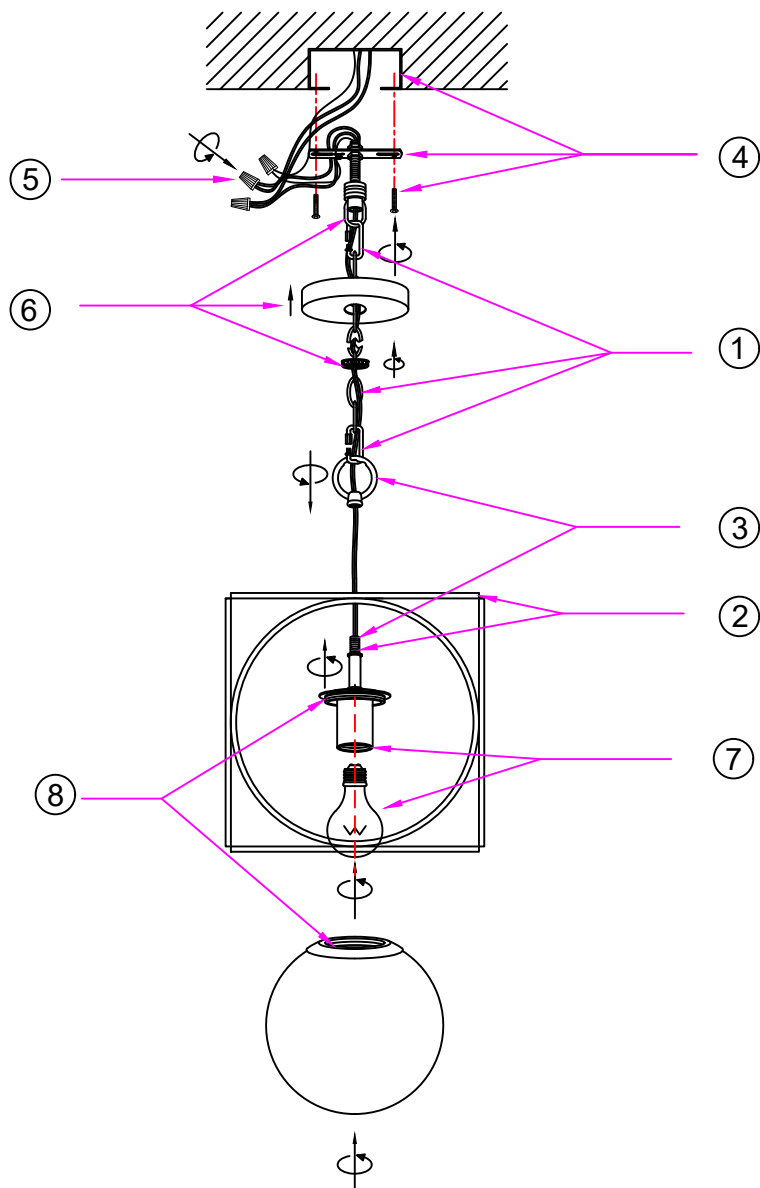


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Adjust the height of the suspension chain and the wire by loosening the swivel hook.
 2. Screw the lamp socket onto the lamp body.
 3. Align the suspension ring with the fixture's threaded pipe and tighten.
 4. Secure the mounting plate to the U.S.-standard junction box using screws.
 5. Connect the output and input wires with connector.
- Note: Connect the black (live) wire to black, white (neutral) wire to white, and ground wire to the grounding terminal. Ensure no exposed wiring remains during connection.
6. Secure the metal ring and the canopy to the mounting plate.
 7. Screw the bulb into the lamp socket. (Bulb Not Included)
 8. Align the metal threads of the glass globe with the socket's upper threads and tighten clockwise.
 9. Restore electricity and test the bulb for proper operation.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
