

INTERIOR DESIGNER TIPS

- 4 When placing a mirror above a vanity, console table, arm chair or fire place hang your mirror 6" 8" above the visual line. This will protect your mirror from water splashes as well
- 4 Choose a mirror that is 1-2 inches shorter than the width of the countertop of your bathroom vanity
- 4 Make sure that the mirror is tall enough so that your head doesn't get cut off when you look into it
- 4 When hanging your mirror above a nightstand, centre the mirror above the night stand
- If your mirror is going on a blank wall, centre it horizontally on the wall space and hang it so the vertical centre is at eye level- usually 60" from the floor
- 4 Hang mirrors with a buddy who can hold things up and give the chance to 'eyeball' your placement
- 4 ADA COMPLIANT MIRRORS Just make the bottom edge of the reflective surface is no higher than 40" off the ground

- 4 Measures 22" X 28":

(.5" bevel)

(Scalloped edge & 0.5" bevel)

(polished & frosted edge)

(double v-groove etches)

(8" grey glass "frame")

(molten glass frame)

4 Measures 24" x 36":

(1"bevel)

4 Measures 39.5" x 23.5": (polished edge)

4 All oval mirrors featured can be huna horizontally and vertically
