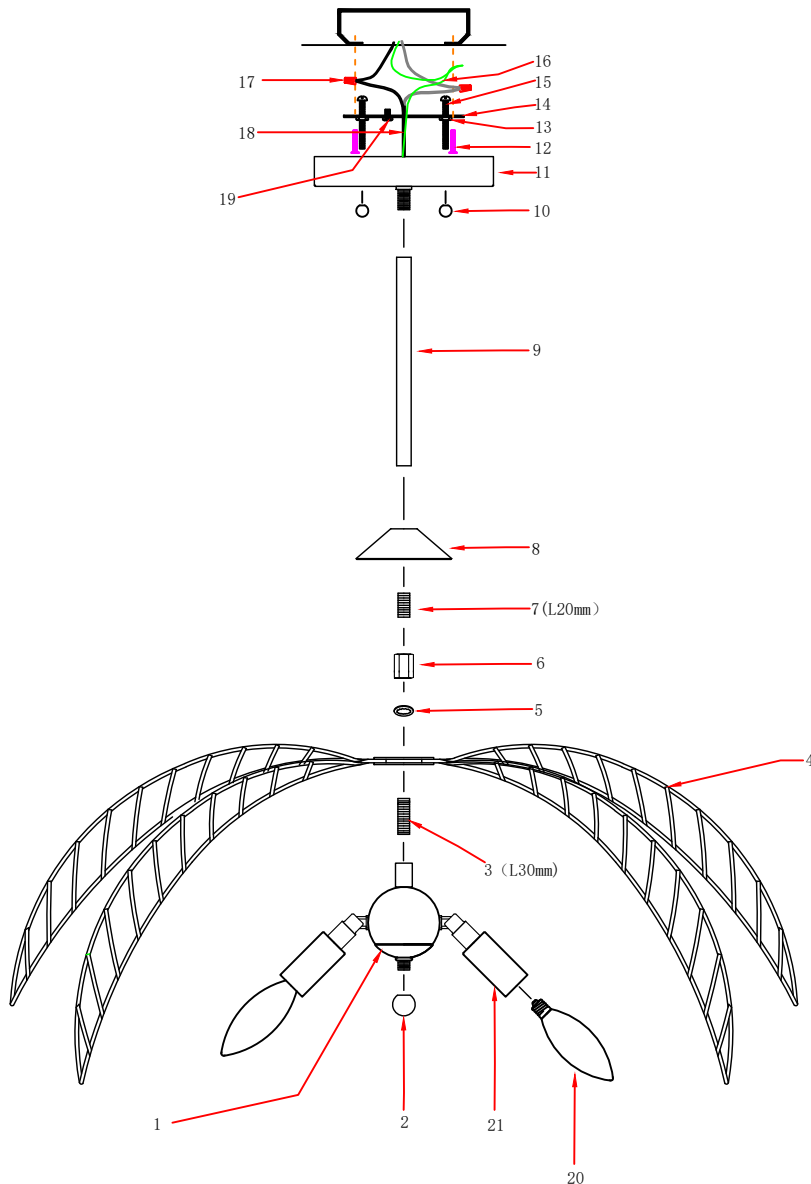


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step A: Adjust the lamp head component (1) to a suitable angle as indicated in the diagram. Secure the cylindrical metal (2) into the threaded nipple on the lamp head component (1).

Step B: Route the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp head component (1) through the 30mm long threaded conduit (3). Secure the conduit into the lamp head component (1).

Step C:

·Route the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp head component(1) through the leaf shade (4), serrated washer (5), and hexagon connector component (6). Ensure the opening of the shade faces downward.

- Tighten the hexagon connector component (6) onto the the 30mm long threaded conduit (3).

Step D: Route the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp body through the 20mm long threaded conduit (7). Secure the conduit (7) onto the hexagon connector component (6).

Step E: Route the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp body through the cover (8) and rod (9). Secure the rod (9) to the 20mm long threaded conduit (7).

Step F: Route the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp body through the canopy (11). Secure the canopy (11) to the rod (9).

Step G:

·Insert two connecting screws (15) into the two holes at 70mm spacing on the mounting plate (14).

- Adjust to the desired length and secure with small hex nuts (13).

Step H: Secure the mounting plate (14) to the junction box with screws (12).

Step I: In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the wires.

· Connect the positive wire (black) of the lamp body (18) to the supply positive wire (+) using the wire connector (17).

Similarly, connect the negative wire (white) of the lamp body to the supply negative wire (-) using the wire connector (17).

Ensure that no bare wires are exposed to prevent electric leakage.

• Secure the fixture grounding wire (16) and supply grounding wire to mounting plate (14) using green hexagonal screw (19).

Step J: Tuck all wires into junction box. Secure the canopy (11) to connecting screws (15) with decorative spheres (10).

Step K: Install the bulbs (20) into the lamp socket (21). Refer to the warning label on the lamp cup for the maximum wattage of the bulb. (Bulb Not Included)

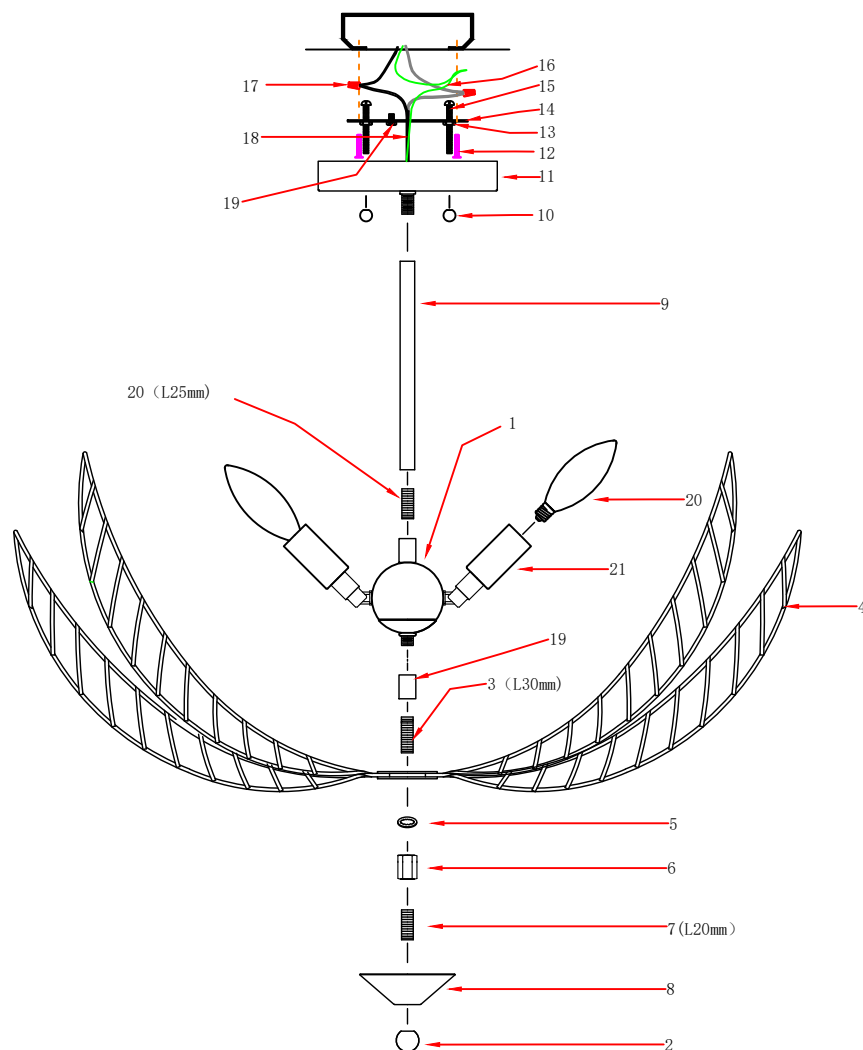
Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step A: Adjust the lamp head component (1) to a suitable angle as indicated in the diagram.

Step B: Install the cylindrical metal (19) into the threaded nipple on the lamp head component (1), and screw the 30mm long threaded conduit (3) into the cylindrical metal (19).

Step C: Secure the leaf shade (4) to the 30mm long threaded conduit (3) using a serrated washer (5) and hexagon connector component (6), as indicated in the diagram.

Step D:

•Screw the 20mm long threaded conduit (7) into the hexagon connector component (6).

•Then, pass the central hole of the cover (8) through the threaded conduit (7), and fix it tightly with a large spherical metal component (2).

Step E: Pass the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp head component (1) through the 25mm long threaded conduit (20), and secure the threaded conduit (20) into the lamp head component (1).

Step F: Pass the main wires and grounding wire of the lamp body through the rod (9), and screw the rod (9) into the lamp head component (1).

Step G: Pass the wires through the canopy (11). Secure canopy onto the rod (9).

Step H:

•Insert two connecting screws (15) into the two holes at 70mm spacing on the mounting plate (14).

•Adjust to a suitable length, and then fix screws with small hexagon nuts (13).

Step I: Secure the mounting plate (14) to the junction box with screws (12).

Step J: In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the wires.

•Connect the positive wire (black) of the lamp body (18) to the supply positive wire (+) using the wire connector (17).

•Similarly, connect the negative wire (white) of the lamp body to the supply negative wire (-) using the wire connector (17).

Ensure that no bare wires are exposed to prevent electric leakage.

•Secure the fixture grounding wire (16) and supply grounding wire to mounting plate (14) using green hexagonal screw (19).

Step K: Tuck all wires into junction box. Secure the canopy (11) to connecting screws (15) with decorative spheres (10).
