

Step 1: Measuring the bottom of your planter.

If you can't turn your planter upside down, here is an easy way to measure:

1. Place two pieces of tape or ribbon parallel to each other on either side of the planter.

2. Use a tape measure to measure the distance between the ribbon pieces. This will be the diameter of your planter.
