

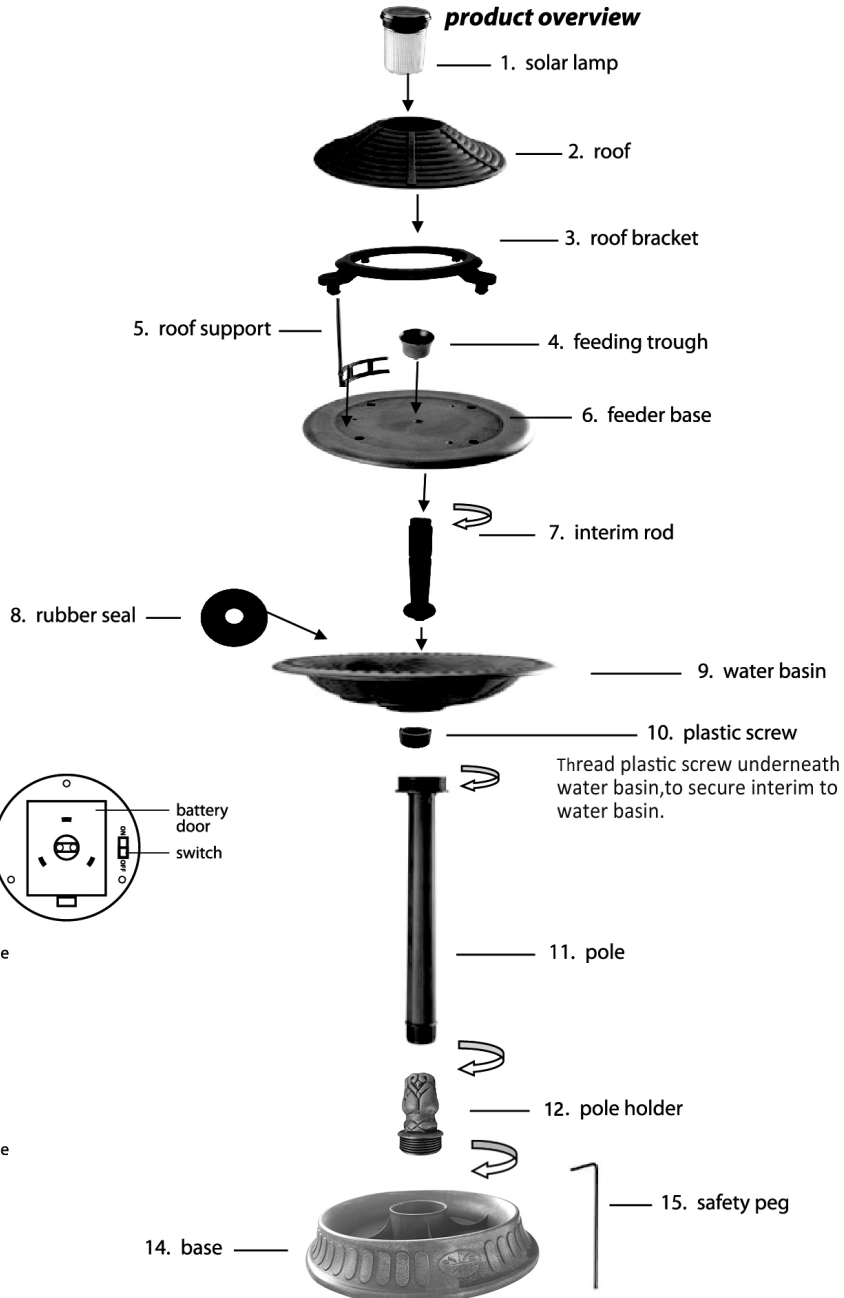
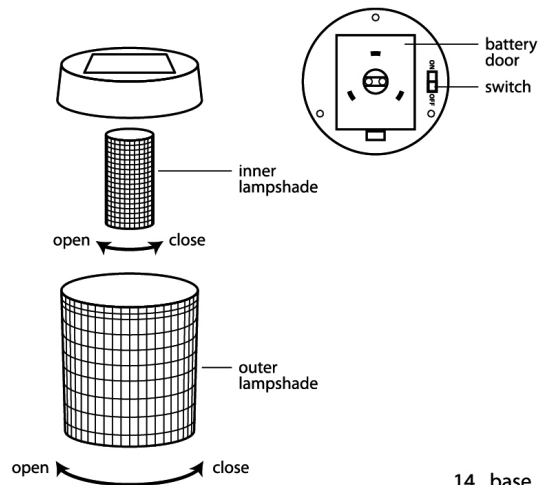
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT:

PLEASE READ THE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING.

- 1. solar lamp X 1
- 2. roof X 1
- 3. roof bracket X 1
- 4. feeding trough X 1
- 5. roof support X 4
- 6. feeder base X 1
- 7. interim rod X 1
- 8. rubber seal X 1
- 9. water basin X 1
- 10. plastic screw X 1
- 11. pole X 1
- 12. pole holder X 1
- 14. base X 1
- 15. safety peg X 3

Note: assemble it from base to top.



Assembly & start up

For the purpose of safety, lay out a protective sheet during assembly in order to prevent damage to the floor. Please refer to the diagram for instructions during assembly of bird bath.

1. Set the base(14) on an even surface and screw the pole holder(12) to the base(14).
2. Screw the pole (11) to the pole holder (12).
3. Now assemble the water basin(9), securely into position together with the rubber seal(8) and the interim rod(7), which comes down from above, to the plastic screw(10).
4. Screw the fully assembled water basin(9) onto the pole(11).
5. Place the feeder base(6) on the interim rod(7).
6. Insert the feeding trough(4) into the locator hole situated in the middle of the feeder base(6).
7. Insert the 4 roof supports(5) into the corresponding locator holes on the feeder base(6) and plug the roof bracket(3) into the roof supports(5).
8. Finally, place the roof(2) on the roof bracket(3) and insert the solar lamp(1) into the corresponding hole in the roof(2).

Your bird bath is now in an assembled state and ready for use.

You can now select a location for the bird bath and secure it to the ground using the enclosed safety pegs x 3 (15).

Turning on the solar lamp

In order to activate the solar lamp, remove the solar lamp from the roof and set the switch to ON. To turn it off, set the switch to OFF. Remark: the product requires 8 hours charging in the sunlight for 8 hours of solar light at night time for the first time and ongoing.

Changing the batteries

The solar light comes with a battery - 1 x Rechargeable Ni-MH AA 300mAh 1.2V. Please keep the battery dry. Please proceed very carefully during the operation. Defective rechargeable batteries must be removed and disposed of responsibly. To protect the environment, batteries must not be thrown in the domestic garbage, or disposed of in a fire as they contain dangerous materials. Dispose of the batteries by taking them to your local waste collection service to be recycled.

1. Remove the lamp's outer and inner shades by turning them counter-clockwise.
2. Remove the battery door.
3. When inserting the new rechargeable batteries, ensure that the polarity is correct.
4. Replace the inner and outer shades on the lamp.

Note : Do not overexert during this procedure to avoid the breakage of the solar light.
