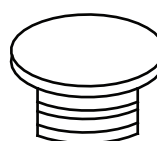

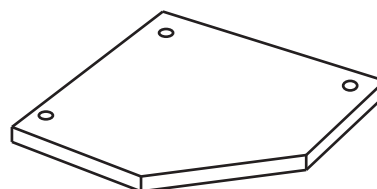
For ease of identification all hardware is organized into separate Hardware Packs for each Step in the Instruction Manual.

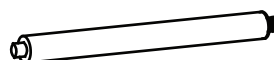
(A) End Caps X 5



(B) Shelves X 3



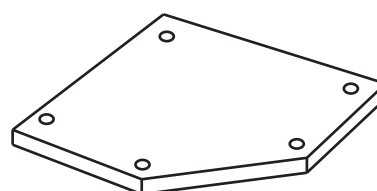
(C) Metal Poles X 9

(G) Eyelet Screw X2

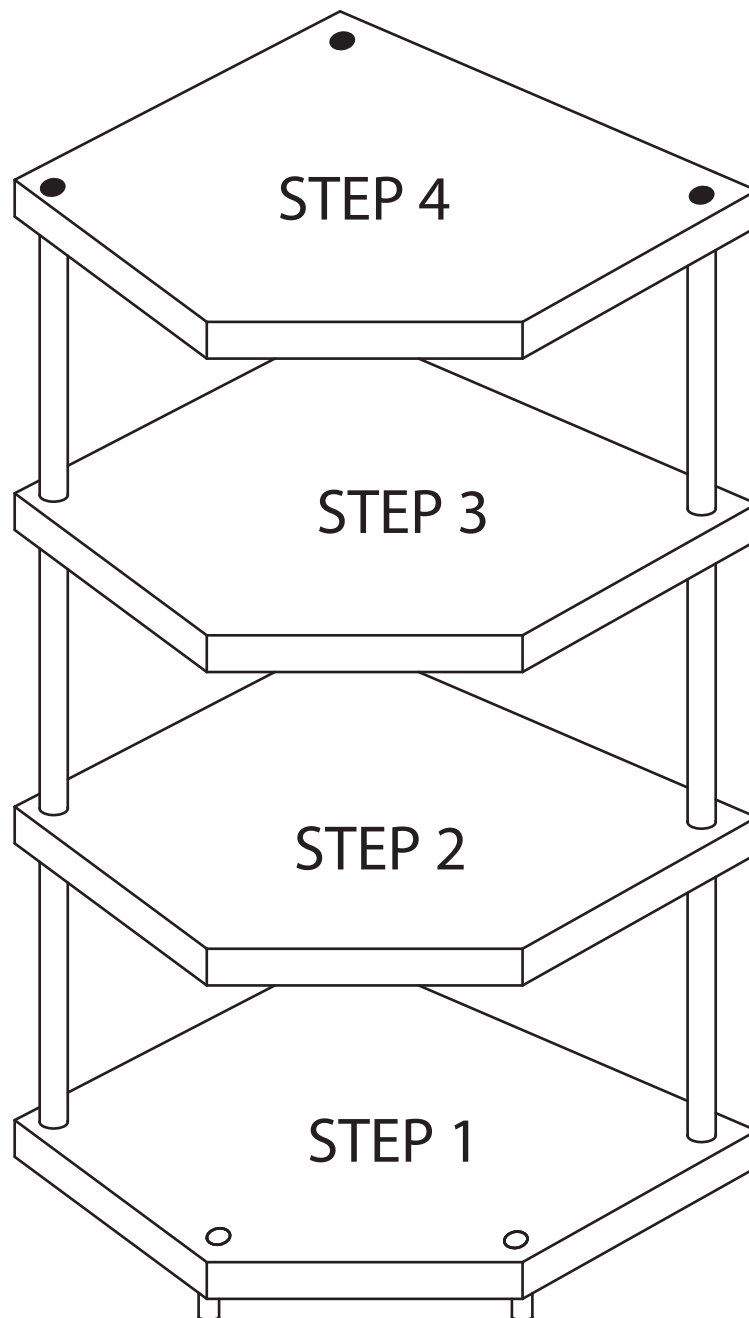


(H) Cable Tie X2

For ease of identification all parts are labeled to correspond to the Step number in which the part is used.

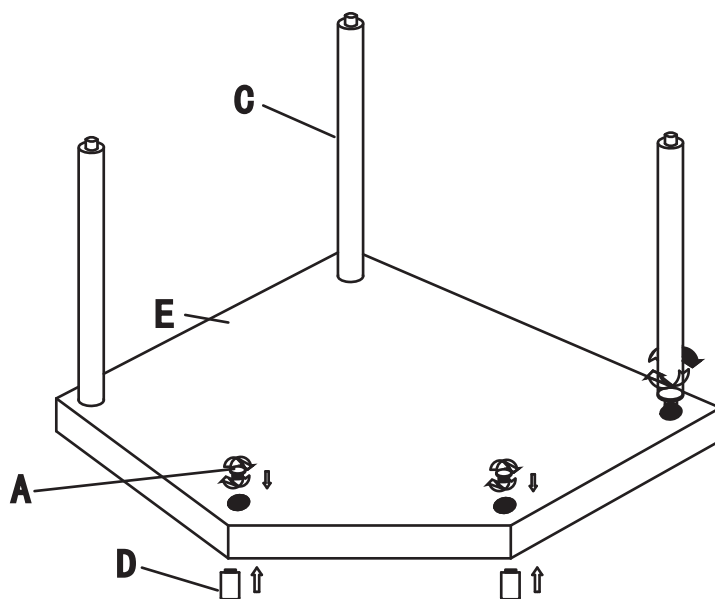
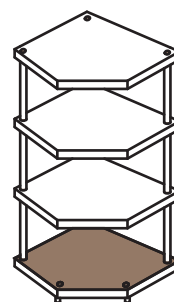


## STEP #1

### SHELF ASSEMBLY

## STEP 1

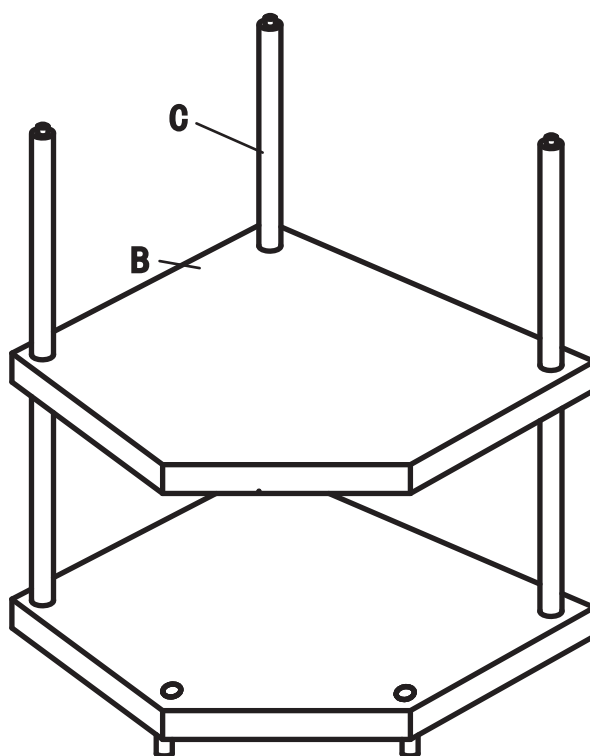
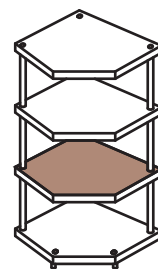
- (1) Place Bottom Shelf (E) on top of Plastic Feet (D).
- (2) Gently screw Poles (C) into Plastic Feet (D) using care not to over tighten.
- (3) Screw chrome End Caps (A) into Front Feet (D).

## STEP 2

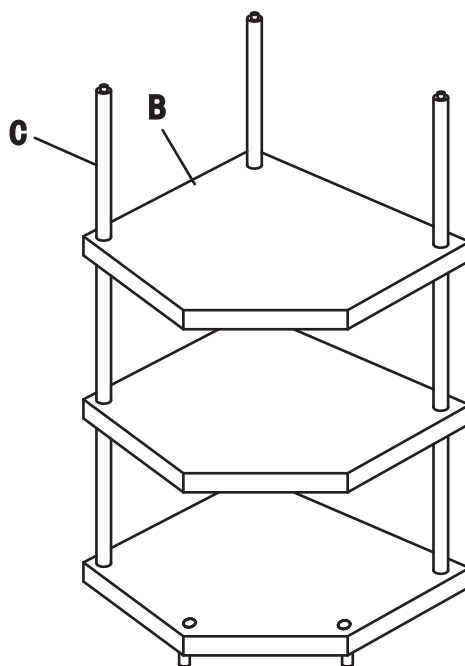
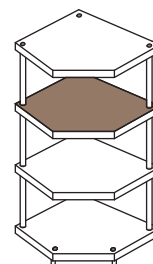
- (1) Place Shelf (B) onto Metal Poles (C).
- (2) Gently screw another set of Poles (C) into unit using care not to over tighten.

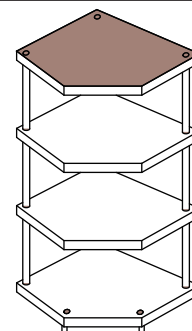
(1) Repeat STEP 2.

## STEP #4

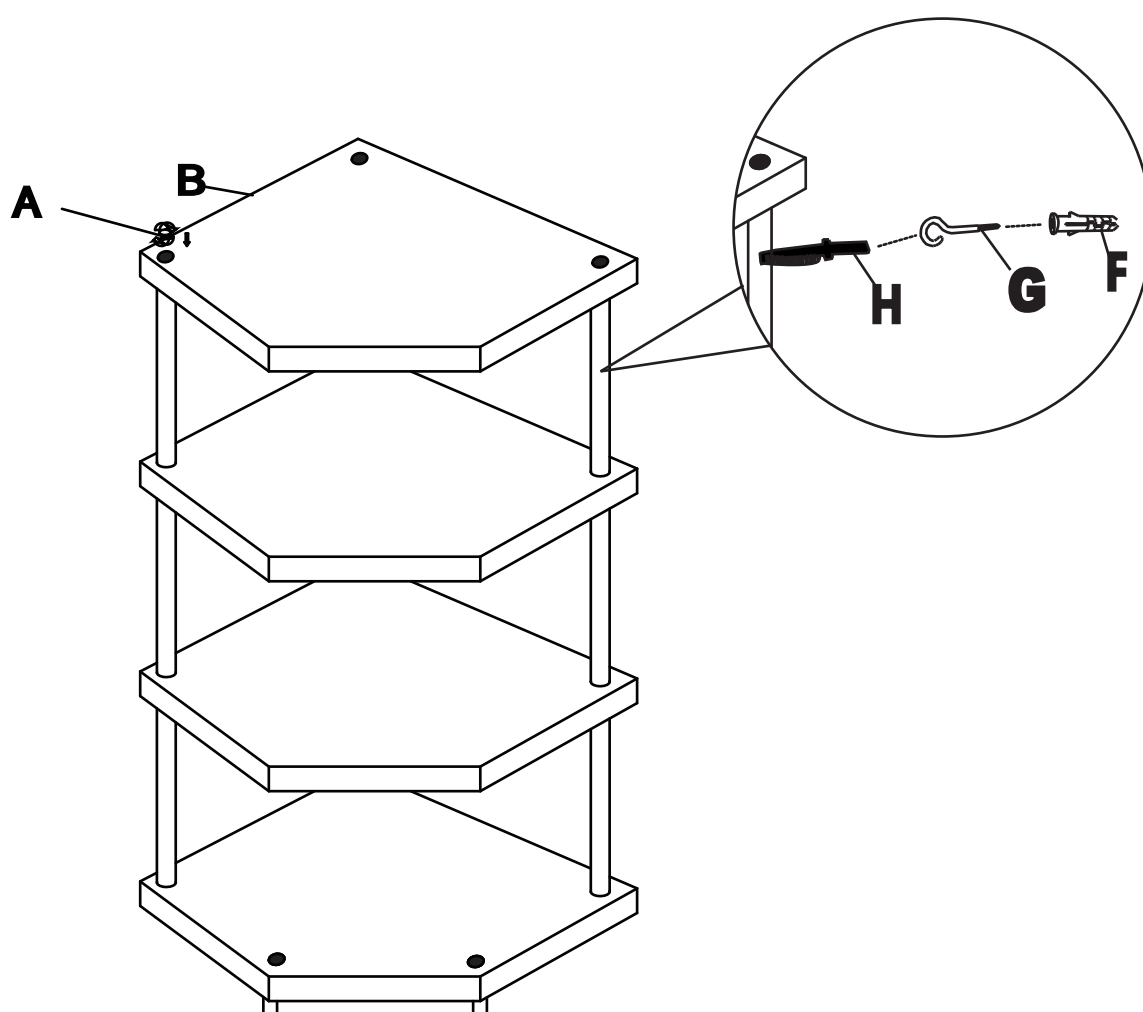
### SHELF ASSEMBLY

Shelf 4

**Hardware Pack 1**



- (1) Place Shelf (B) onto assembly.
- (2) Fasten End Caps (A) using a clockwise rotation.



- (3).Drill hole slightly smaller than anchor (F) into drywall and gently tap anchor into hole.
- (4).Insert eyelet screw (G) into anchor and fasten unit to wall using cable tie.
