In each of the previous steps, tighten all screws to approximately 70% to stabilise the overall frame during assembly. Do not fully tighten any screws until the final step is completed.

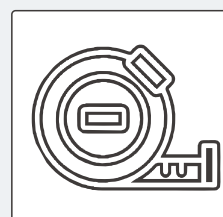

The headboard section assembly requires a total of labeled panels shown in the diagram. Please locate all of them and prepare them for use.

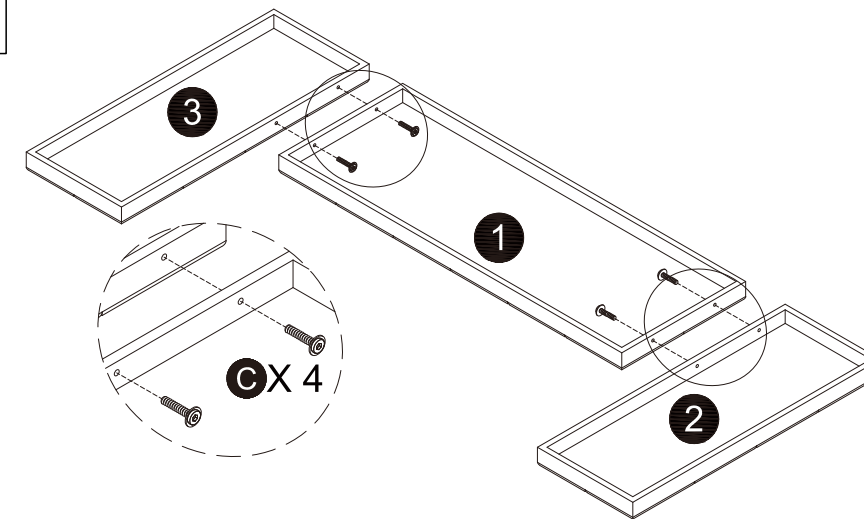
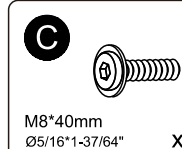

Step 1

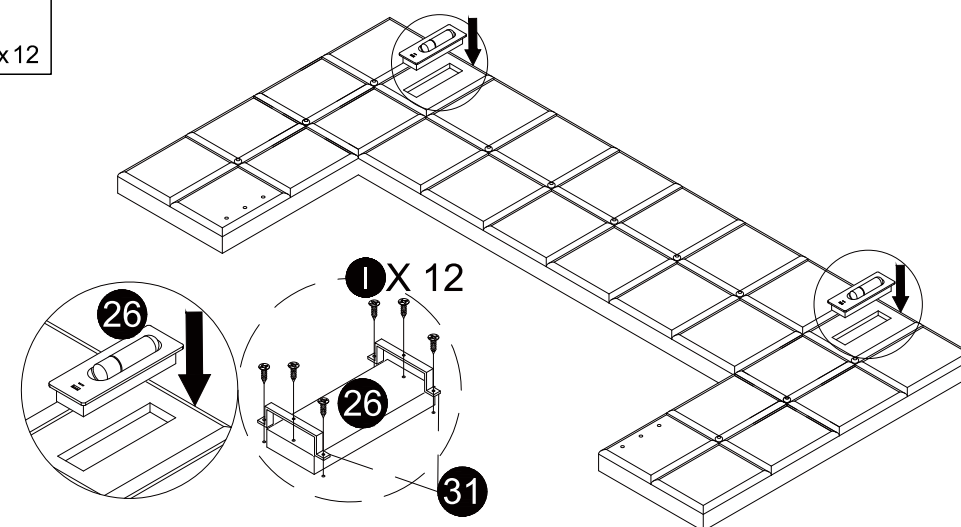
Headboard Section



Connect the left and right headboard side panels (2) and (3) to the center headboard panel (1). Tighten with screw (C).

Headboard Section

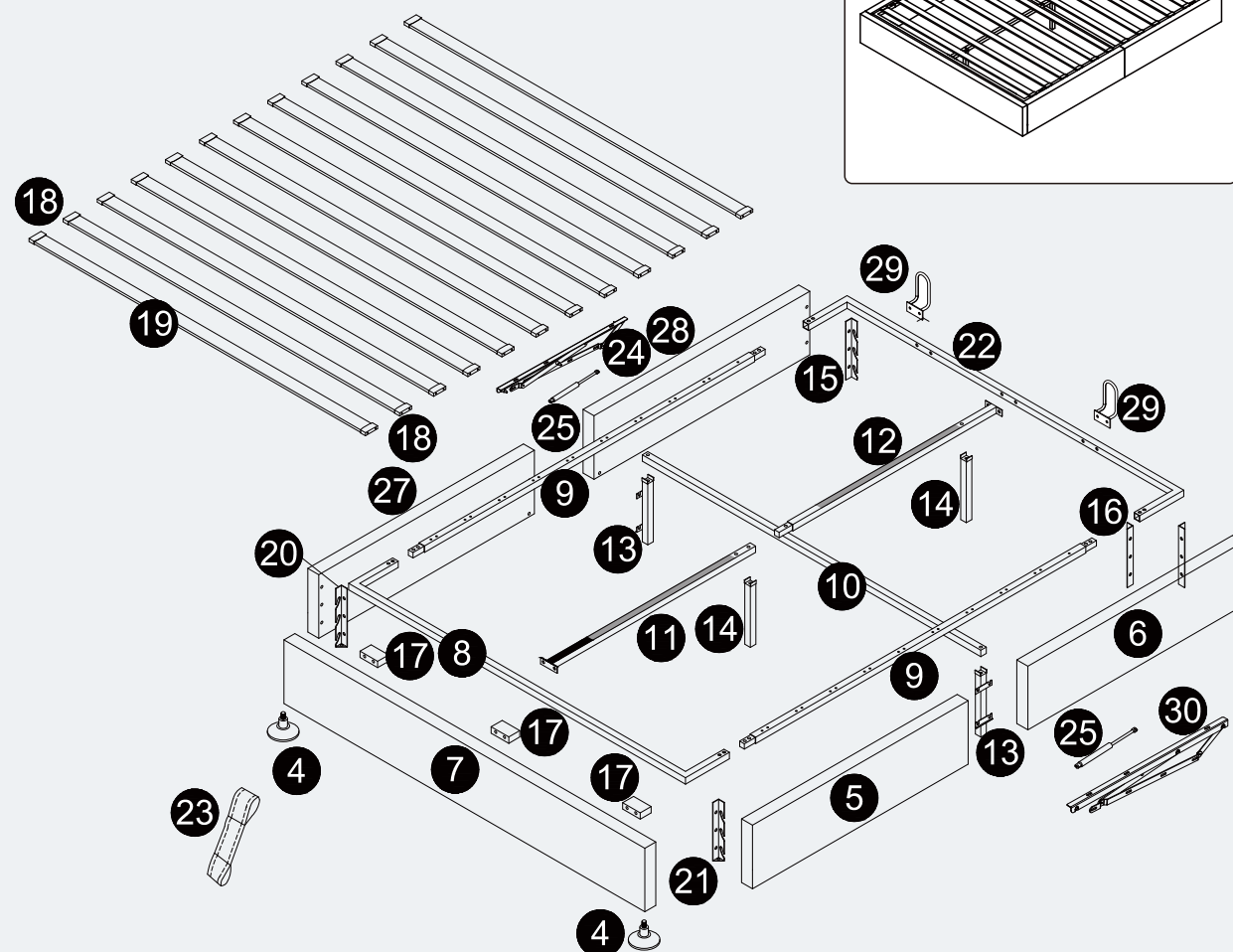


1. Install the spotlight (26) onto the left and right side panels (2) and (3).
2. Install the stop iron plate (31) onto the spotlight (26), and the left and right side panels (2) and (3), and secure it with the self-tapping screw (I).

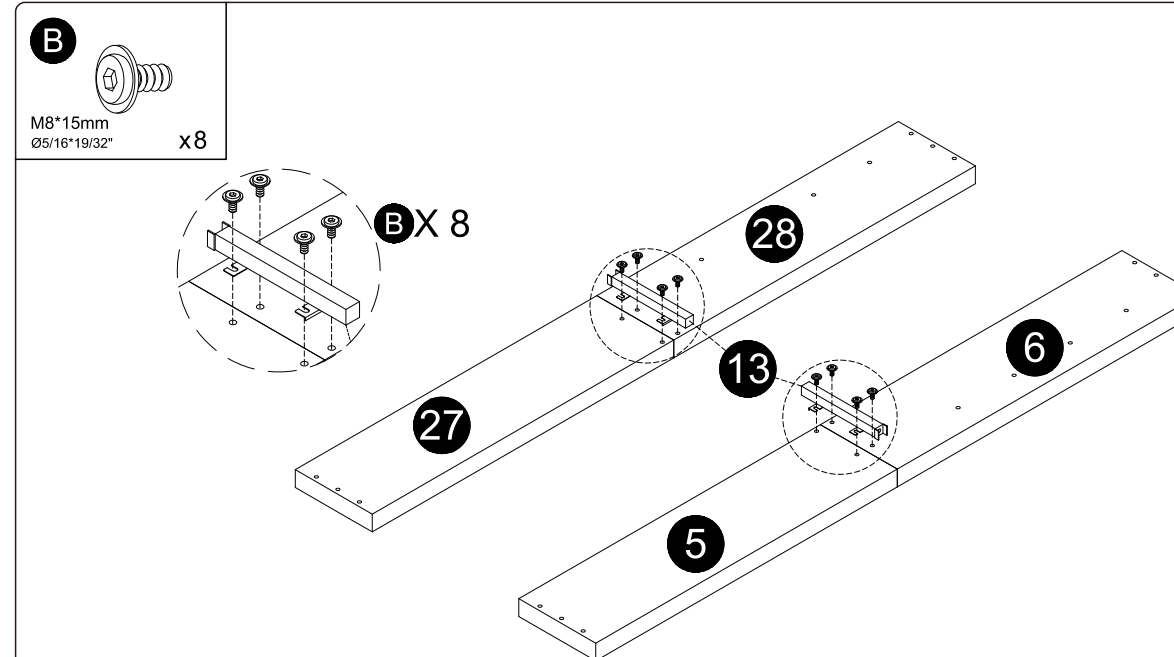

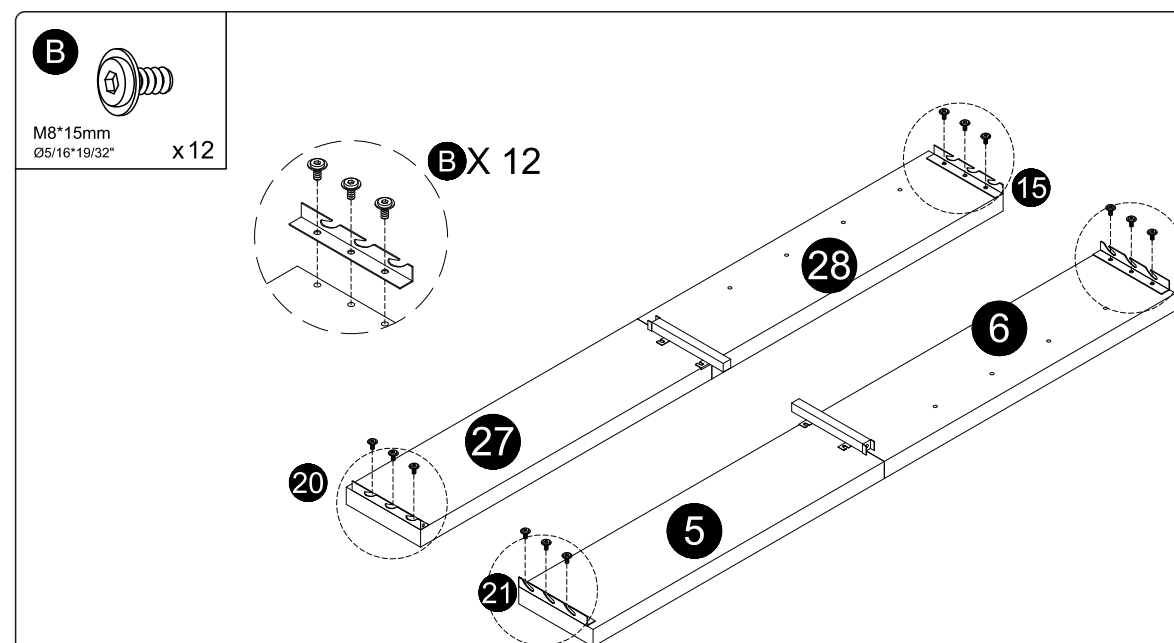

Connect the center support leg (13) to the bed rails (5), (6), (27), and (28). Tighten with screw (B).

Step 4

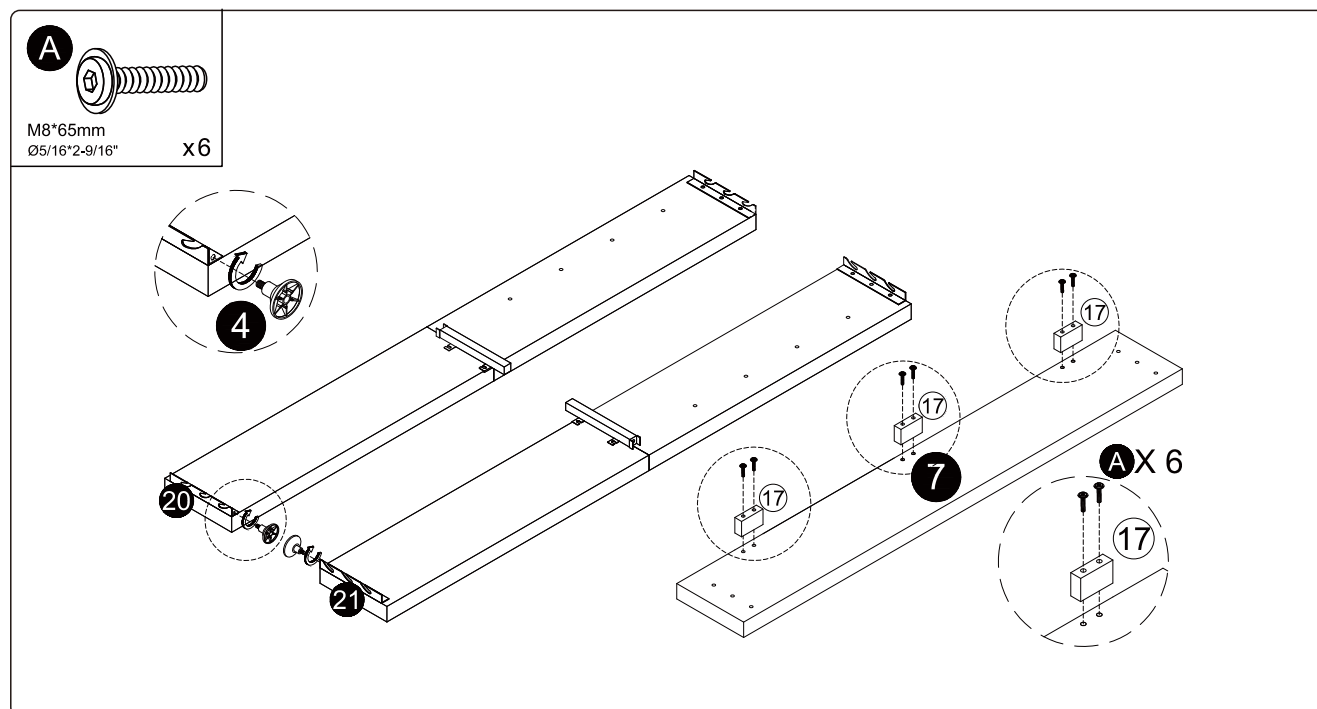

Connect hooks (15), (16), (20), and (21) to the bed rails (5), (6), (27), and (28). Tighten with screw (B).

Step 5

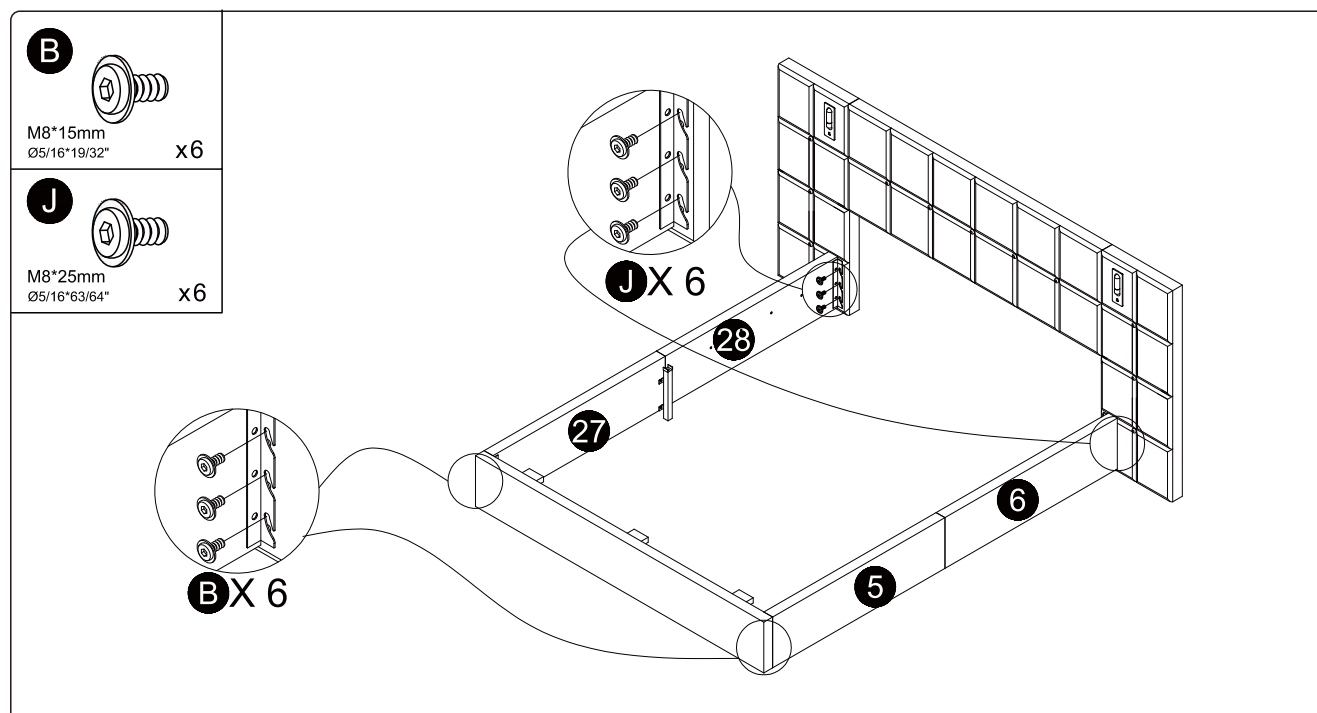
Frame Parts Section



1. Connect bed leg (4) to hooks (20) and (21).
2. Connect counterweight block (17) to the footboard (7). Tighten with screw (A).

Step 6

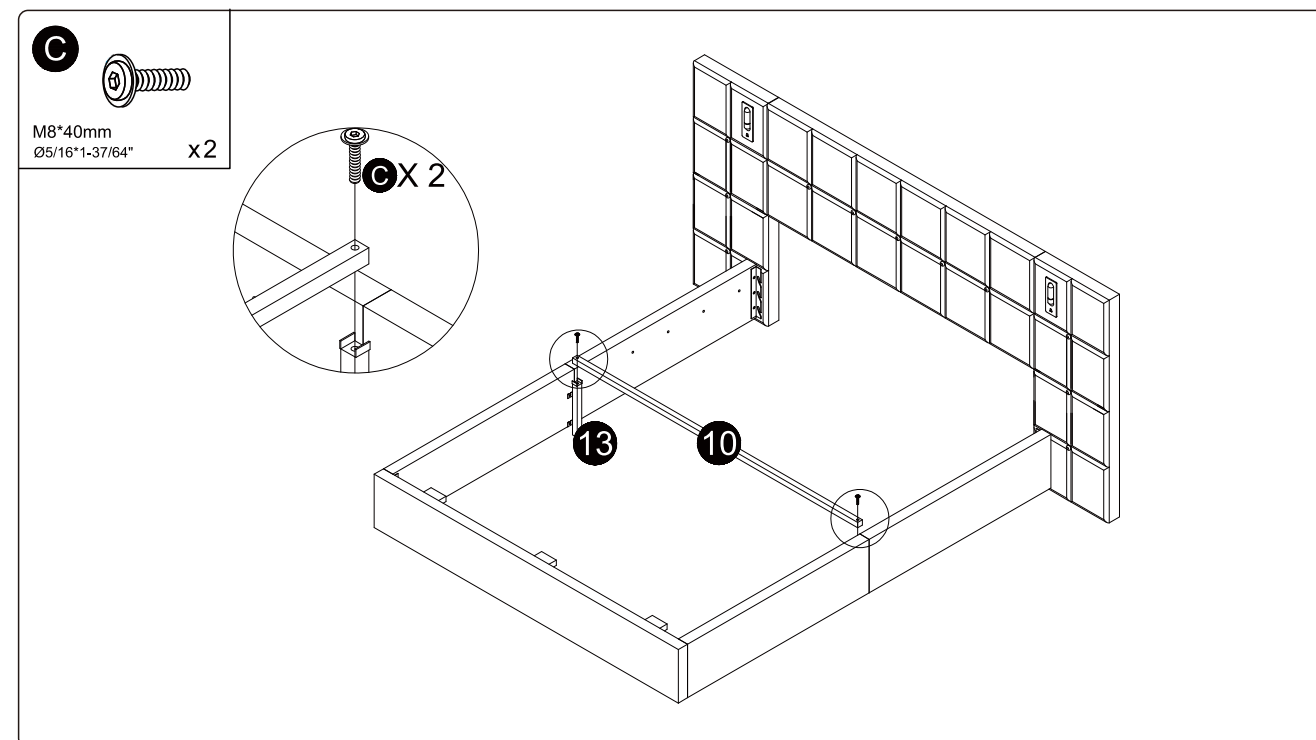
Frame Parts Section



1. Connect the assembled bed rails (5) and (27) to the footboard (7). Tighten with screw (B).
2. Connect the assembled bed rails (6) and (28) to the assembled headboard side panels (2) and (3). Tighten with screw (J).

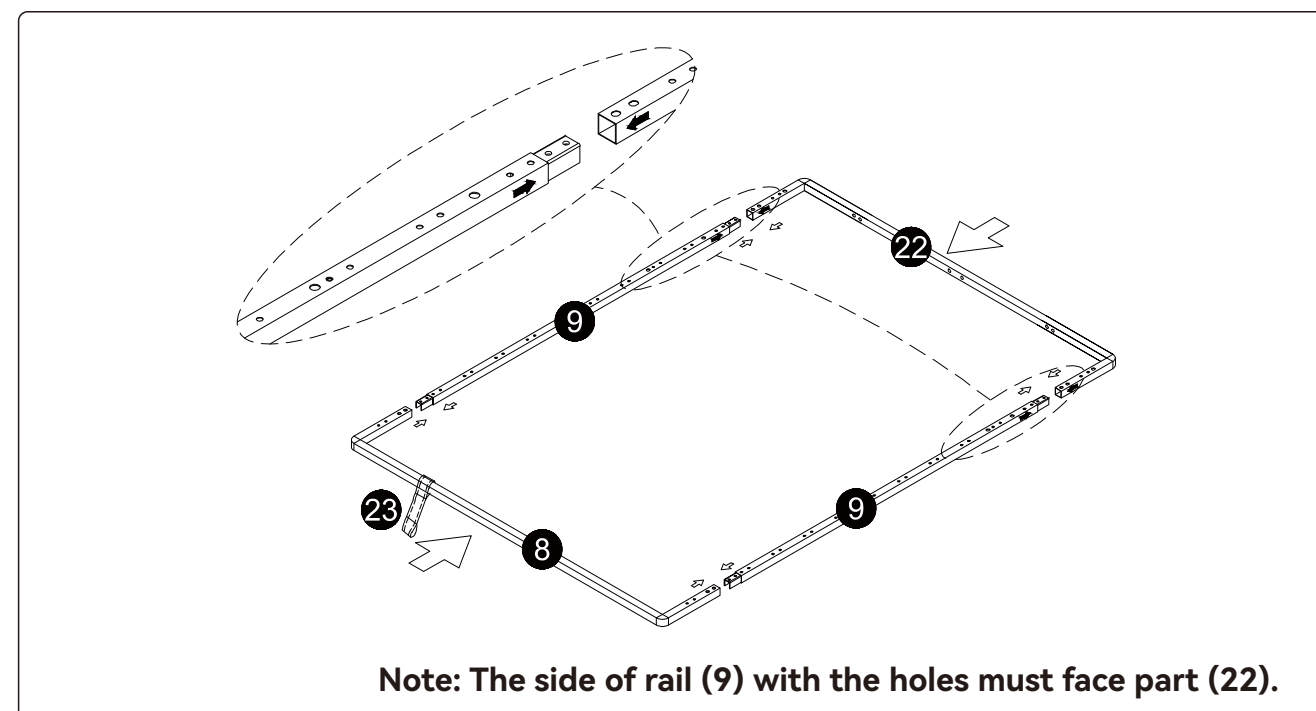

- Connect crossbar (10) to the assembled center support leg (13) of the bed rails. Tighten with screw (C).

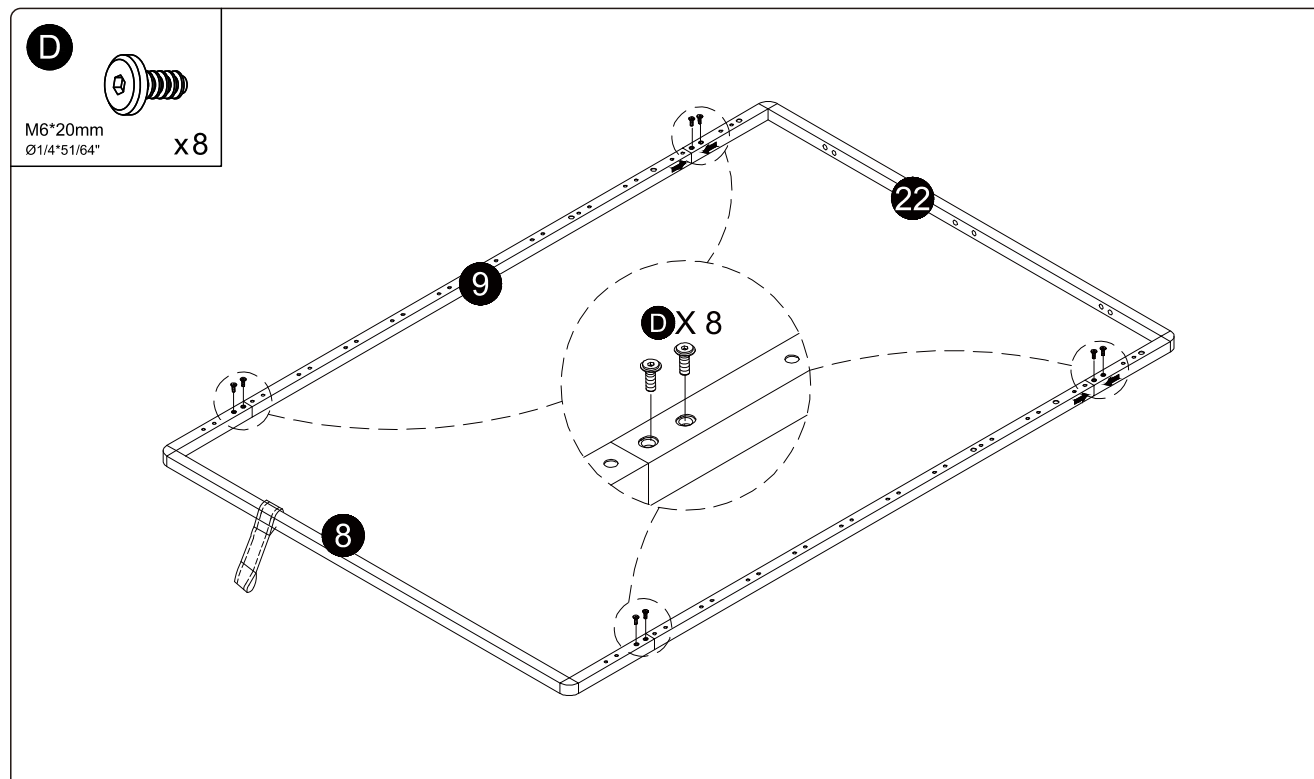

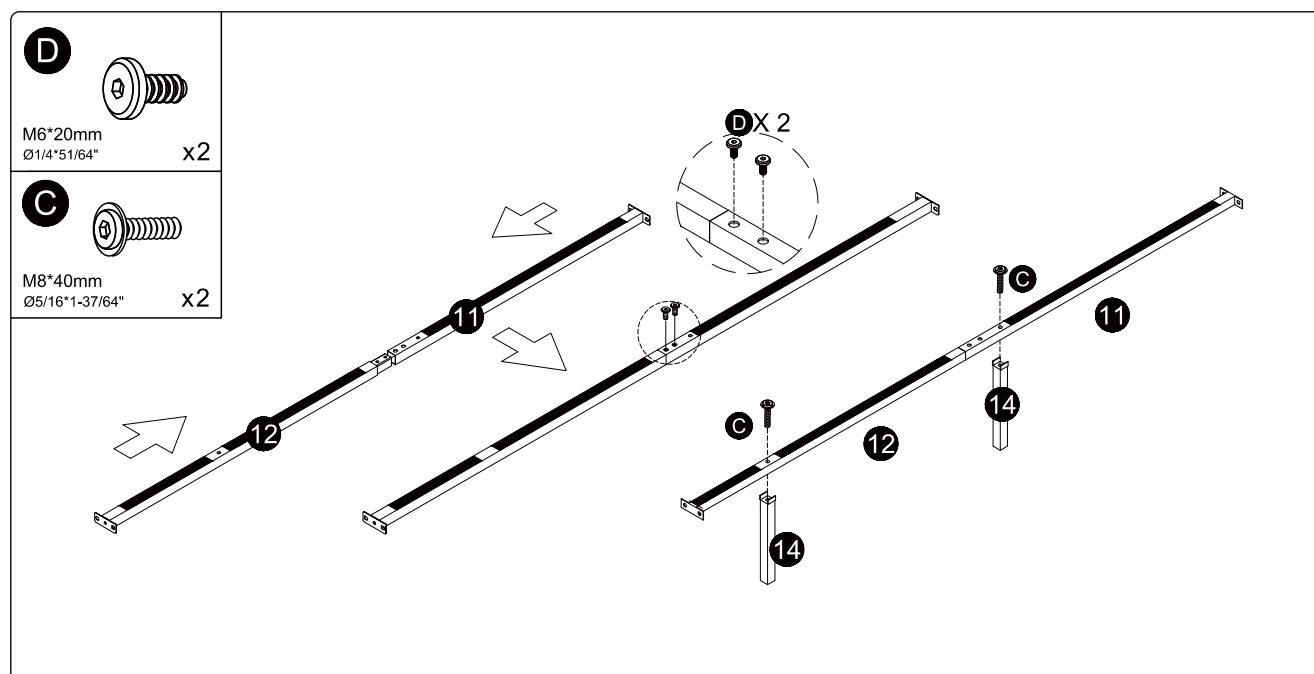

Connect assembled rods (8), (9), and (22). Tighten with screw (D).

Step 10

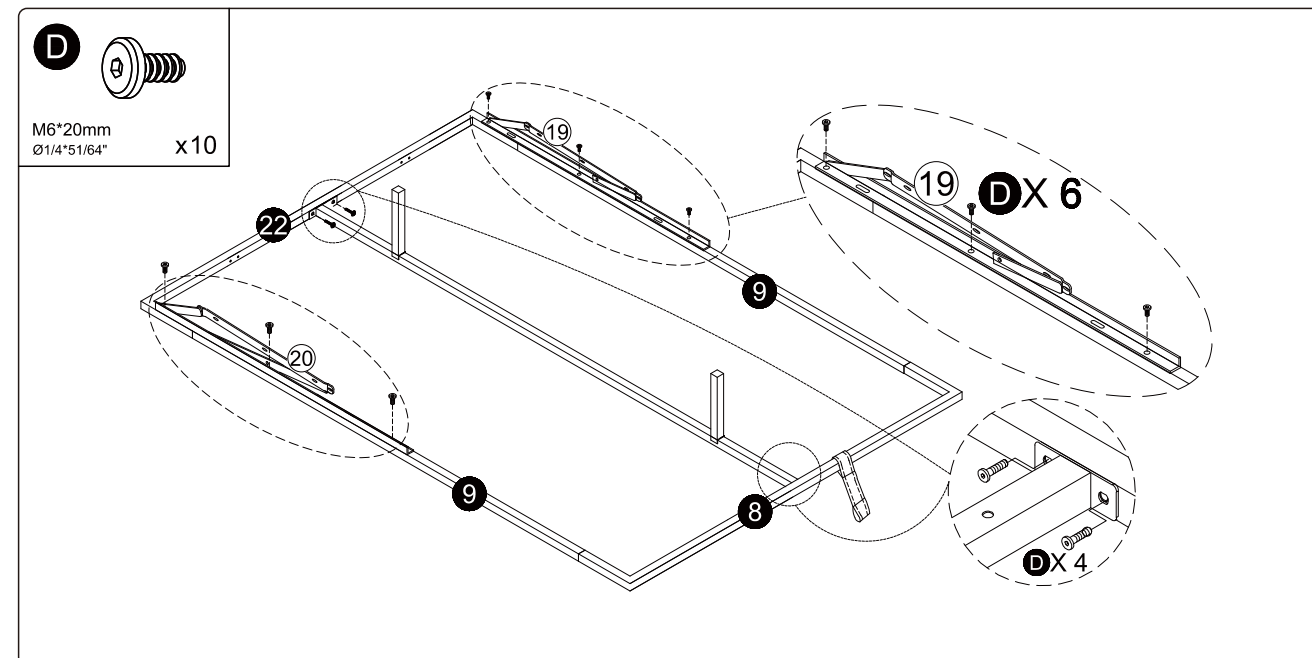
Frame Parts Section



1. Connect one end of center rod (11) with one end of center rod (12). Tighten with screw (D).
2. Connect the two center legs (14) to the assembled center rods (11) and (12). Tighten with screw (C).

Step 11

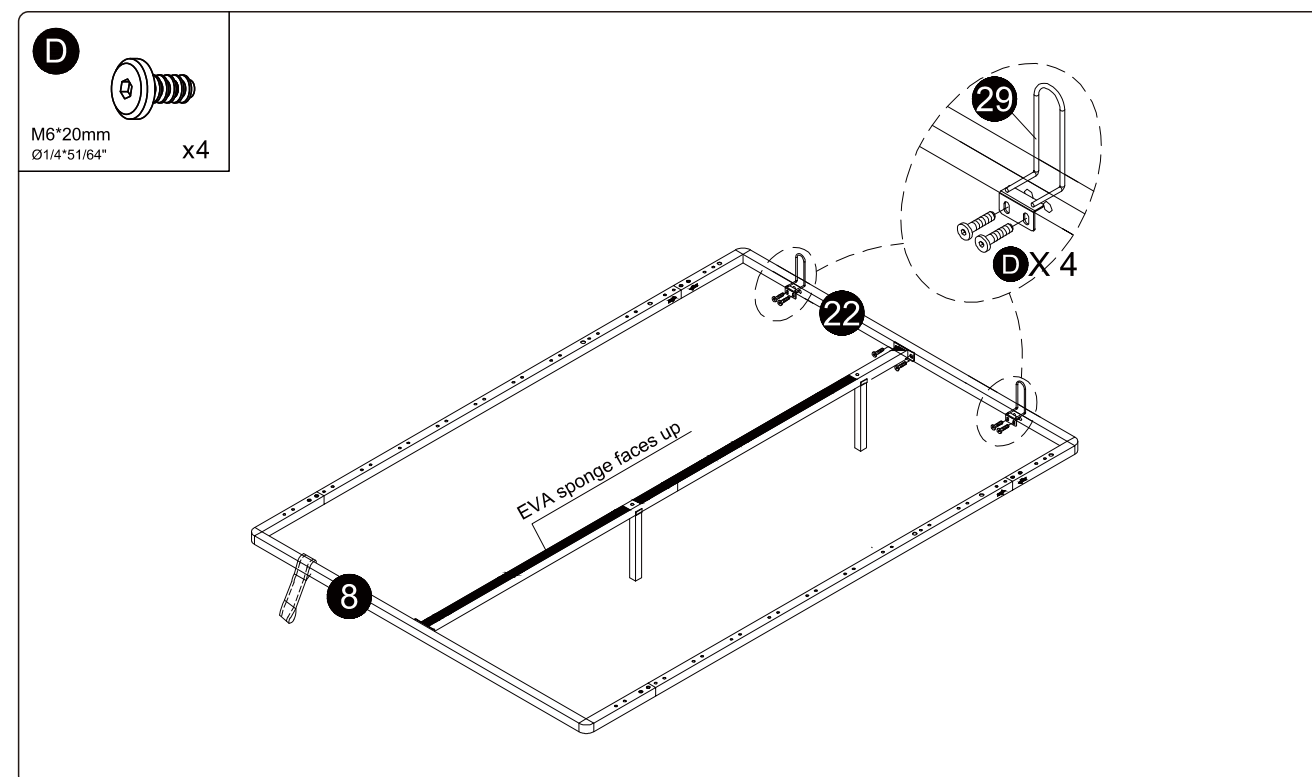
Frame Parts Section



1. Connect the assembled center rods to the assembled side rods (8) and (22). Tighten with screw (D).
2. Connect pneumatic frames (19) and (20) to bed rail (9). Pay attention to hole positions as shown in the diagram. Tighten with screw (D).

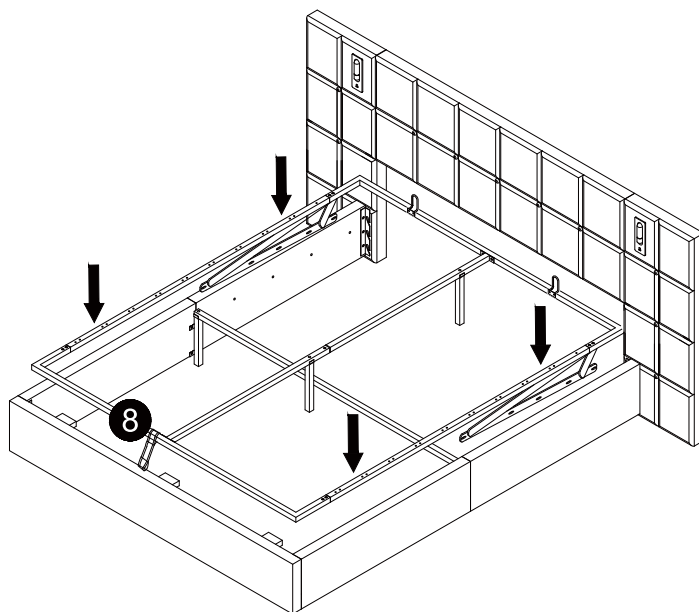

Connect anti-slip bar (29) to headboard rod (22). Tighten with screw (D).

Step 13

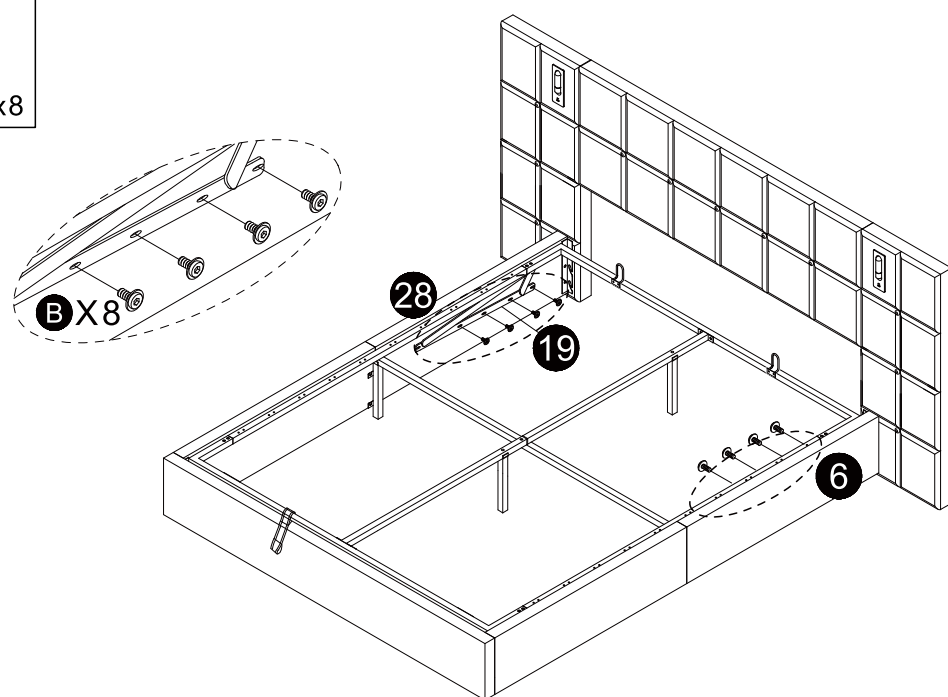
Place the assembled bed frame in the position shown in the diagram.

Note:

Part (8) must be at the footboard, and the support frame must face downward.

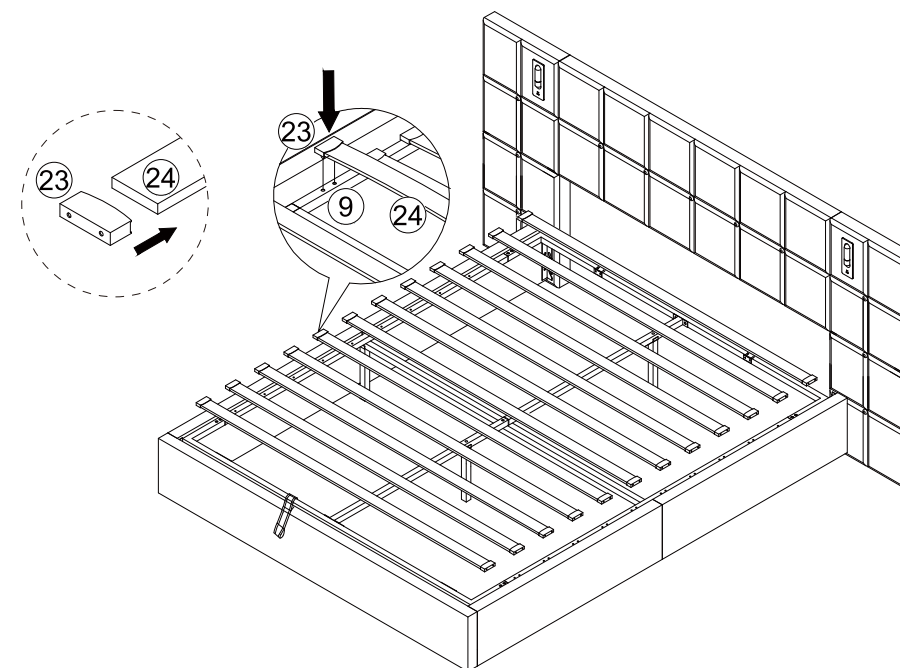

Connect the assembled bed frame to bed rails (6) and (28). Tighten with screw (B).

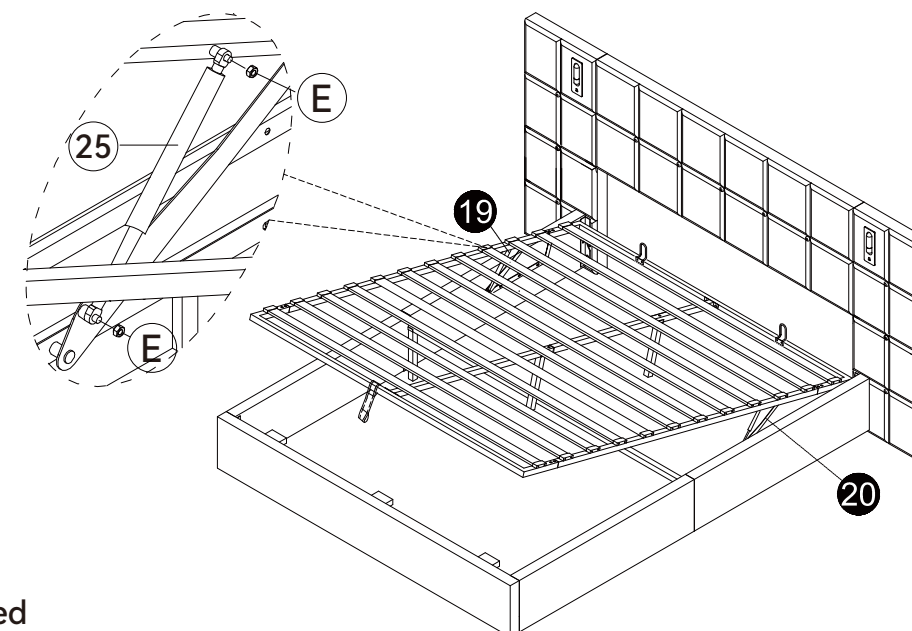
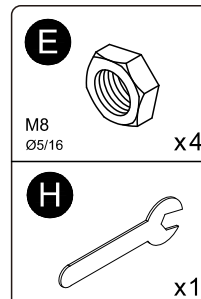

Attach plastic clip (23) to slats (24). After connection, press them onto side rail (9).

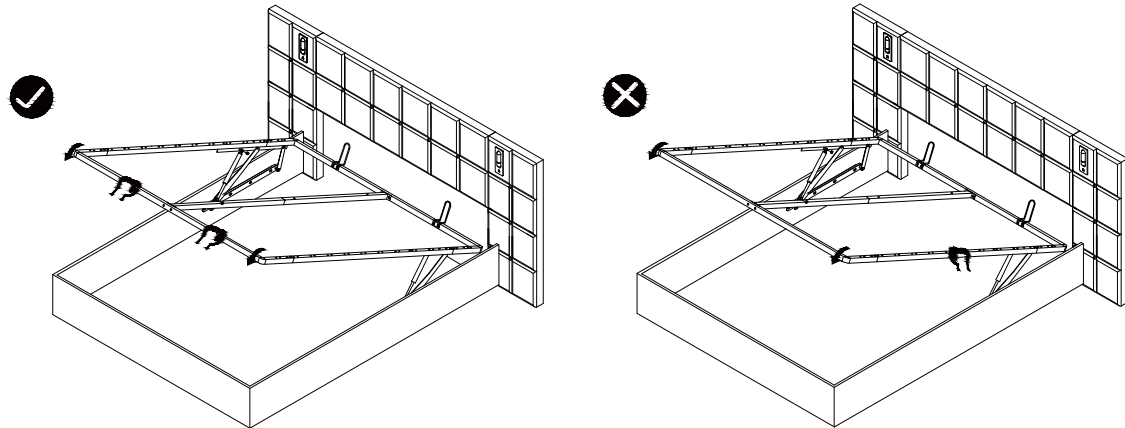
Connect the two gas springs (25) to the pneumatic frames (19) and (20). Fasten with nut (E). Tighten with handle (H).

Step 17

Note:

1. It requires extra force to push down when there is no mattress placed on it.
2. The hydraulic struts only function when mounted on the bed frame and cannot be actuated independently.

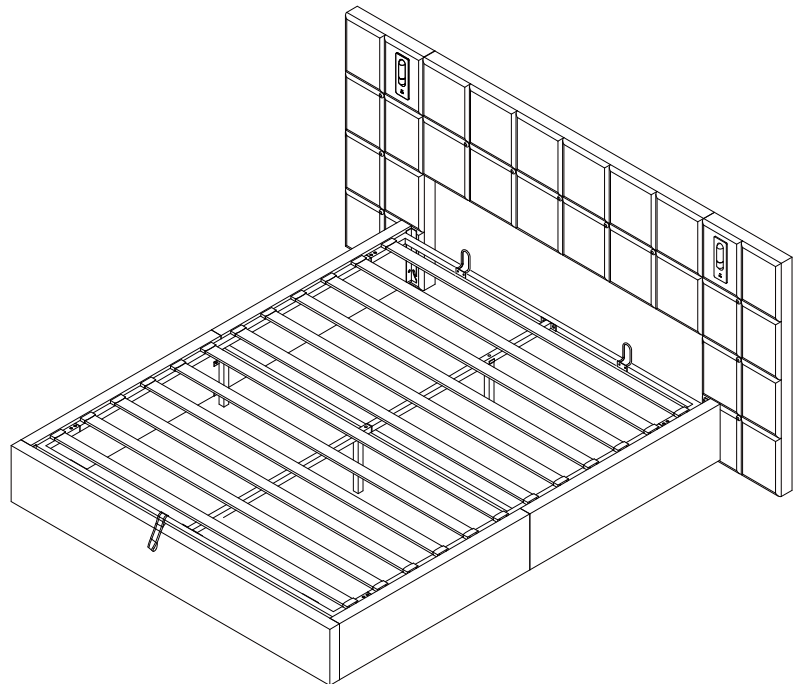


Operate from the foot of the bed
