assembling & handling the product to prevent scratching the paint. Should any scratching or damage occur, we recommend immediate touch-up with rust inhibiting paint.

Surface rust can also be easily removed with a very light application of common cooking oil. If surface oxidation (rusting) occurs and if no measure is taken to prevent this, the oxidation may start dripping on to deck or patio and caused damaging stains, which may be difficult to remove. This can be prevented if the above-mentioned measures are taken to keep the product from oxidizing.

Use damp cloth to wipe off the stains as quickly as possible.

If necessary, wash with a mild solution of soap and water; rinse thoroughly and dry completely.

Periodically check and ensure that all bolts are well-tighten during use
