Do not fully tighten hardware until all components have been loosely assembled.

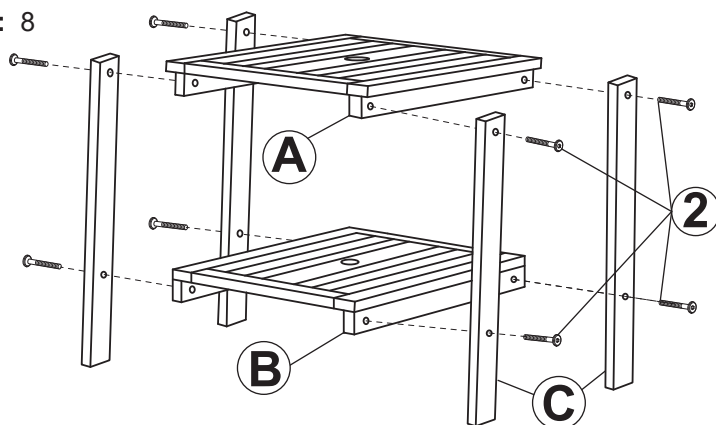
STEP 1

- Fasten Leg (C) to Tabletop (A) and Table Shelf (B) by hand-tightening two M6x40 Bolts (2).
- Repeat until all legs have been installed.
- Finish tightening all hardware.

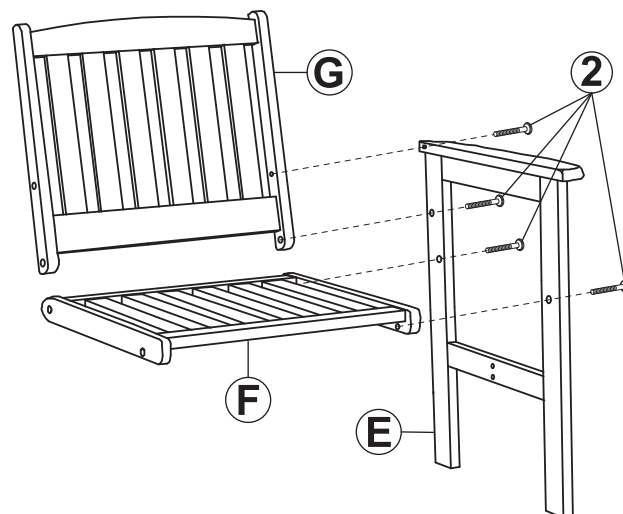
STEP 2

- Fasten Left Arm (E) to Seat (F) by hand-tightening two M6x40 Bolts (2).
- Fasten Backrest (G) to Left Arm (E) by hand-tightening two M6x40 Bolts (2).

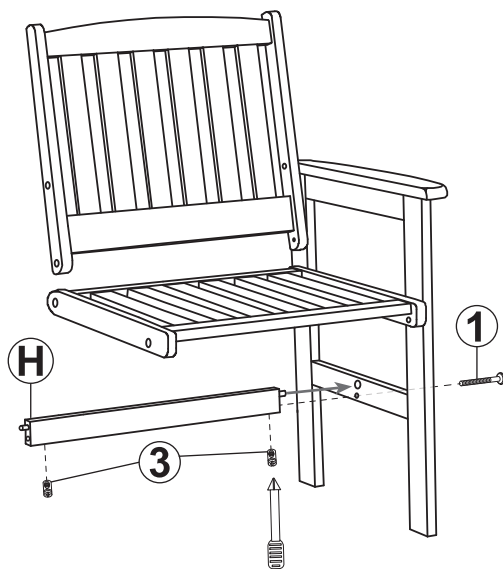
Do not fully tighten bolts until after Step 4 is complete.

STEP 3

- Insert two Barrel Nut (3) into Support Beam (H). Use the Barrel Nut Driver to align the barrel nut with the hole on the side of the support beam.
- Insert the peg on Support Beam (H) into the left arm.
- Fasten the components by hand-tightening one M6x60 Bolt (1) through the arm and into the barrel nut inside the support beam.

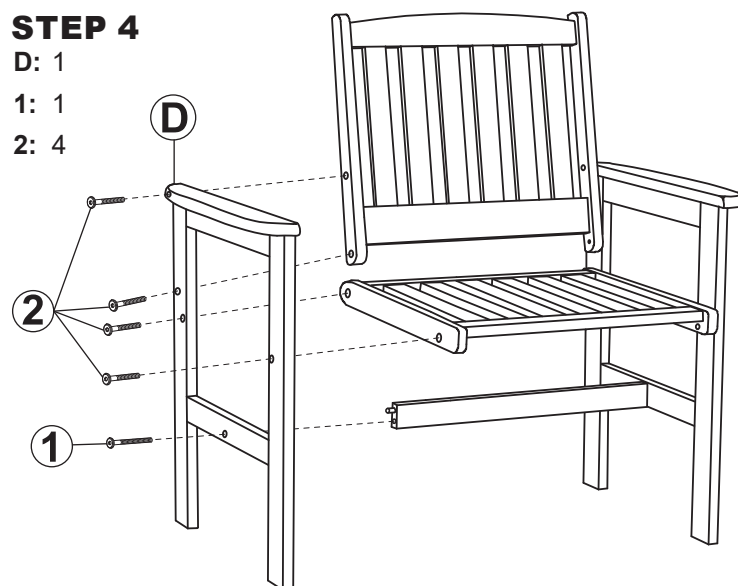
Do not fully tighten bolts until after Step 4 is complete.

STEP 4

- Align Right Arm (D) with assembled components, ensuring the peg in the support beam is correctly positioned within the arm.
- Secure the arm by hand-tightening one M6x60 Bolt (1) and four M6x40 Bolts (2), as shown.
- Finish tightening all hardware.
- Repeat steps 2 through 4 to assemble the second chair.

Care & Maintenance

SAFE USE: For residential use only. Only use on a flat, level surface. Do not stand on the chairs. Do not sit or stand on the table. Do not exceed the weight capacities.

INSPECT: Periodically check assembly points and tighten fittings as necessary.

CLEANING: Identify the direction of the woodgrain. Following the direction of the woodgrain, wipe surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials or a pressure washer to clean.

EXPOSURE: Over time, sunlight and weather elements fade and degrade wood furniture. Maintain the color and integrity of the furniture by covering it with a breathable cover or storing indoors when not in use.

WINTER CARE & STORAGE: Protect this item from inclement weather, especially ice and snow. Move to a cool, dry indoor location. Covering while in storage is recommended to help prevent dust build-up.

MAINTENANCE: This item was treated with teak oil at the factory. To maintain the appearance, apply a suitable penetrating Wood, Teak or Linseed Oil (not included) yearly, or when the wood looks particularly dry. Clean the unit and bring into a dry, warm, indoor location. Allow the unit to thoroughly dry before applying oil; drying may take several days. Only apply oil to wooden surfaces. Use a soft cloth or soft brush and carefully apply oil as directed by the wood oil manufacturer.

- Do not exceed the weight capacity of the furniture.
- Do not sit, stand, or climb on the table.
- Do not stand on the chairs.
- Inspect hardware often and tighten loose hardware before use.
- Do not put hot items on or near furniture.
- Keep furniture a safe distance from heat sources such as fire pits, patio heaters, and grills.
- Do not allow children to use this product without adult supervision.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials to clean the furniture.
- Do not use a pressure washer to clean the furniture.
