# SAFETY & WARNINGS

- This umbrella was made for the explicit purpose of providing outdoor functions and is not to be used as a toy.
- This product is intended for normal outdoor use; however, the manufacturer recommends storing and / or covering this umbrella when any formidable severe weather is approaching.
- Do not locate this product near open flames.
- Do not use this product as a support.
- Do not shake, lean or climb on the product.
- Children under the age of 10, near the product, should be supervised by a competent adult at all times.
- **WARNING:** Please keep children out of the assembly area before assembly.
- Do not locate the product near any heat source.
- Never use the umbrella in high wind conditions. Damage to the umbrella can occur.
- When not in use, secure the product in a cool and covered location.
- Umbrella should not be used in the event of wind, rain, hail, sleet, snow or any other inclement weather.
- Always close and secure the product when not in use.

# INSTALLATION

## Note:

1. The ribs must be separated before opening umbrella.
2. In step 4, open umbrella to fix point by crank, please stop to crank more otherwise umbrella will be damage.

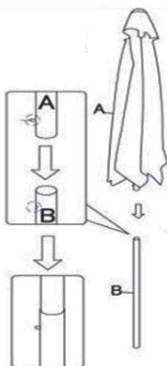
## Step 1

Take out the umbrella and umbrella pole.



## Step 2

Attach the umbrella to the umbrella pole.



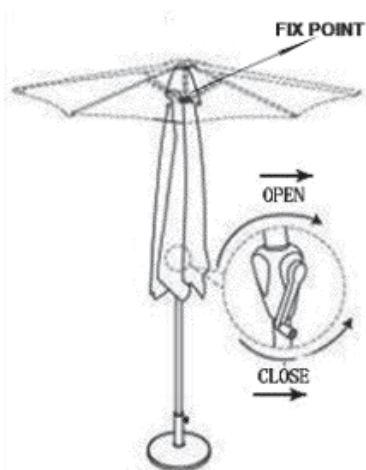
### Step 3

The installation of the umbrella and umbrella stem is completed.



### Step 4

Open the umbrella by turning the crank by clockwise. Close the umbrella by turning the crank in counterclockwise.



### Step 5

The umbrella has been opened.



### Step 6

The umbrella is closed.



## CLEANING & CARE

- For best results, clean the umbrella with damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the umbrella in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the umbrella away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
