- Well-constructed and highly durable for mid-traffic applications
- The tensile strength of the sari silk used makes the rugs pliable, smooth, and resilient
- Has an organic & rustic, high quality, but informal look and feel
- Conceived from historical textiles originating in Central America, North Africa, Central Asia, the Middle East, Europe, and the Far East
- Named after a multinational group of world renowned poets as a nod to the multi-cultural, multi-ethnic, influence of the designs
