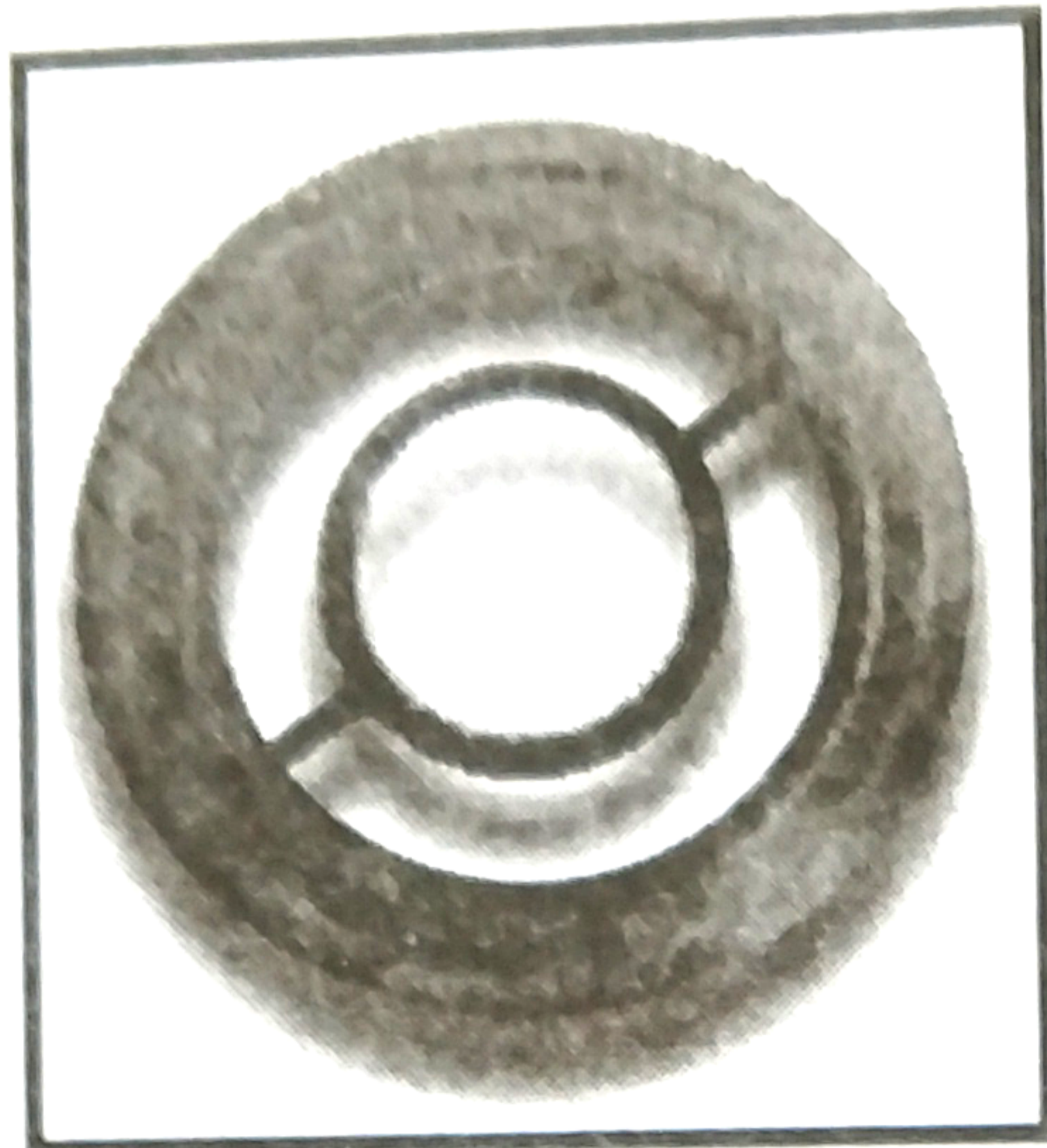


STARLAMP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT : THIS LAMP IS NOT RATED FOR USE WITH BULBS GREATER THAN 40 WATTS. USING BULBS GREATER THAN 40 WATTS MAY RESULT IN FIRE OR DAMAGE TO THE LAMP.

You have received a distance protector with your starlamp. This distance protector will keep the bulb from touching the starlamp itself. It will not provide adequate protection if the star is crushed or the protector is incorrectly installed.



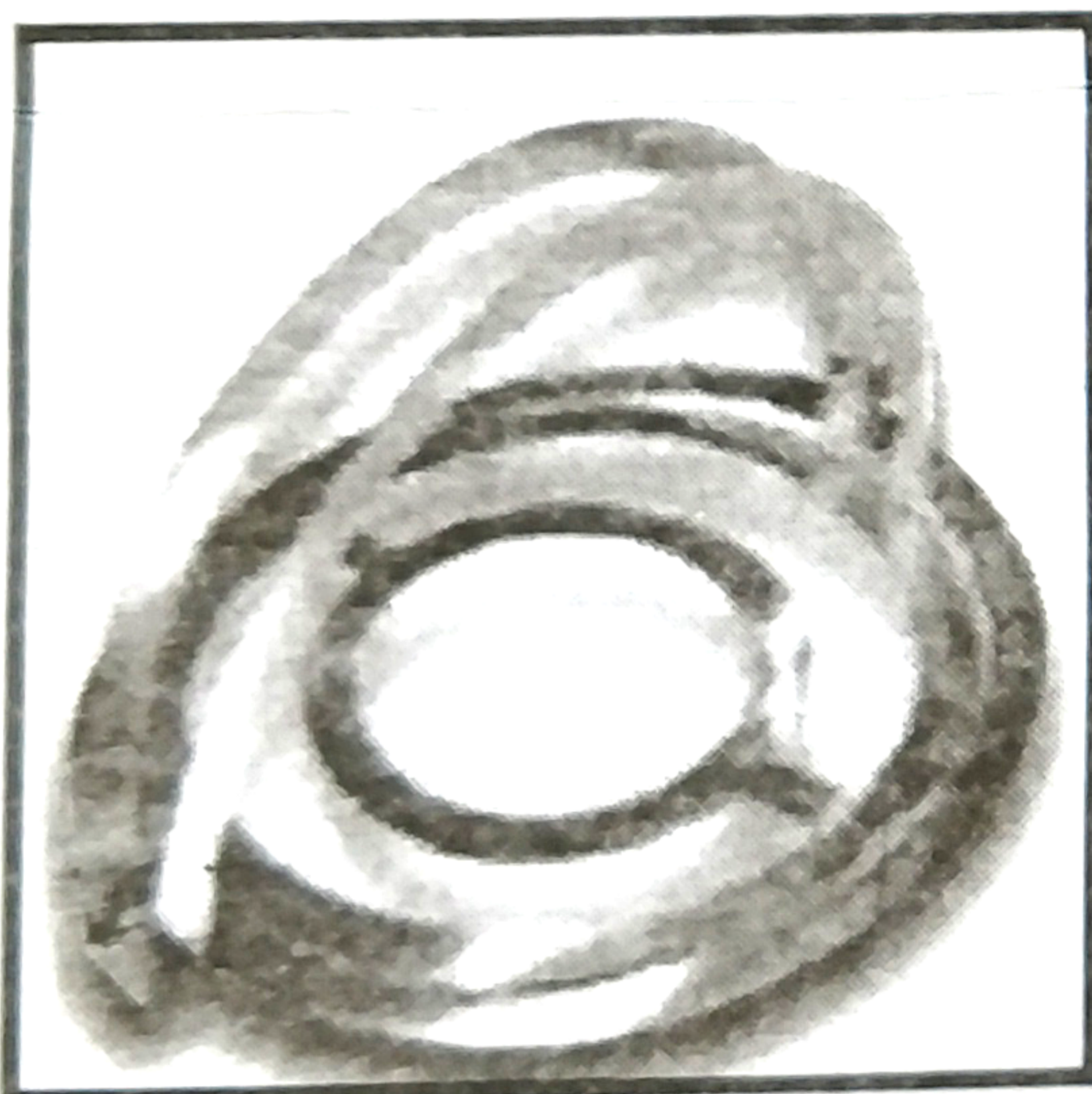

Carefully insert your fingers between each arm of the star to free one from another. Expand the legs of the star by placing your fingers inside, starting with the center and working outward.

Assembly is easy. Locate the outer circle of the distance protector. With a pinching motion, squeeze the unattached sides toward the center to create a taco shape as shown.



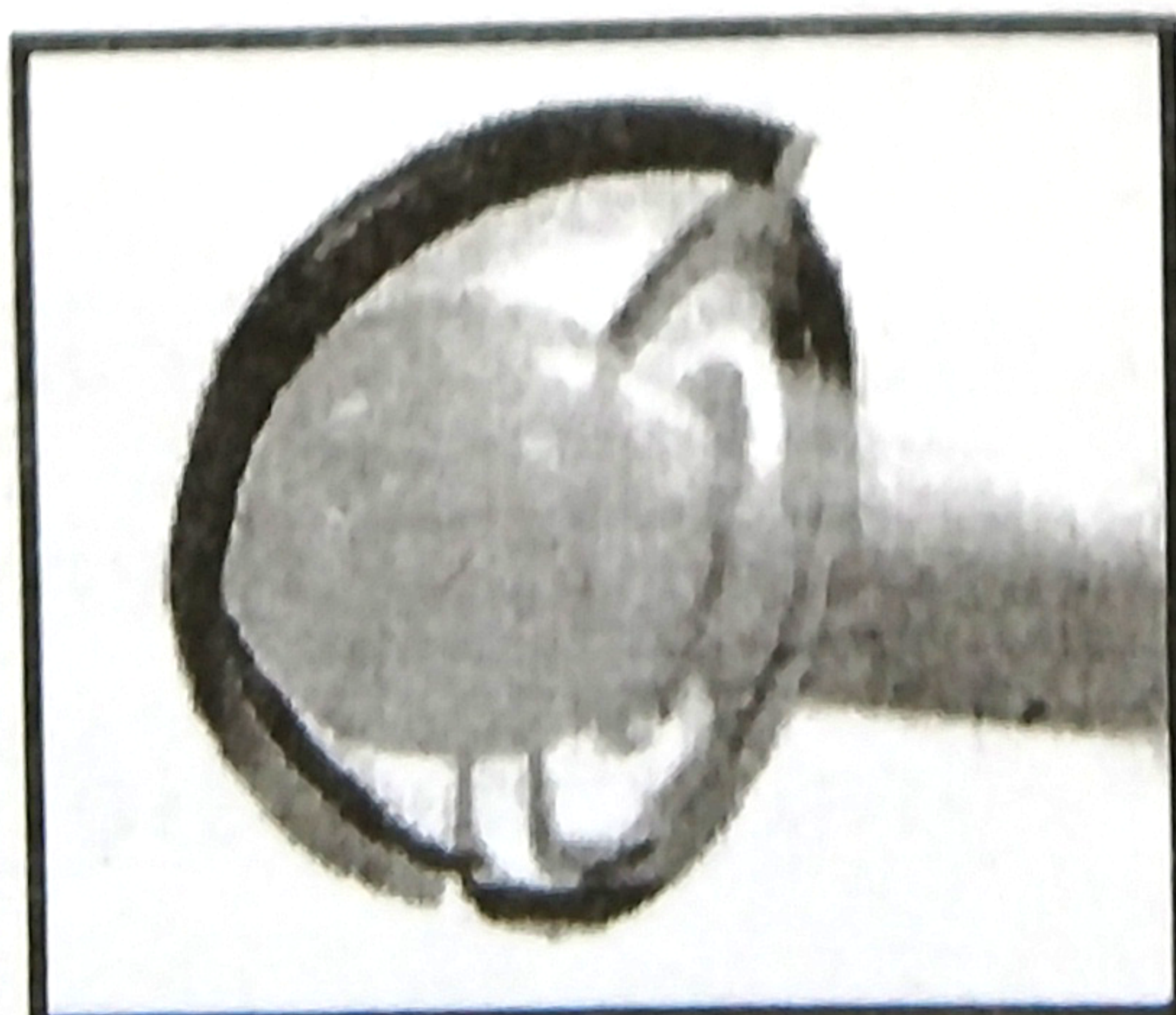

Lay the partially-open star on its side, insert the socket assembly, and pull the star closed with the string loops. Tie the loops in a knot and your star is ready to hang from a hook in the ceiling.

Insert the lightbulb, threaded end first, through the taco, into the center hole. The bulb should lock into place. You may need to adjust the width of the taco for a secure fit. Use a 40 watt bulb max.

Once the your lamp is hung, double check to ensure that the lightbulb is not touching the star and that it is positioned correctly in the center of the star. Now Enjoy!
