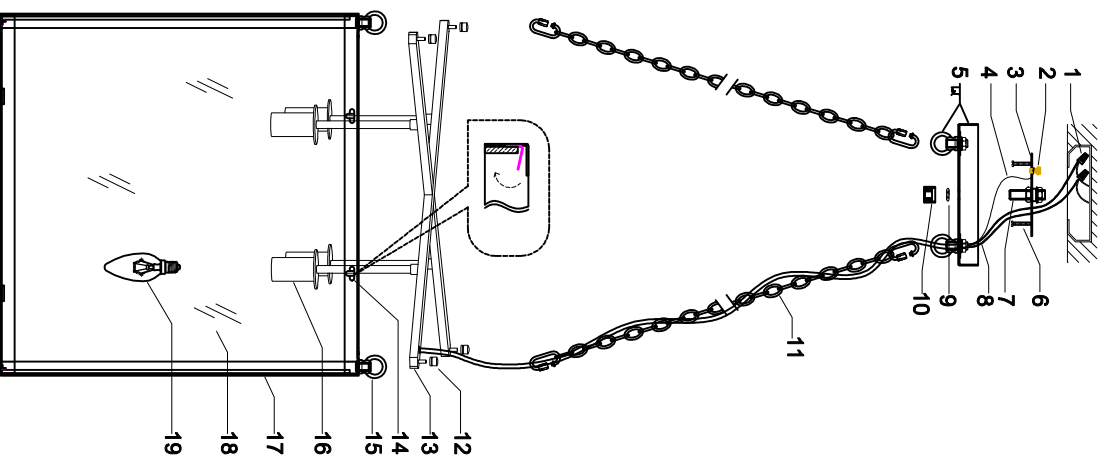
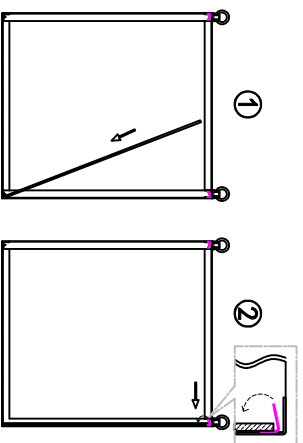


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



- Before You Begin:**
- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
 - Read all instructions carefully.
 - Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

- Step A. Loosen the decorative nuts (12) and remove the light arm (13).
- Step B. Install Glass Panels and Light Arm:
• Insert the glass panels (18) into the metal frame (17) from top to bottom.
• Pry up the glass retainers (14) inside the frame to secure the glass panels.
• Place the light arm (13) into the frame (17) at an angle. And secure the arm by tightening the decorative nuts (12).
- Step C. Route the main wires (8) and ground wire (4) through the suspension chain (11) and canopy (5).
- Step D. Attach the lower quick-link of the chain (11) to the suspension ring (15) on the fixture frame. And connect the upper quick-link to the suspension ring on the canopy (5).
- Step E. Secure the mounting plate (3) to the junction box using the provided screws (6).
- Step F. Connect Electrical Wires
• Use wire connectors (1) to connect the positive (marked) wire, the negative (unmarked) wire of the fixture's main wires (8) to the corresponding wires in the junction box
• Use a green screw (2) to connect the ground wires (4) on the mounting plate (3).
• Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
- Step G. Align the canopy (5) with the mounting plate studs (7). Hand-tighten the locknuts (9) onto the studs. Then, screw the decorative finials (10) over the locknuts until snug.
- Step H: Install the bulbs (19) into the sockets (16) as indicated on the diagram. (Bulbs Not Included)

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
