

1. Daily Cleaning

- Dust with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.
- For fingerprints on the matte surface, wipe with a cloth lightly dampened in a 1 : 10 solution of mild dish soap and water, then buff dry.
- Avoid paper towels—they can leave micro-scratches on low-sheen finishes.

2. Spill & Stain Treatment

- Blot liquids immediately; do not rub.
- For sticky residue, use a cloth dampened with a 50 / 50 mix of water and white vinegar. Wipe in grain direction, then dry.
- Never use abrasive powders or ammonia/bleach cleaners—they cloud the matte sealant.

3. Heat & Moisture Protection

- Always place coasters under hot mugs, trays or electronics.
- Use felt pads under décor to prevent surface scratching.
- Maintain indoor humidity between 35–55 % to minimise seasonal wood movement.

4. Monthly / Seasonal Maintenance

- Rotate books and décor so the finish ages evenly.
- Check and retighten mounting bolts every 3 – 4 months with the supplied Allen key.
- Once a year, apply a beeswax-based wood conditioner to refresh lustre—test first on the underside.

5. What to Avoid

- ✗ Abrasive pads, steel wool, or magic-eraser sponges.
- ✗ Silicone furniture sprays or wax polishes (they streak matte finishes).
- ✗ Dragging the table—lift to move; dragging stresses the arch pedestal joints.
- ✗ Prolonged direct sunlight—use blinds to reduce UV fade.
