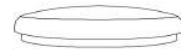
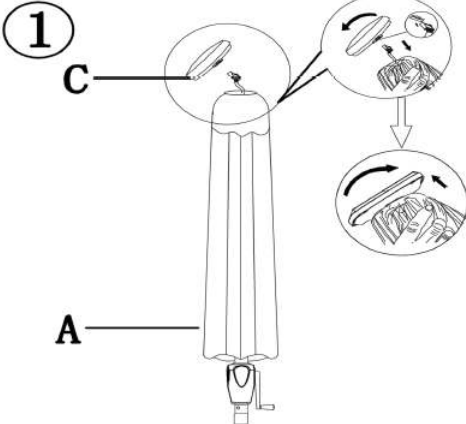


UMBRELLA ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Note : Leave the solar receiver out in a sunny area to charge before the first time turning on the LED lights.

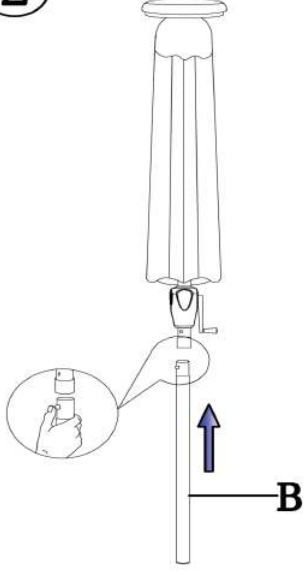
Step 1: Put the solar panel on the top of the umbrella and connect the wires and plug. Once connected, attached the solar panel to the umbrella by pushing down and rotating clockwise until panel is secure.

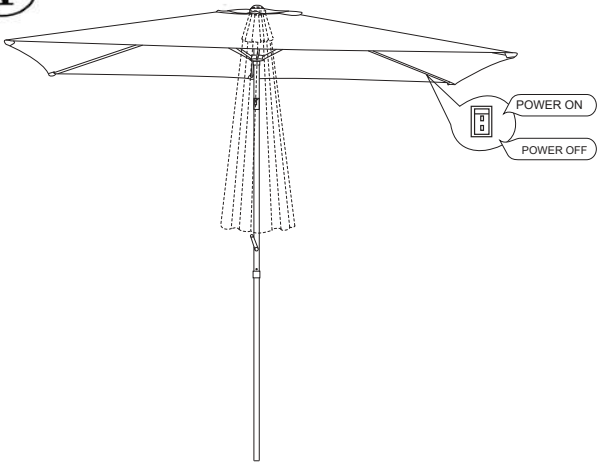
Step 3: Pull out ribs away and turn the crank handle in the clockwise direction to open the umbrella canopy, and in the opposite direction to close the canopy. To close the umbrella it must be in the upright position.

Step 2: Attach the bottom pole of the umbrella until the pole snaps in place.

Step 4: Press the light switch to turn the lights on / off. Put the solar umbrella in the sunlight to charge the batteries before the first use.

REMINDERS:

Make sure to charge the batteries for at least 8 hours before the first use. If charging the solar panel while attached to the umbrella, make sure the switch on the pole is in the off position. Please note that the battery can discharge if it is left unused or uncharged for a long period of time.

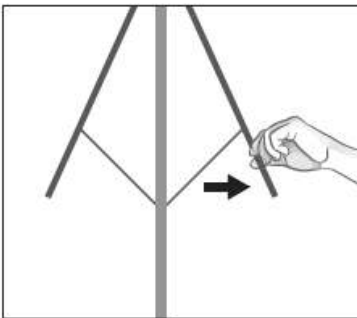

CARE AND DIRECTIONS

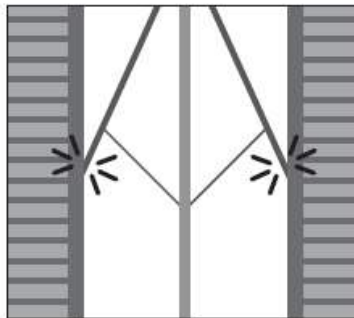
Always close the umbrella in its stand when not in use or in windy weather. It is best to remove the top section of the pole (that holds the umbrella canopy), and lay it flat when not in use. To clean the umbrella cover, rinse with a solution of mild soap and warm water and allow to air dry. Always use an appropriate weighted base with your umbrella, even if it is being used with a table. In the event that you are using the umbrella without a table, you must use a free-standing base that is heavy enough to provide support for the umbrella.

ONE (1) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY ON MANUFACTURING DEFECTS

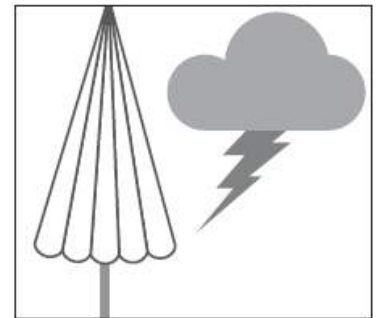
