


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Guidelines

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS COULD RESULT IN INJURY

- Do not stand on the item or use as a step ladder
- Do not use this item unless all bolts and screws are firmly secured and fastened.
- Check all bolts and screws every 90 days. As necessary tighten if any are loose.
- Lift the product when moving. Pushing or dragging this item can result in injury or cause damage to your floor.

Pre-Assembly:


Please read through this instruction booklet before beginning assembly of this item.

Assembly should be completed by two adults.


- Assemble in a large, clear space and lay out all of the parts on the Parts List to make sure all of the pieces are included.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.
- Keep small parts and pieces away from children and pets.
- Check for loose screws and tighten them before use.

WARNING: DO NOT LET CHILDREN PLAY IN OR AROUND THE UNIT DURING ASSEMBLY DUE TO THE POSSIBLE RISK OF INJURY.




Step 1-- 1. Remove all parts from the carton and place them on a protected surface or carpet.

- 2. Make sure all parts and hardware match the Parts List.
- 3. Attach the Legs (3) to the Headboard (1) and Footboard (2). Tighten by hand.




Step 2-- 1. Connect the Support Legs (5) to the Center Support Bar (4) with Bolts (F), then use the Allen Key (E) to tighten.

2. After installing the Support Legs (5), adjust the leveler to your preferred height.




- Step 3-- 1. Connect the Side Rails (3) to the Headboard (1) and Footboard (2) with Bolts (A), Spring Washers (B) and Flat Washers (C). Use the Allen Key (D) to tighten.
 - 2. Connect Center Support Bar (4) to Head Board (1) and Foot Board (2) with Bolts (A), then tighten with Allen Key (D).




Step 4-- 1. Place the Double Plastic Caps (8) on the Central Rail (4) as shown below.


- 2. Lay all of the Slats (7) in two rows across the base of the bed. The slats must be convex side up with the ribbon on the underside. The assembly hole on the slat end must be on the outside position. Next, insert the end of the slat into the Plastic Cap (8).
- 3. Place the Plastic Pin (H) on the slats to the Side Rail (3) as shown below.



Step 5-- Place the bed onto a flat level surface and level the bed, then fully tighten all the Bolts (A) with Allen Key (D).



You should routinely check (every 90 days) the bolts to make sure they are fully tightened. **ATTENTION**: Make sure the bolts are tightened before using the bed.



Product Dimension

Limited Warranty

The product you have purchased is warranted against defects in material and workmanship while owned by the "Original Purchaser". The term "Original Purchaser" is defined as that party or entity that purchases these products from and authorized dealer or retailer as shown by the original sales receipt. This warranty does not apply too "as is" or previously owned products.

The manufacturer warrants its products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship (normal wear and tear, fading and stretching excepted), for one year from the date of purchase, except as provided below under the limited warranty.

This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state (or country to country). All warranties are limited to the Original Purchaser for normal use.

The exceptions or exclusions to this warranty are:

- Upholstery material and foam cushion material is warranted against defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year, beginning on the date of purchase as shown on the original sales receipt.
- Any warranty claim that is submitted after the limited warranty period, or without proper proof of purchase will not include the cost of parts, labor, or delivery on the warranted parts within a reasonable amount of time. We reserve the right to require damaged parts to be returned to us upon request. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, color variations, etc. will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects.
