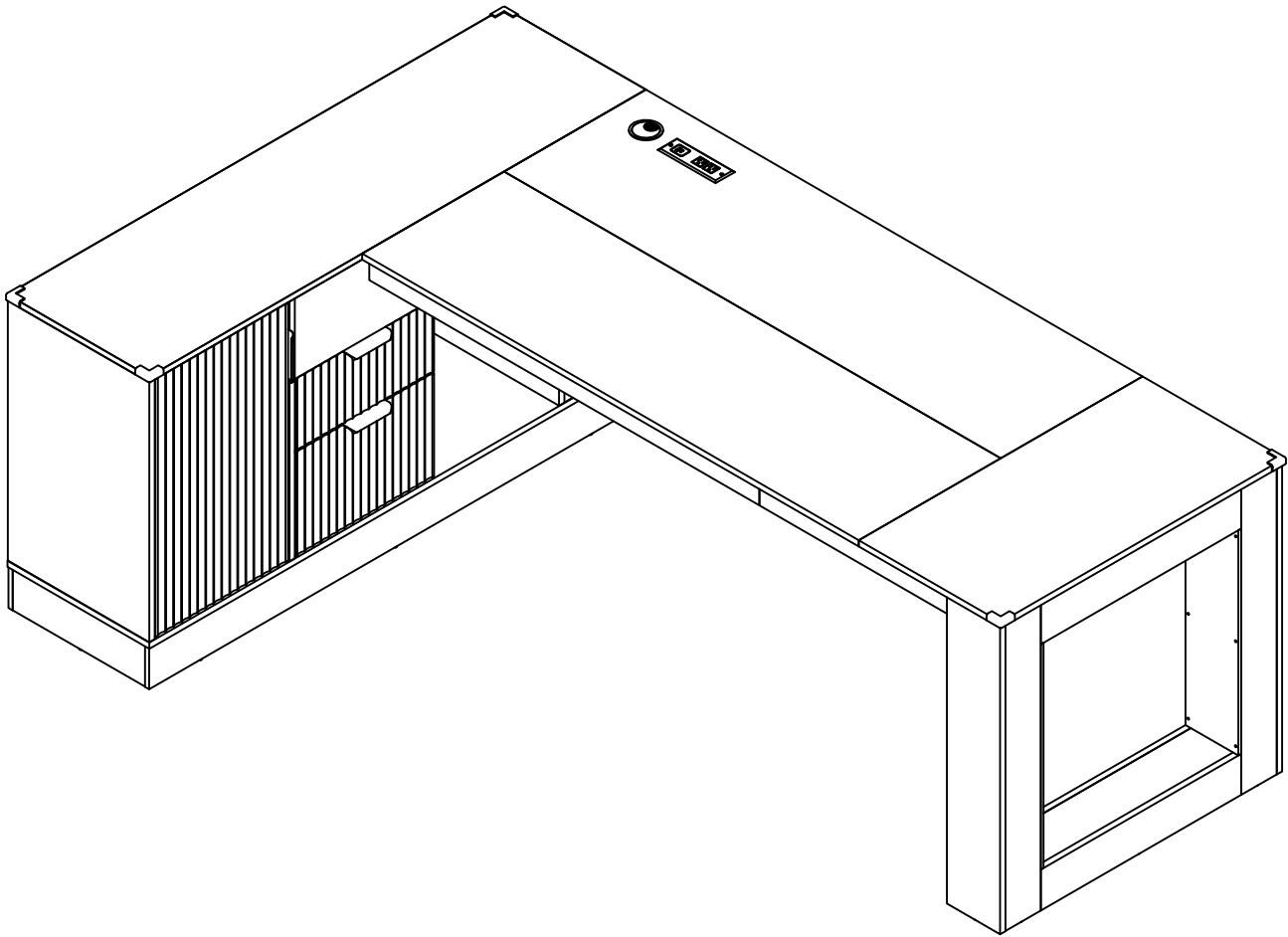

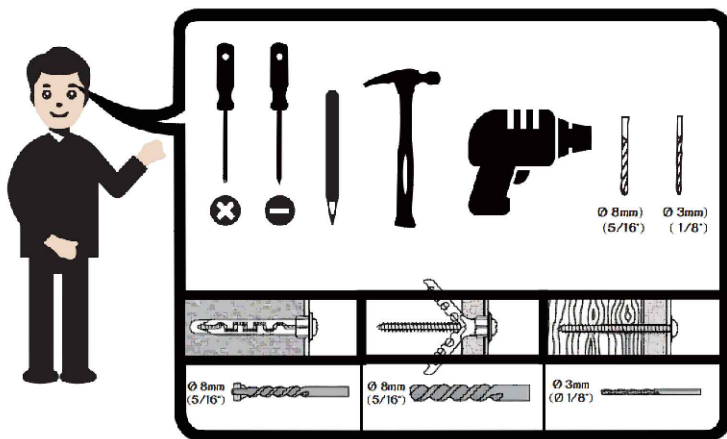

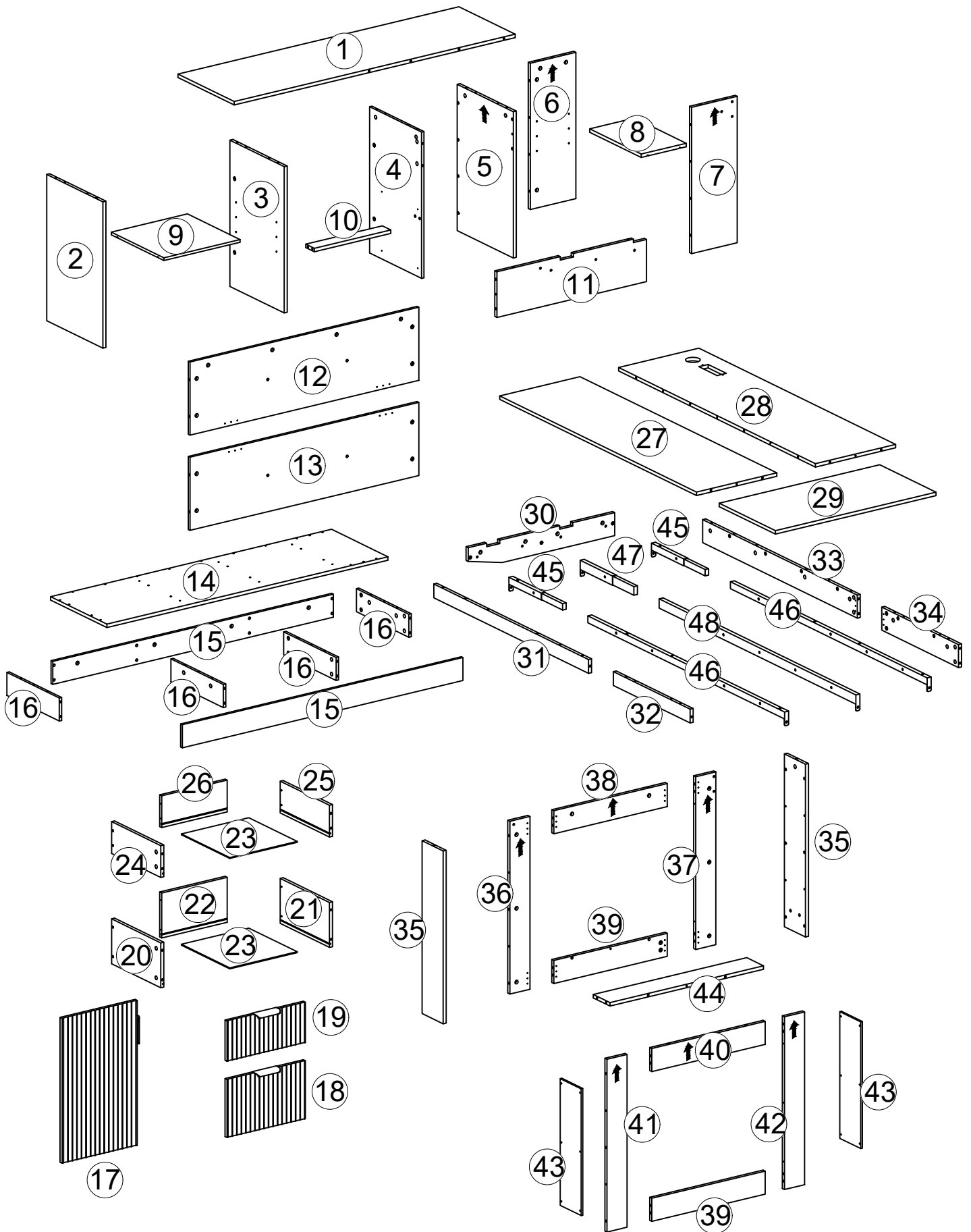
Important reminder:

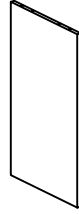
Explosion Diagram



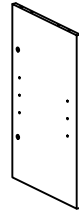

A Guide to Wall Mounting & Fixings

Important note:

If plastic wall plugs (rawl plugs) are supplied with your product, e.g.:



- these are only suitable for use in masonry walls.

If you are in any doubt about the correct wall plugs for your wall, seek professional advice.

Failure of the product due to using the incorrect fixings is the responsibility of the installer.



Important: when drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc.

Make sure that the screws and wall plugs being used are suitable for supporting your unit. Consult a qualified tradesperson if you are unsure.

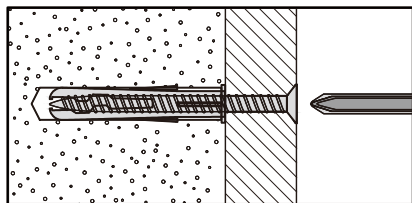
Hints:

- 1: General rule:  always use a larger screw and wall plug if you are not sure.
- 2: Ensure you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.
- 3: Ensure you drill the hole horizontally; do not force the drill or enlarge the hole.
- 4: Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceilings and ceramic tiles. Ensure wall plugs are inserted beyond the thickness of the ceramic tiles to avoid the tiles splitting or cracking.
- 5: Ensure wall plugs are well fitted and are a tight fit in the drilled hole.

Types of walls

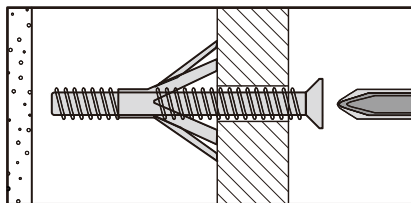
You can use one of the following types of wall plug if your walls are made of brick, breeze block, concrete, stone or wood.

No.1 "General Purpose" wall plug



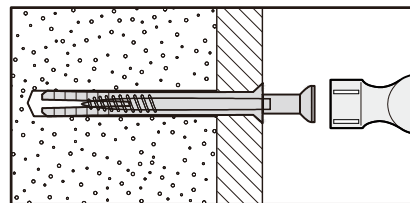
Generally aerated blocks should not be used to support heavy loads, use a specialist fitting in this case. For light loads, general purpose wall plugs can be used.

No.3 "Cavity Fixing" wall plug



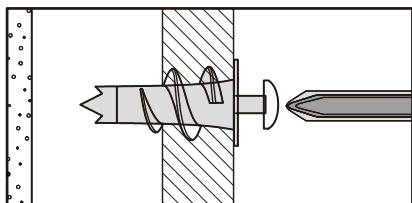
For use with plasterboard partitions or hollow wooden doors.

No.5 "Hammer Fixing" wall plug



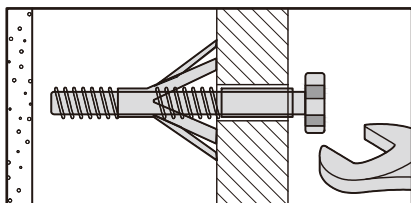
For use with walls stuck with plasterboard. The hammer fixing allows it to be fixed to the wall rather than the plasterboard. Always check the fixing is secure to the retaining wall.

No.2 "Plasterboard" wall plug



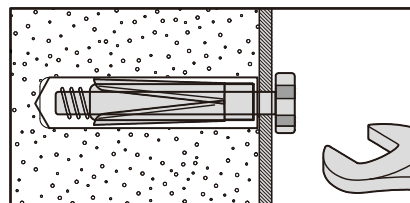
For use when attaching light loads onto plasterboard partitions.

No.4 "Cavity Fixing - Heavy Duty" wall plug



For use when fitting or supporting heavy loads such as shelving, wall cabinets and coat racks.

No.6 "Shield Anchor" wall plug - heavy loads



For use with heavier loads such as TV and HiFi speakers and satellite dishes etc.



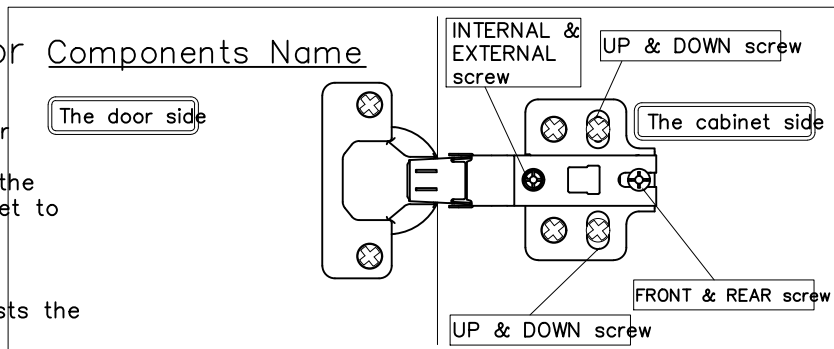
Care & Maintenance

Safety: always check the fitting and location to ensure your safety in and around the home.

Fitting: from time to time check the fitting to ensure the wall plugs or screws do not become loose.

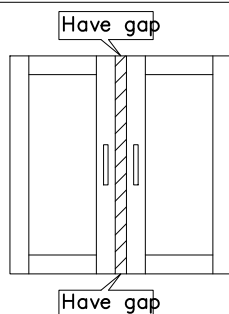
The ways to adjust the door Components Name

- Before adjusting the hinge, please check whether the cabinet is skewed.
- If the skew can not be repaired, please remove the anti-tipping device first, then adjust the cabinet to vertical position.
- Please adjust the hinge with the door open.
- Please operate it with more than 2 people, one person holds the door and the other one adjusts the screw.

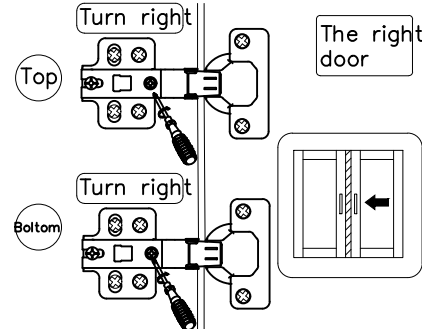
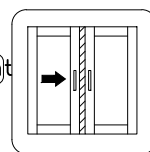
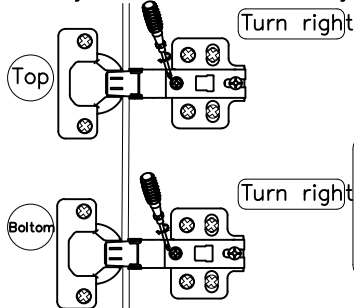


Obvious gaps between doors or Doors don't look closed

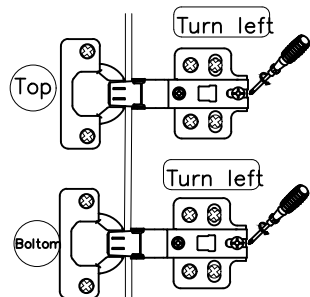
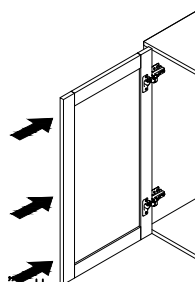
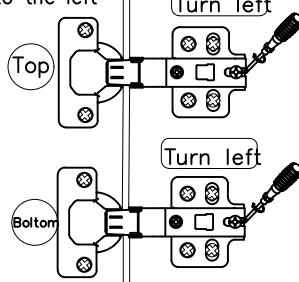
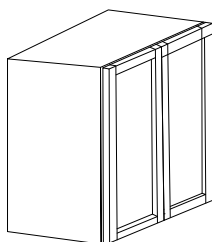
※ If the 2 doors are overlap, please turn the "internal & external screw" to the left.

- 3 Rotate the "font and rear screws" to the right



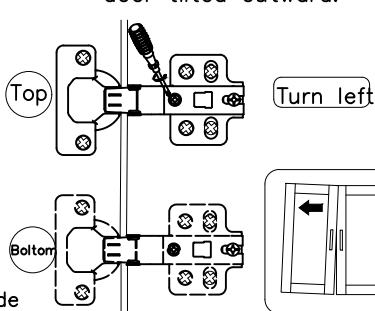
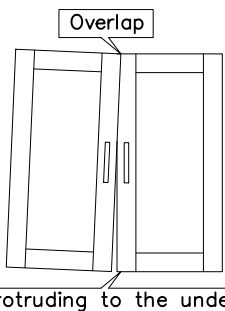
Please take the following steps to adjust first.

After adjusting the "front and rear screw", the door still does not change, please turn the "internal & external screw" to the right Slightly.

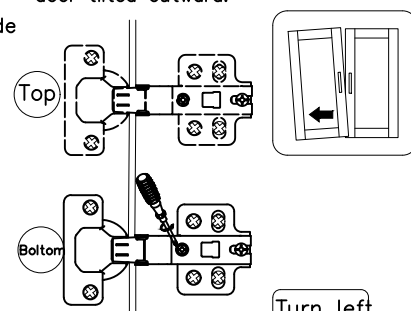
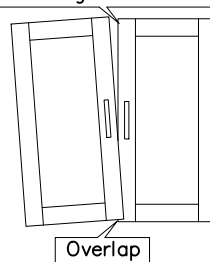
When door is leaning

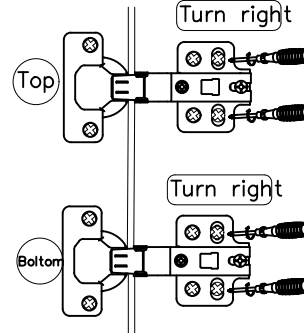
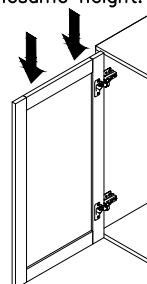
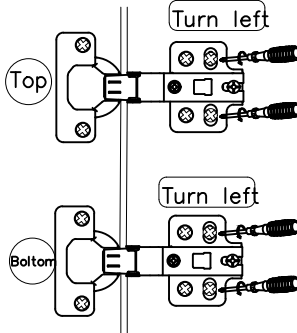
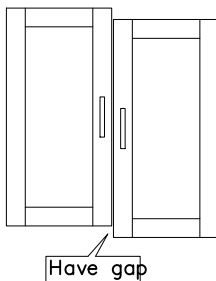


When door is higher on top

- 1 Turn "up & down screw" to the left

- 2 Lower the door's height so that 2 doors are of the same height.

- 3 Turn "up & down screw" to the right



※ if the door is lower on bottom, please lift up the left door slightly on step 2
