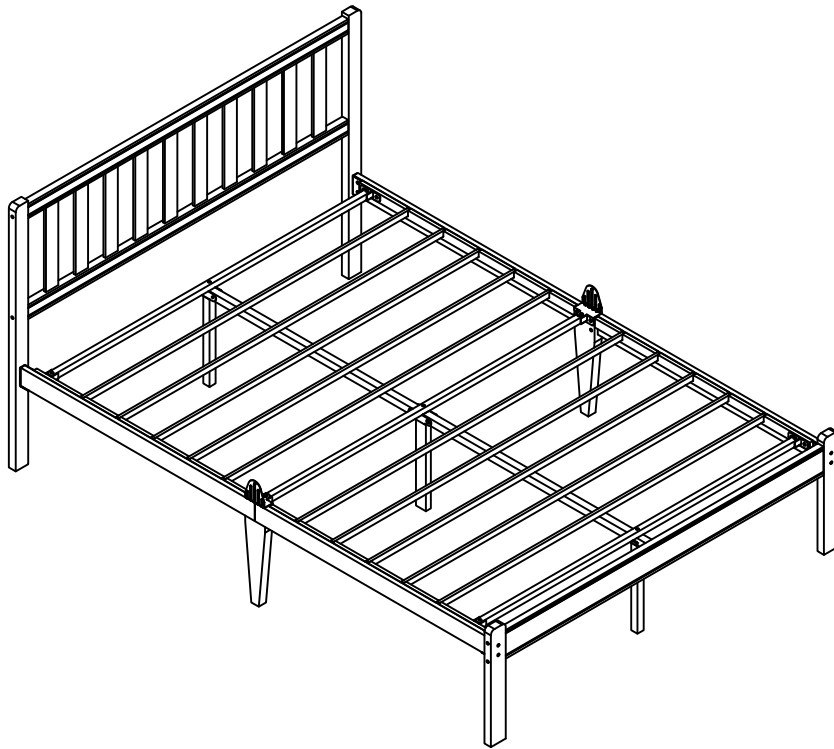

Read Before Beginning Assembly

- 1. Clearing a area:** Please assemble in a spacious area near the product's final location, preferably on a carpet or protected surface to safeguard both your floor and the product.
- 2. Recommend team assembling:** It is recommended that at least 2 people assemble this product. Having an extra hand can make the process faster easier.
- 3. Check for all parts:** Most parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Ensure all parts are included before starting.
- 4. Read each step carefully:** Follow the assembly steps in the correct order. Skipping steps or changing the sequence can lead to difficulties.
- 5. Tighten after complete:** Do not fully tighten any bolts before the entire assembly is completed. Final tightening all together ensures greater stability.
- 6. You can contact us:** If you encounter any questions or difficulties during installation, please contact us through marketplace.

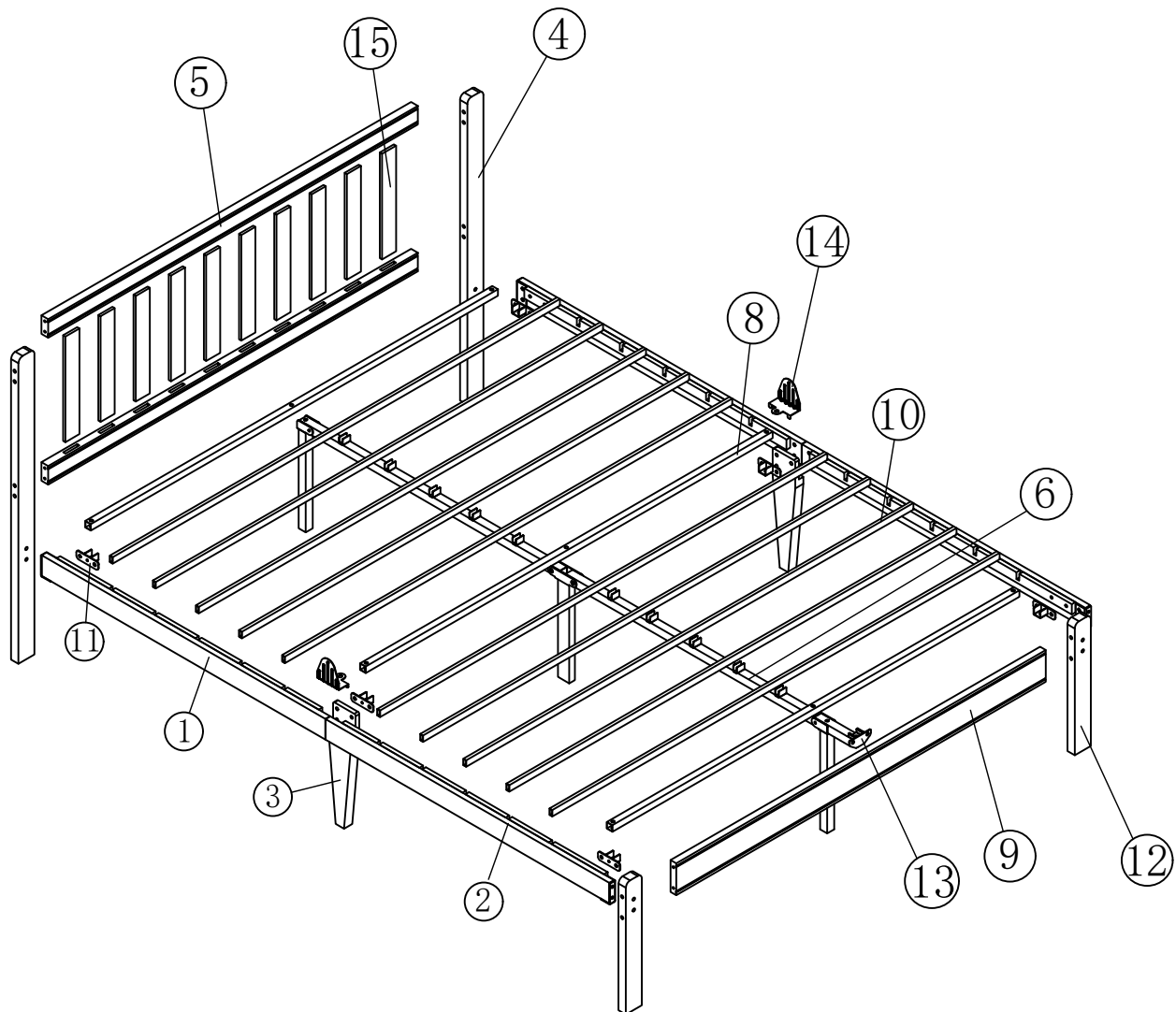
- 1. Choking hazard:** This product contains small parts. Keep out of reach of children.

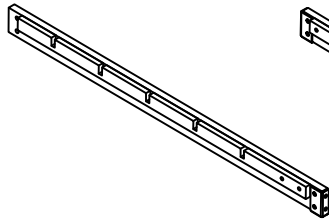
- 1.** This product is warranted against defects in materials and manufacture for 3 years from the purchase date (proof of purchase required).

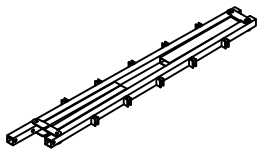

Installation

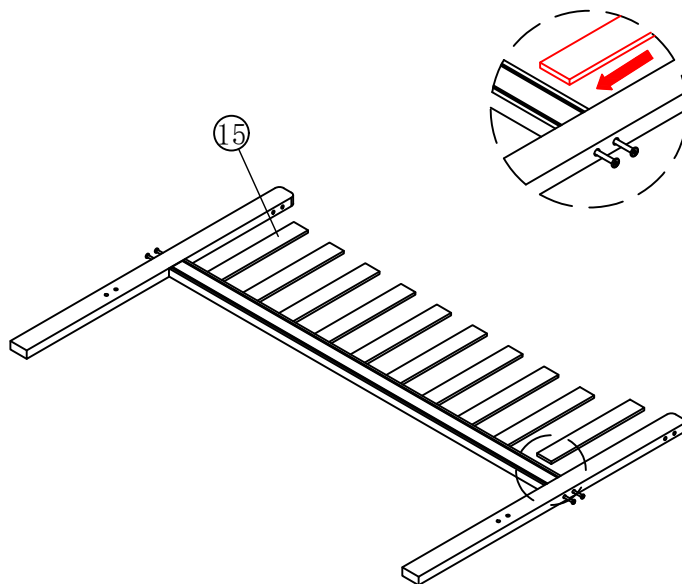

Step 1

Connect Headboard Panel

- Attach headboard panel-A ⑤ to the bedposts ④ using four bolts (C);
- Important: Only hand-tighten the bolts at this stage - do not fully tighten.



Step 2

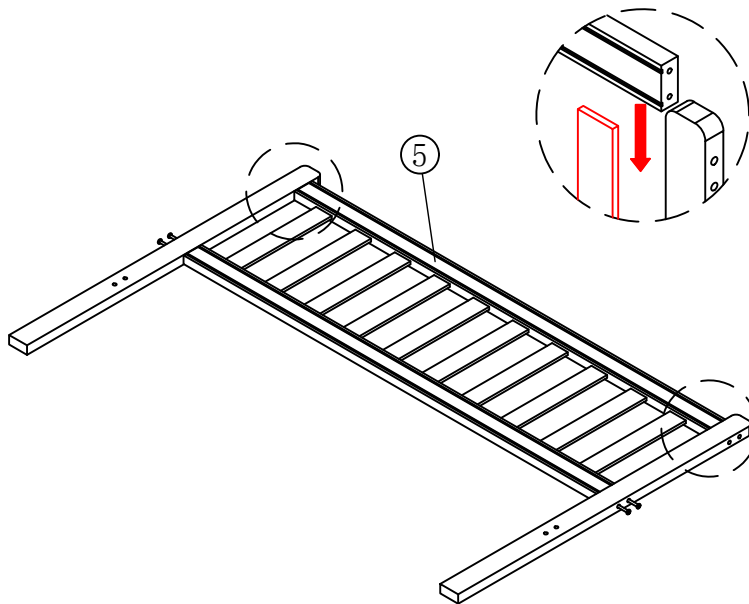
Connect Headboard Panel-2

- Take each headboard rod ⑮ and insert headboard panel-A ⑤ one at a time;
- Slide each slat into the pre-drilled holes on the headboard beams.

Step 3

Connect Headboard Panel-3

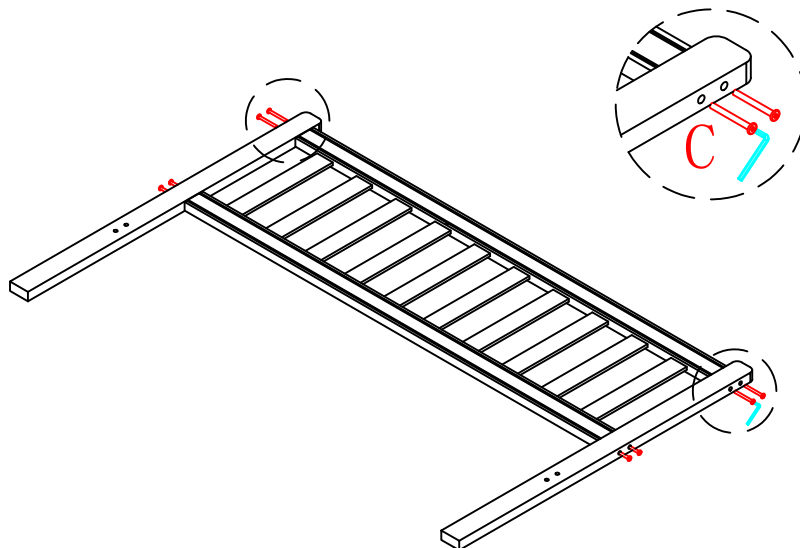
- Take the remaining headboard panel-A ⑤ ;
- Line them up with the corresponding slots on the headboard rod ⑮ from Step 2.



Step 4

Connect Headboard Panel-4

- Fully tighten the bolts (C) that were installed in Step 3
- Secure the remaining bolts (C) from Step1.

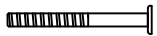
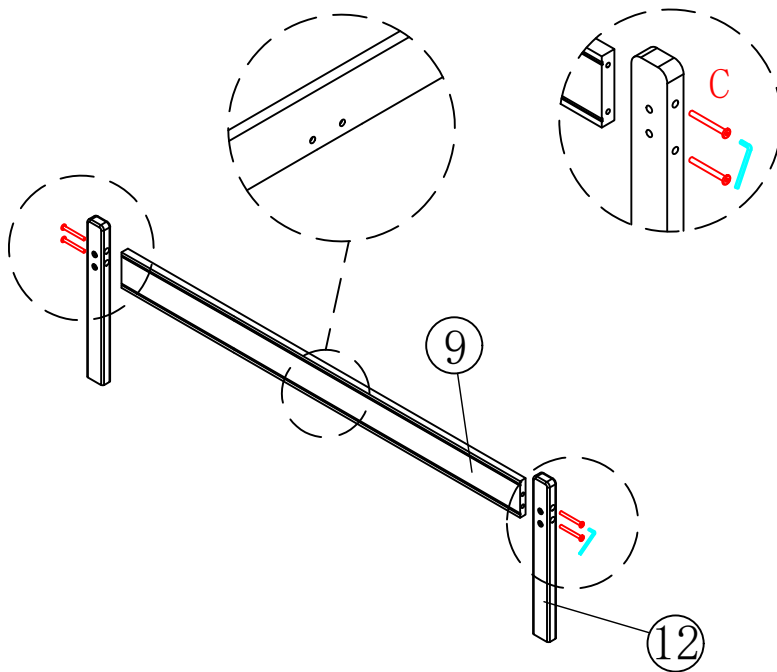

Step 5

Assemble Footboard

- Position the footboard ⑨ between the two foot of bed ⑫.
- Insert the bolts (C) through the pre-drilled holes as shown in the diagram and hand-tighten all bolts first to ensure proper alignment .
- The footboard ⑨ are not centered. Please pay attention to the direction.

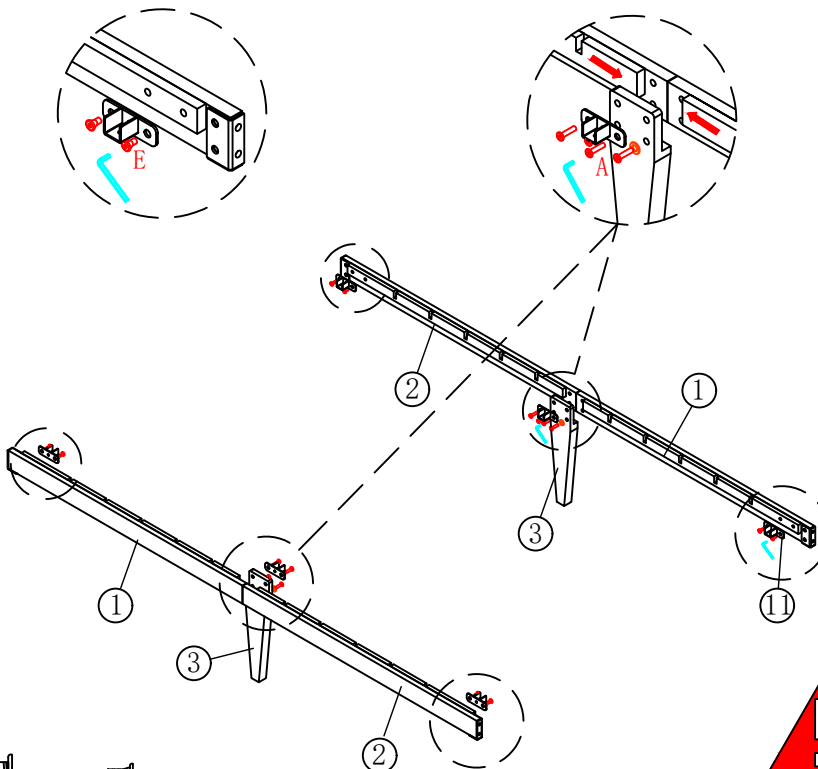

Step 6

Assemble of Side Rails

- Connect the left side rails ①, left side rails ② and middle support leg ③ using connectors-A ⑪ and eight bolts (A) and four washer (F). The washers should be installed to the bottom holes.
- Secure the connector at each end of the side rail assembly to the bed frame using eight bolts (E).

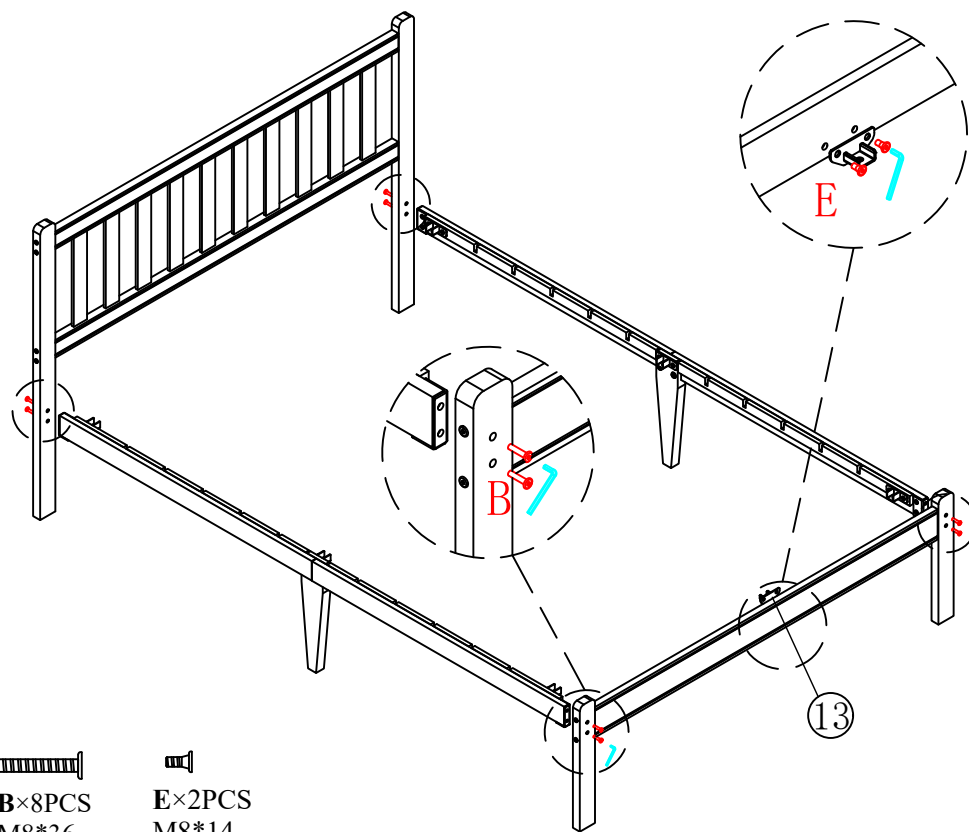

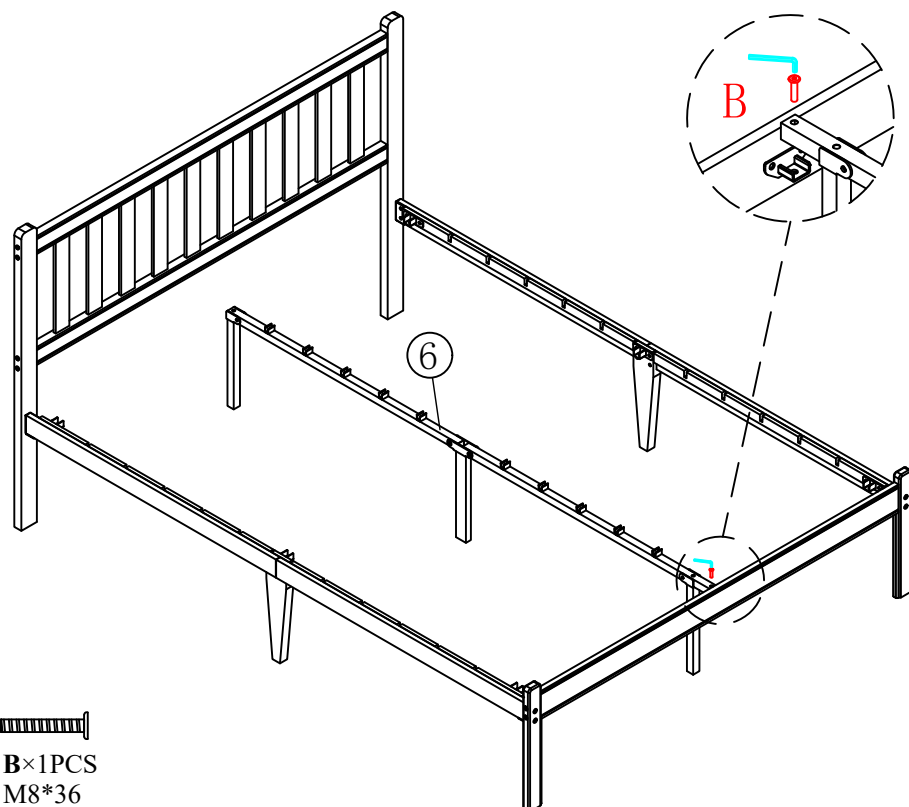
Note: Follow the direction indicated by the red arrow in the detailed view for proper installation. ⑪ It should be placed in the two screw holes above ③.



Step 7

Assemble the Bed Frame

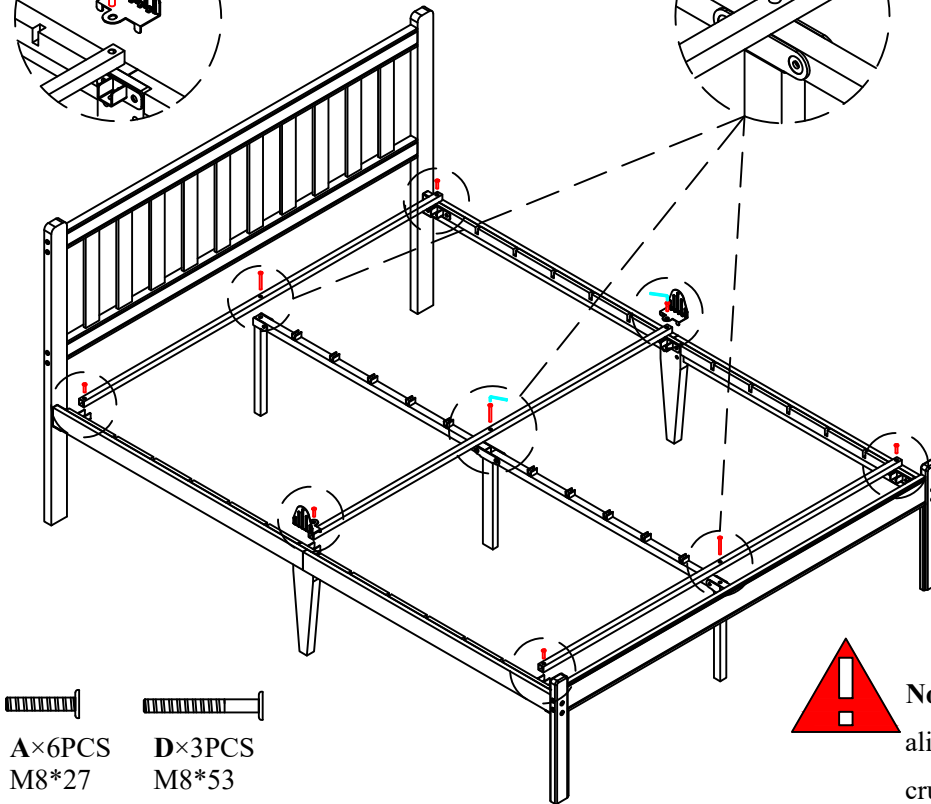
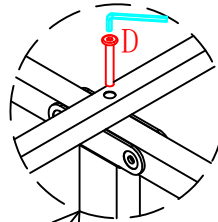
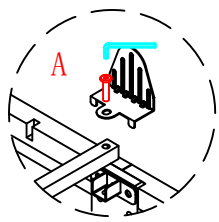
- Align the mounting brackets on the side rails with the corresponding holes on both the headboard and side bracket.
- After all the bolts are in place, use the included hexagonal wrench to tighten bolts (B).
- Use bolt (E) to lock connector-B ⑬ onto the side bracket.



Step 8

Install the Center Support Rail

- Attach the center support rail ⑥ to both ends of the bed frame using bolts (B).

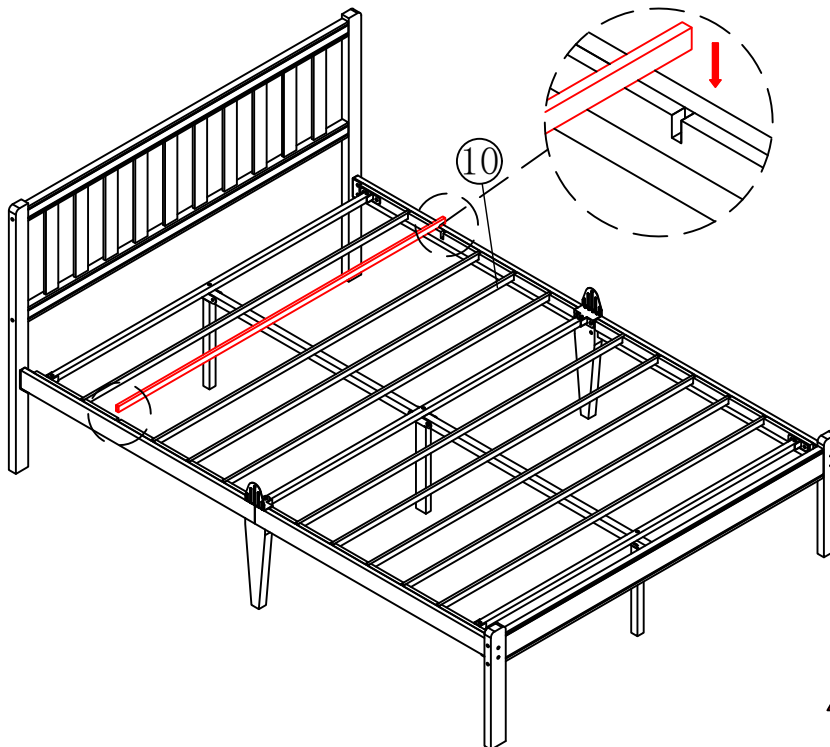


Note: Ensure all connections are properly aligned before final tightening. This step is crucial for the bed's stability.

Step 9

Install the Center Support Bar

- Use bolts (A) and bolts (D) to lock the center support bar ⑧ onto the center support rail .
- At the center, mattress gasket ⑭ can be optionally installed.
- After installation is completed, tighten all the bolts.



Note: Before completing assembly, double-check that all screws and components are fully tightened.

Step 10

Install the Bed Slats

- Place all bed slats ⑩ across the side rails.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Warning

- 1. Age Restriction:** The bed is not designed for children under 4 years old.
- 2. For your safety:** Jumping, rough play, or other vigorous activities on the bed are not recommended as they may cause injury or damage to the bed frame.
- 3. Weight Limit:** The maximum combined weight on the bed should not exceed 1000 lbs. This includes the weight of the bed itself, mattresses, bedding, and people.
- 4. Do not drag or push the bed frame:** Always use two people to lift and reposition the bed frame to avoid damage to the frame or the floor.

Cleaning&Care

- 1. Cleaning method:** Use a dry or slightly damp soft cloth for cleaning. Avoid abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- 2. Hardware maintenance:** Over time, hardware can loosen. Regularly check and tighten all connections to maintain the bed's stability and prevent damage.
