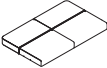
Elegant Lounger



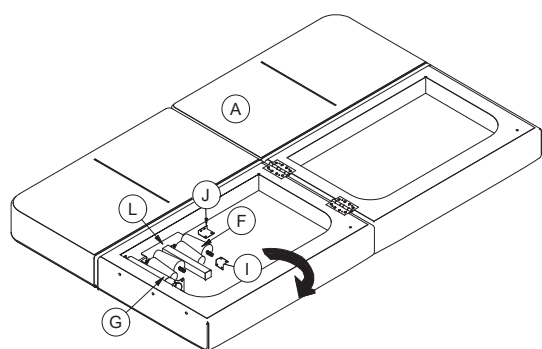
Legs & hardware are stored at the bottom of sofa, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.

Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to spliting or cracking the wood.

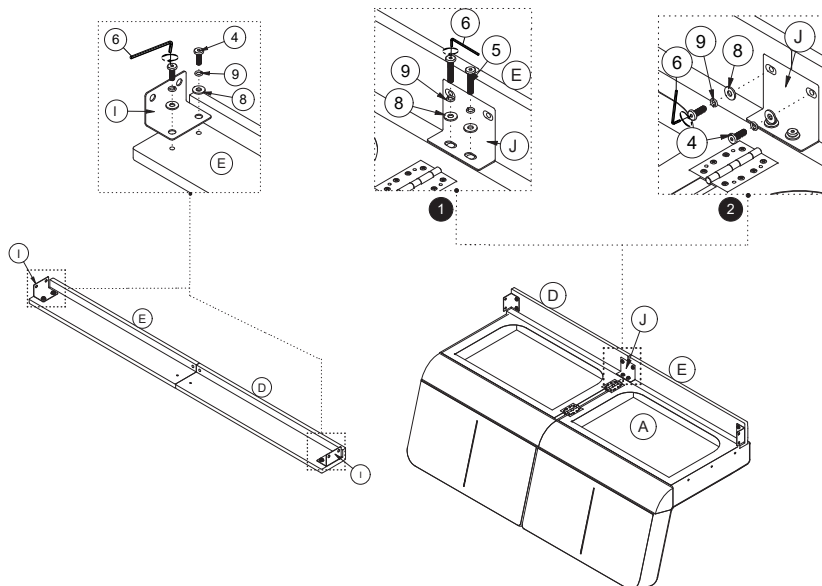
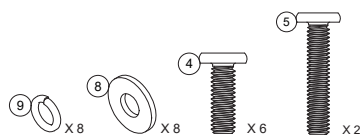

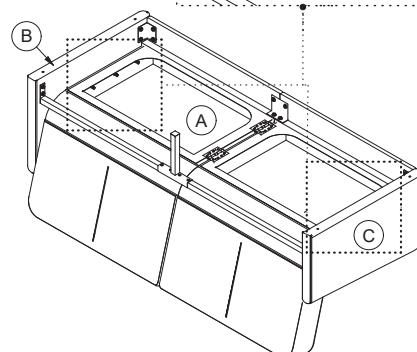
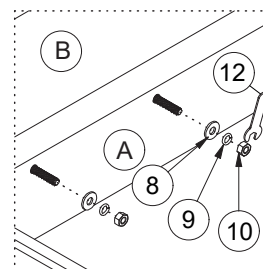
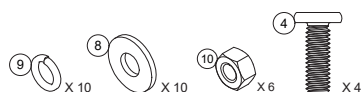
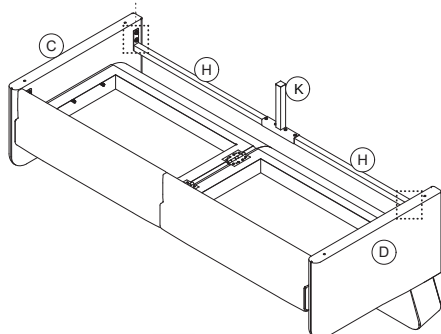
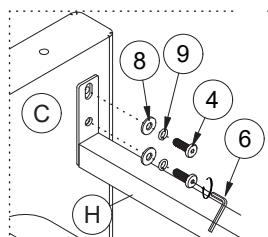
▲ Legs and Hardware will be found in the compartment under the seat as shown.



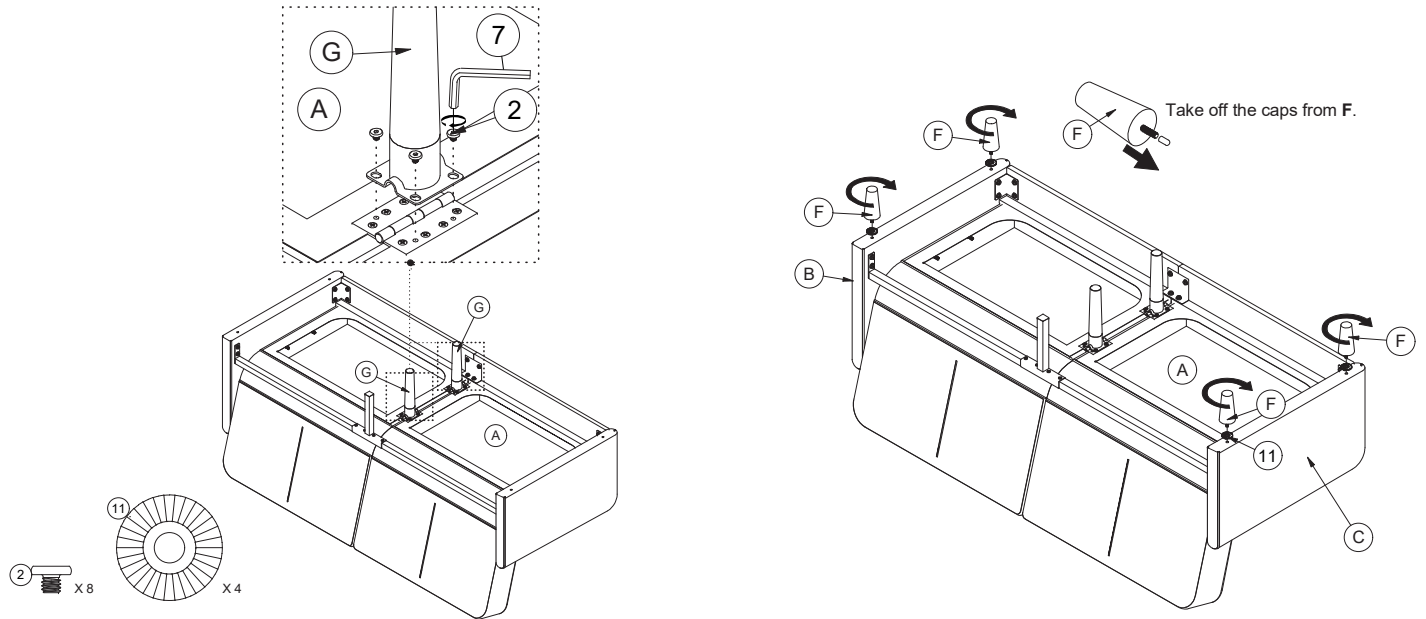

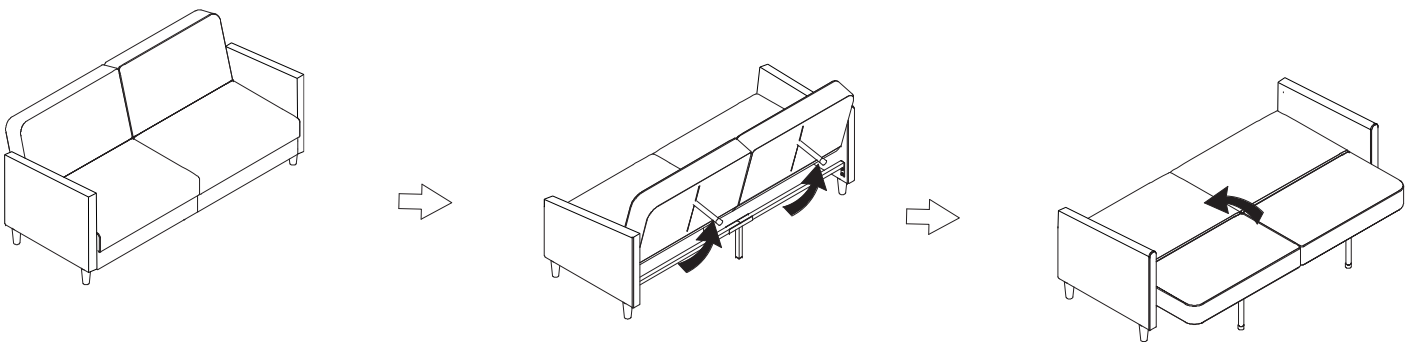

Care Instruction for PU Fabric Furniture:

In order to maintain the original appearance of your PU fabric Furniture, please follow below simple care procedures:

- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage PU Fabric.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connection are tight, re-tighten if necessary.



For items use on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to Install protective pads under all legs and supports to avoid/prevent from damages/scratches and discoloration.
