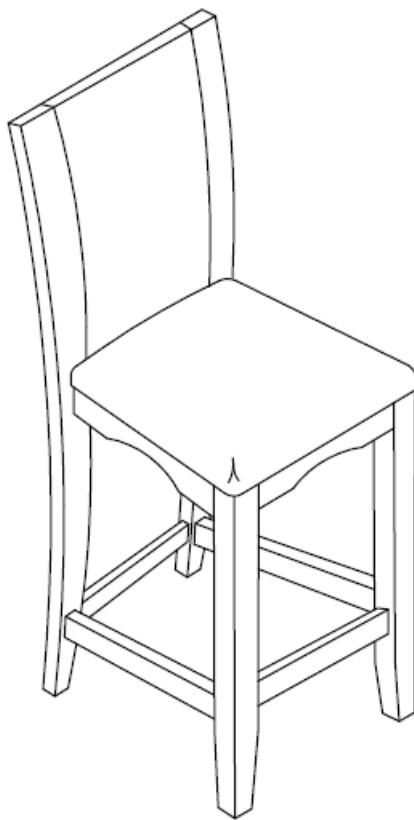


Assembly Instructions



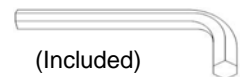
ASSEMBLY RATING

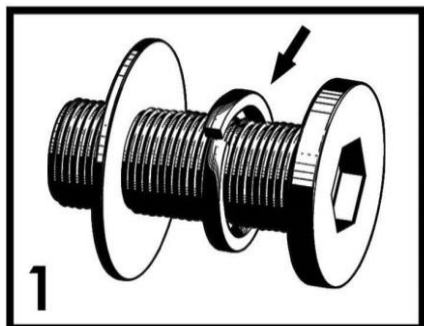

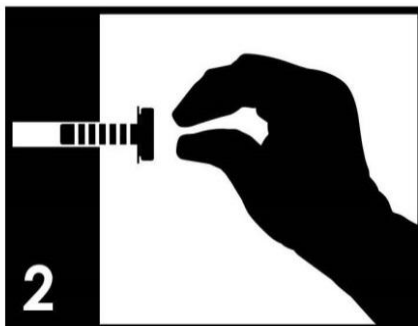

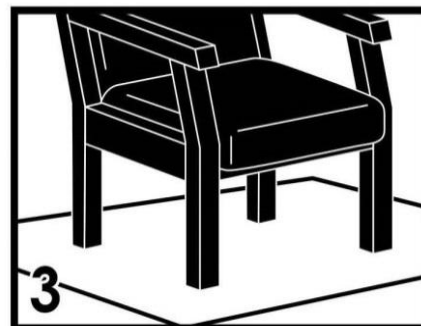
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



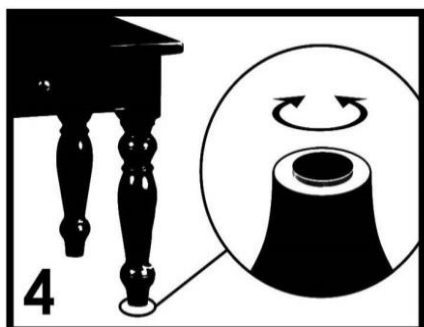
1 When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



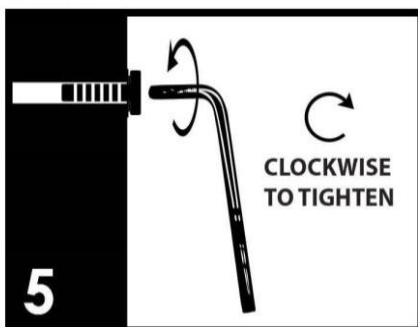
2 Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



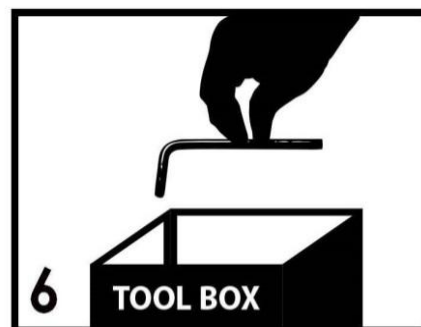
3 Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



4 Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



5 Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

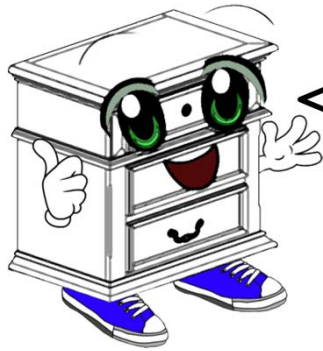


6 Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

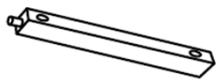

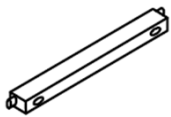

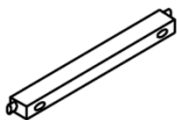

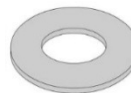

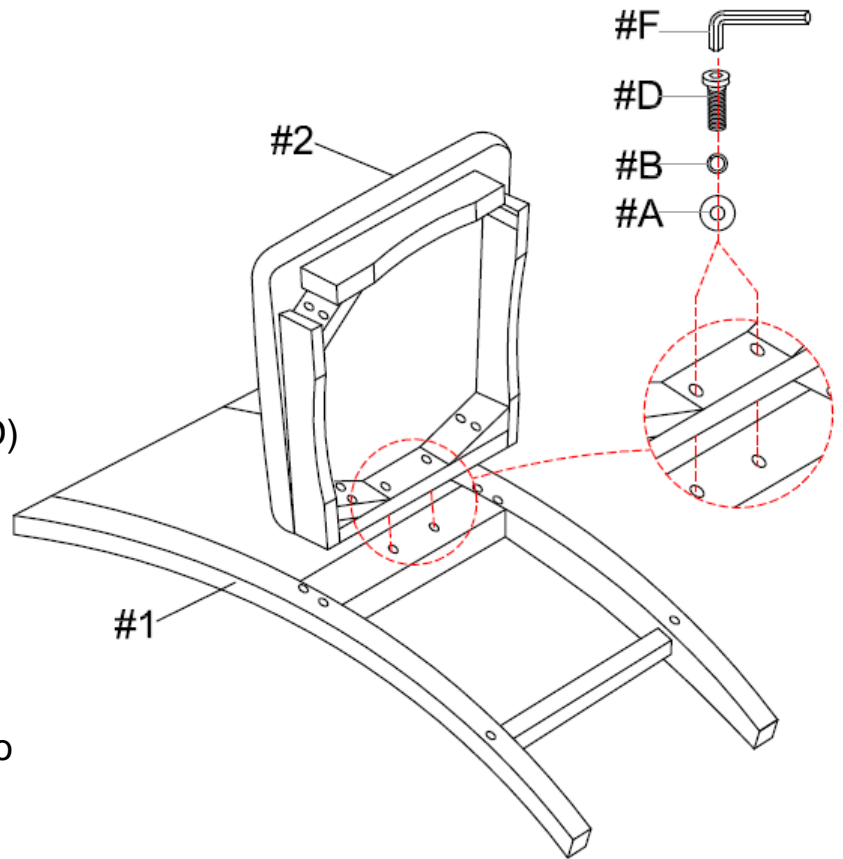
Note: The above parts and hardware are shown for a complete assembly of ONE chair. However, the actual parts and hardware (with an exception of the Allen wrench) in the box will be twice the quantities listed to include the assembly of the second chair.



#A x 2 pcs
#B x 2 pcs
#D x 2 pcs

Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

- I. Place the backrest with legs (#1) on a protected surface. Align the seat (#2) with the pre-drilled holes of the backrest with legs (#1).
- II. Prepare 2 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#D) and then the flat washer (#A) onto the SAME bolt (#D), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assembly near the center holes of the seat (#2) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#F) to lock them with the backrest with legs (#1).



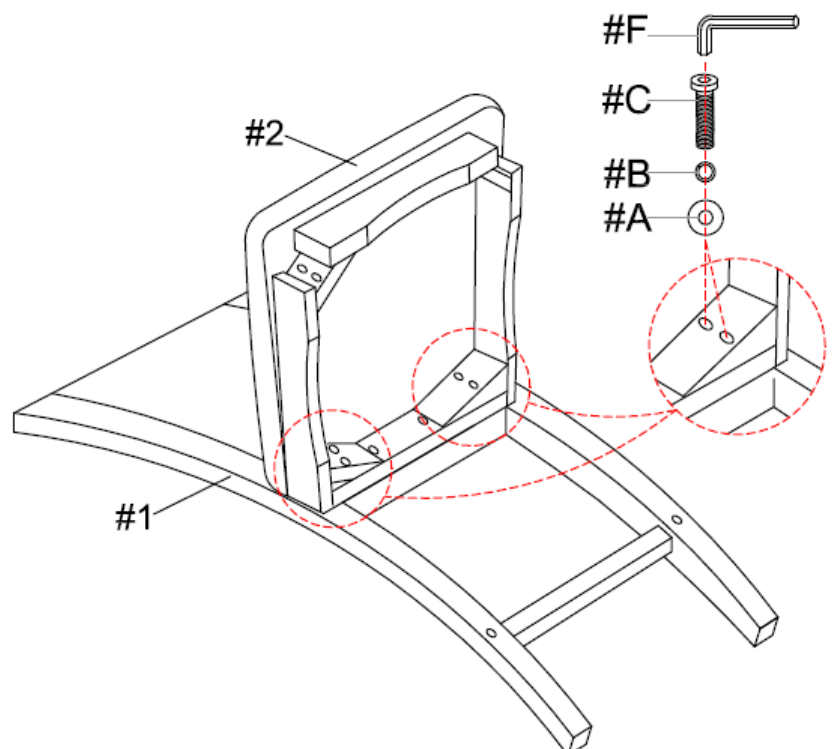

Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

- I. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#C) and then the flat washer (#A) onto the SAME bolt (#C), in that order.
- II. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes in the corners of the seat (#2) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#F) to lock them with the backrest with legs (#1).

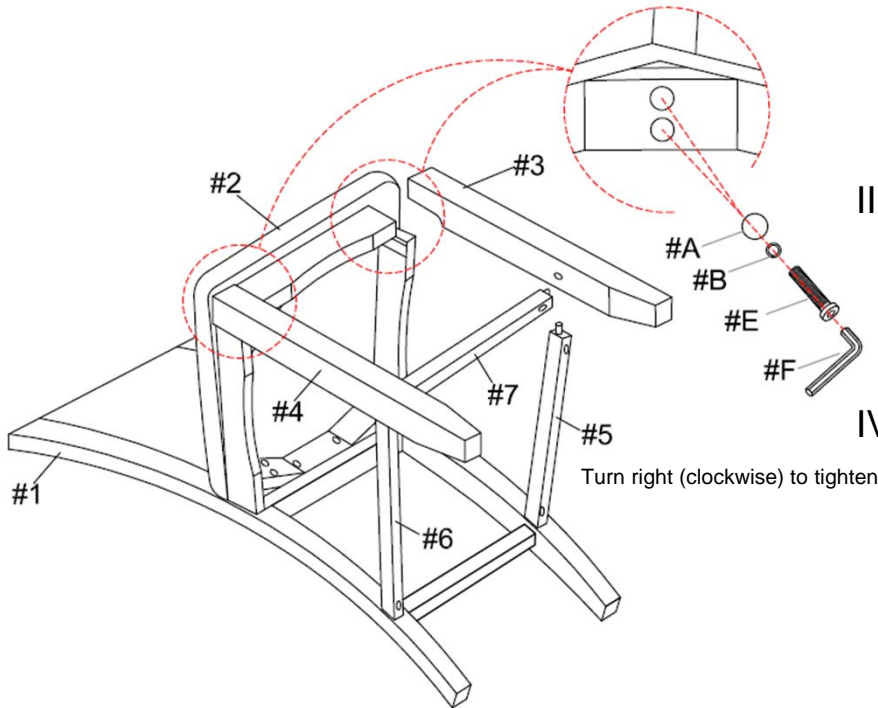

Note: Right and left are determined by facing the front of the chair in the upright position.

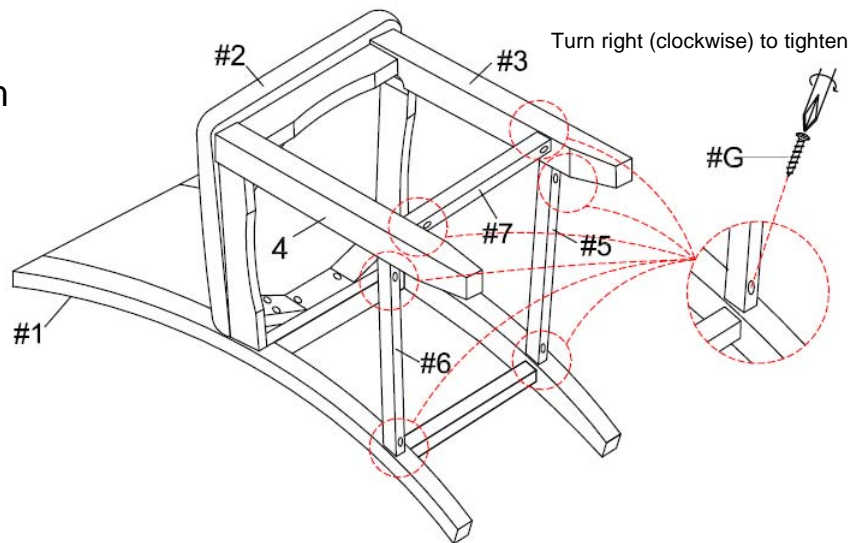


- I. Insert the front leg support (#7) between the right front leg (#3) and the left front leg (#4).
- II. Insert the right leg support (#5) and the left leg support (#6) into the backrest with legs (#1) and the other ends of the leg supports into the assembled right front leg (#3) and the left front leg (#4).
- III. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#E) and then the flat washer (#A) onto the SAME bolt (#E), in that order.
- IV. Insert the bolt assemblies through the corners of the seat (#2) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#F) to lock them with the right front leg (#3) and the left front leg (#4).



#G x 6 pcs

- I. Secure all the leg supports with 6 wood screws (#G) using a Phillips screwdriver to lock them with the backrest with legs (#1), the right front leg (#3) and the left front leg (#4).
- II. Carefully place the completed chair upright. Make sure the chair is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts are secured and properly tightened.



ASSEMBLE EVERYTHING EXACTLY THE SAME FOR THE SECOND CHAIR
