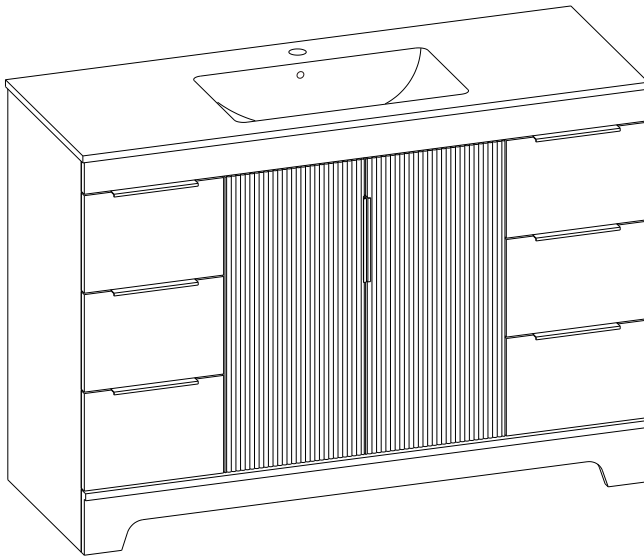

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Workspace Safety

Keep the workspace clear of clutter and ensure it's well-lit. A clean, flat surface is essential.

Read Instructions

Read the entire assembly guide before starting. Skipping steps can compromise safety.

Use Proper Tools

Use the tools provided or recommended. Avoid overtightening screws.

Secure Furniture

Anchor tall or heavy furniture to the wall to prevent tipping. This is crucial in homes with children or pets.

Handle Small Parts

Keep small parts away from children and pets to avoid choking hazards.

Get Help

Don't hesitate to ask for help with heavy or complex pieces.

Inspect Regularly

Periodically check for loose screws or wobbly parts and tighten as needed.

Follow these tips for a safe assembly process.

CARE AND CLEANING

Many cleaners contain abrasive and chemical substance which is not suitable for cleaning stainless steel, enamel, plating or plastic products. You may use mild cleansers or soaps to clean the surfaces. Wipe any splashes of cleaner solutions from the surface with a clean soft cloth.

Maintain ventilation in the bathroom and separate the dry area from the damp one if conditions permit. Try to open the door and windows of the bathroom to maintain adequate ventilation.

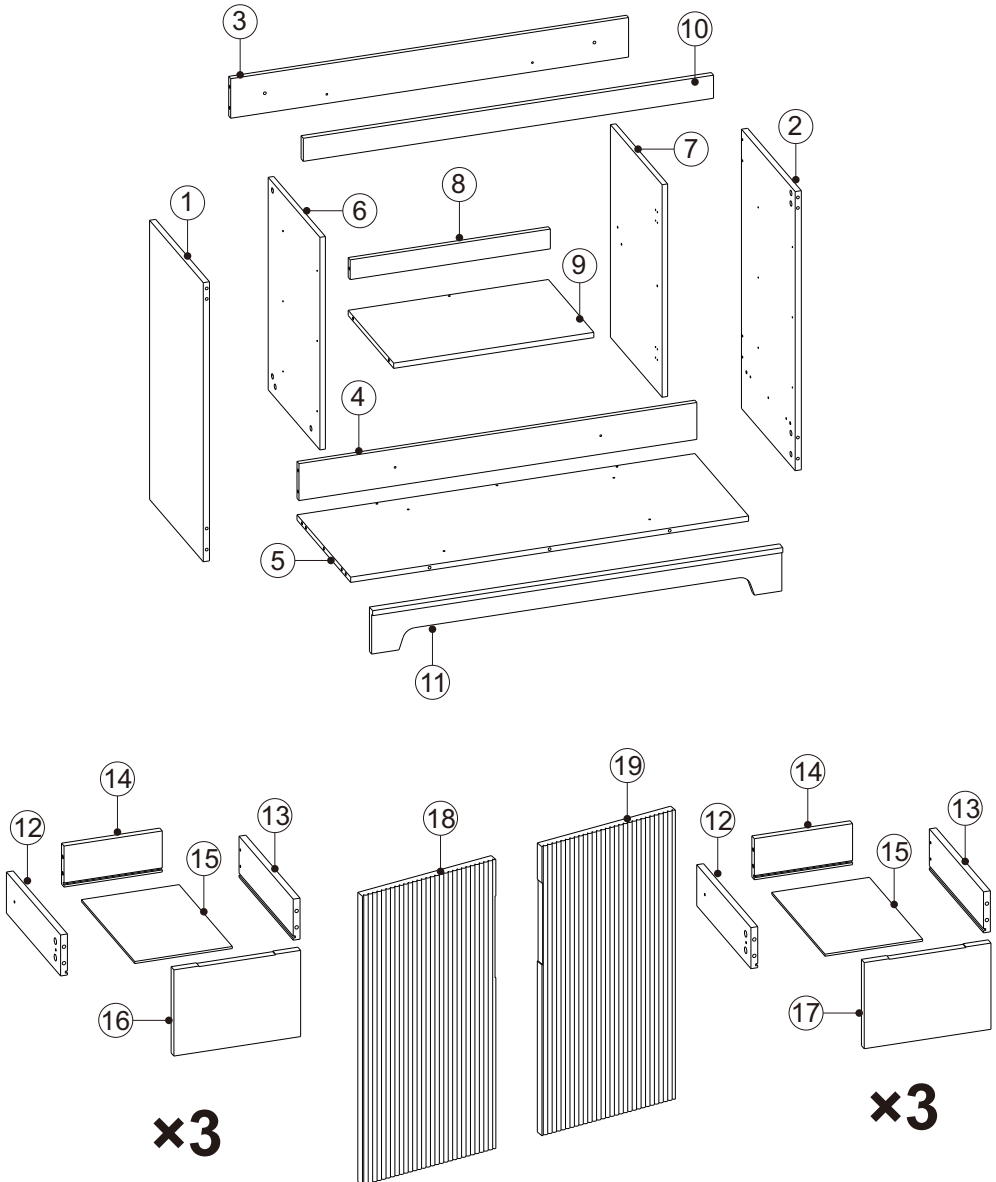
This cabinet is built to withstand normal bathroom humidity. For best results, keep this vanity dry and take necessary steps to minimize bathroom humidity by opening windows and doors and using the exhaust fan (if available).

To maintain the cabinet door, clean and wipe the door regularly with a soft cloth. Wipe condensation with a dry, soft cloth. Keep away from high temperatures.

Please do not sit, lean or step on the basin cabinet.

3. Follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure proper installation.

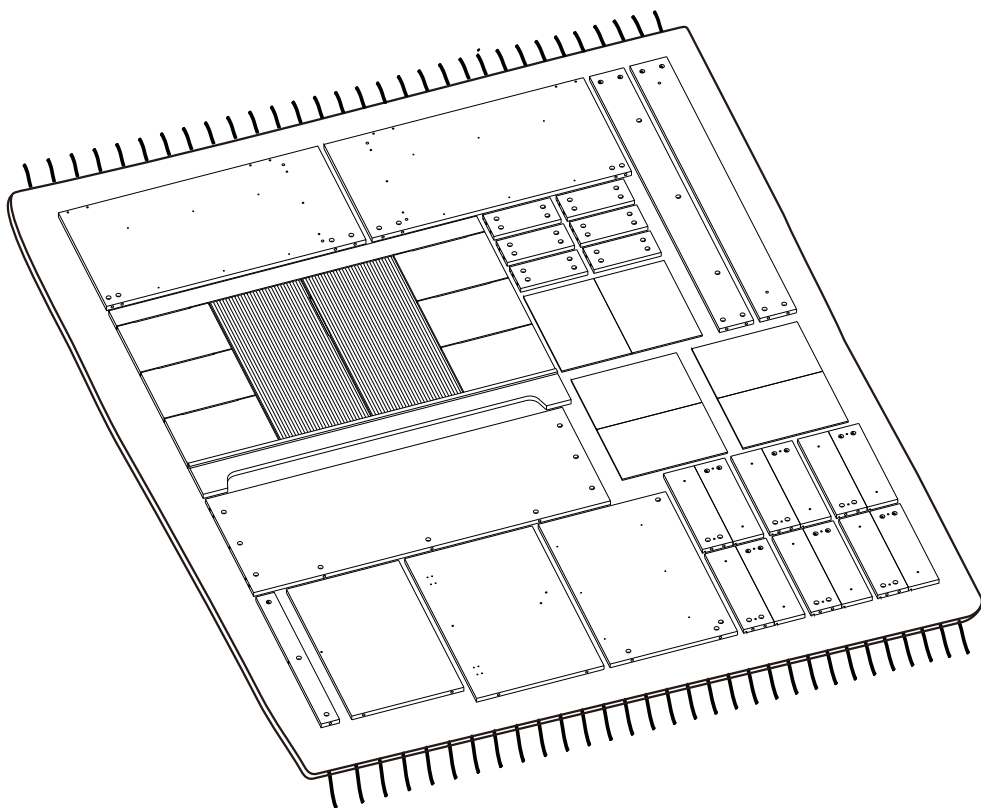

Use 25 Screws to install the handle and apply 22 Screws to fix the hinge on the shelf #18. Then use 22 Screws to connect the hinge bracket to the cabinet. Repeat these steps for the other door.

A.Height adjustment

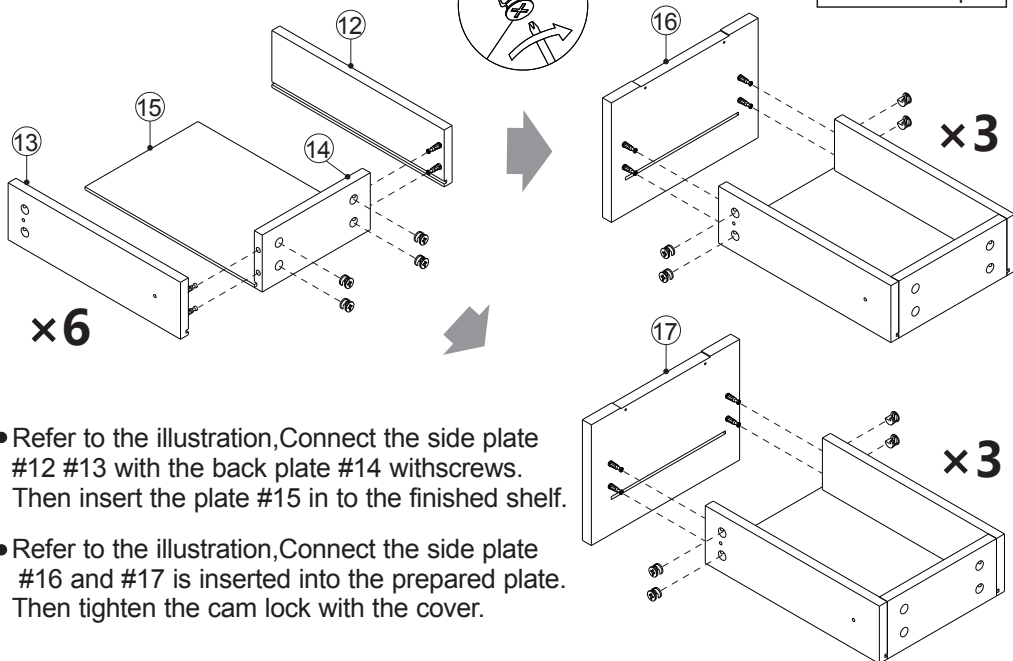
C.Side to side adjustment

D.After adjustment A/B/C,tighten screws.

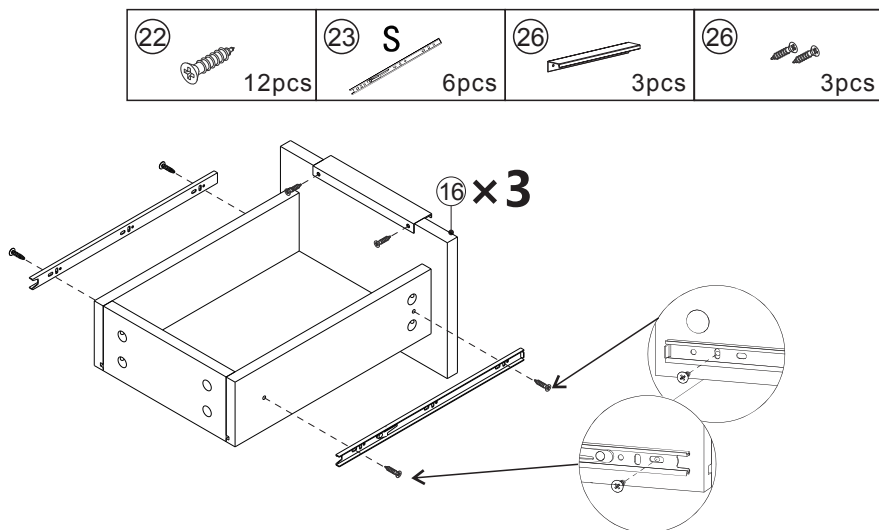
- To ensure proper cabinet alignment, refer to the above illustrations for instructions about adjusting the cabinet height, depth and lateral movement.

- Refer to the illustration, Connect the side plate #12 #13 with the back plate #14 with screws. Then insert the plate #15 in to the finished shelf.
- Refer to the illustration, Connect the side plate #16 and #17 is inserted into the prepared plate. Then tighten the cam lock with the cover.

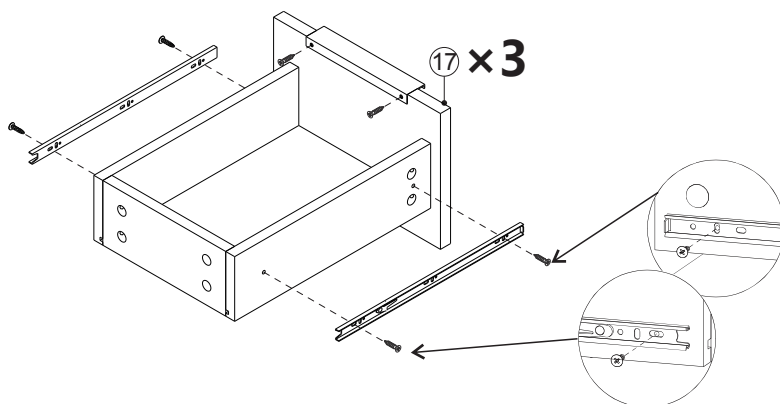

- Refer to the illustration, Apply Screws to fix the slides on the boards #12, #13. Use (26) Screws to install the handle.

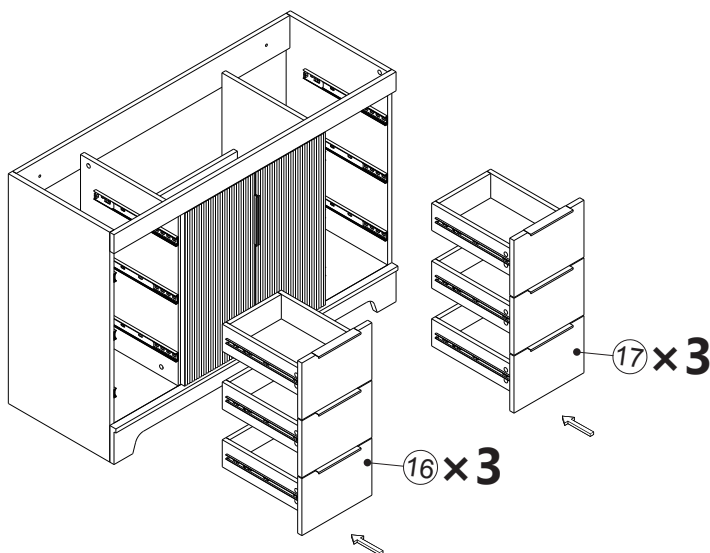

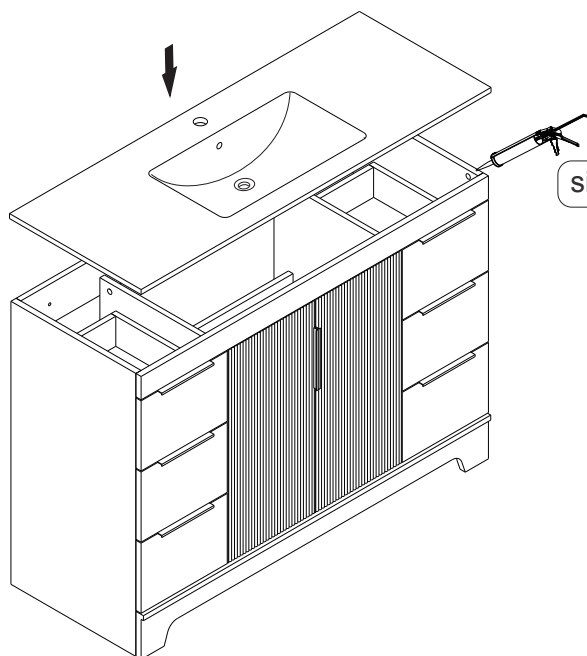
- If the drawers are not in the same level, please adjust the screws in the drawer box.
