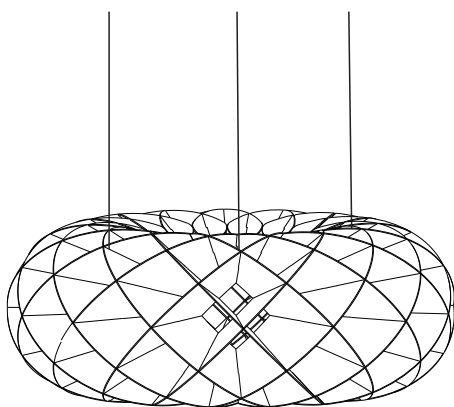
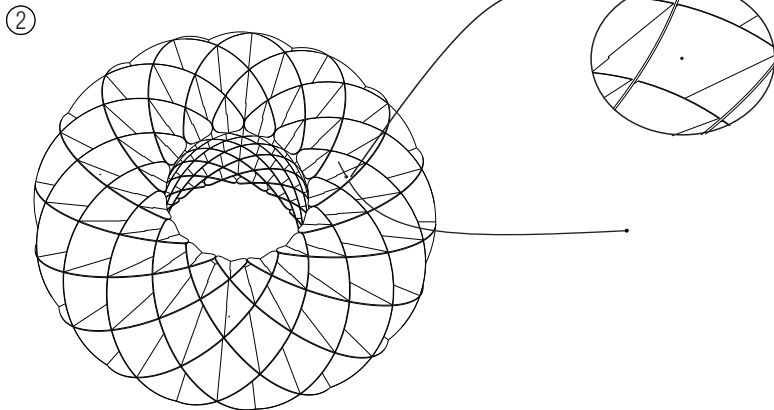

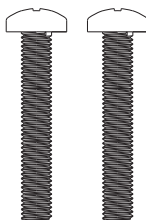
Read carefully all the assembling instructions below and turn OFF energy power before starting the installation.

Turn off the electrical power before starting the installation, and keep it turned off until the installation is completed.

- ① Remove the protective packaging from the parts, taking care not damage any piece with sharp surfaces or objects.
- ② Insert the steel cable from bottom to top through the holes marked with yellow tape, ensuring the steel cable's ball end is fixed to the base. Repeat this process for the other holes.

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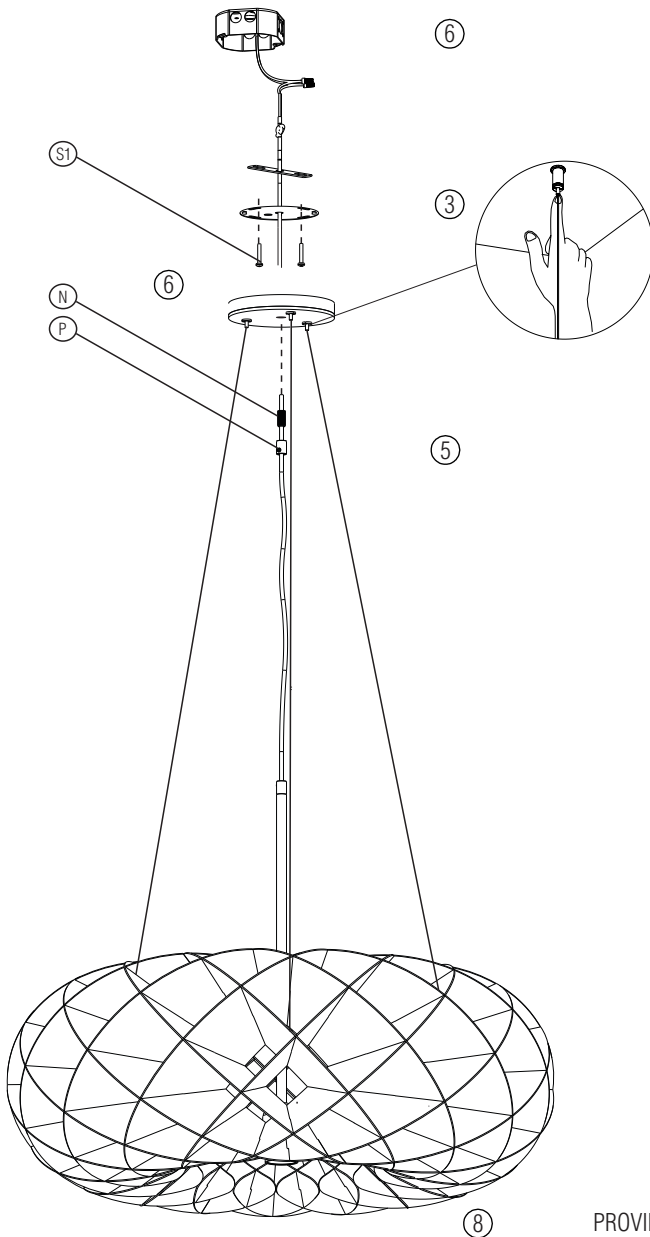
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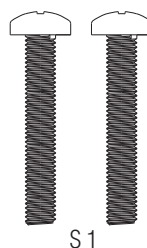


- ③ Pass the support cables through the cable anchors at the canopy, adjusting the desired height for the pendant to be suspended. To adjust the height, press the tip of the cable anchor while sliding the cable in. Release the cable anchor tip, and the suspension cable will be locked.
- ④ Reserve the cable excess by wrapping it inside the canopy, ensuring that it does not touch any electrical connections, or simply cut the excess off.
- ⑤ Pass the power cable through the strain relief (S) on the canopy, also through the threaded nipple (N), junction box cover (JB) and the mounting crossbar (C), at the desired suspension height. Connect the electrical supply wires to the mains supply at the junction box in accordance with all the applicable codes. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product, and the hazards involved.
- ⑥ Attach the mounting crossbar and threaded nipple (N) to the junction box using the supplied screws.
- ⑦ Bring the canopy close to the electrical box, and tighten the strain relief to the nipple, to lock the canopy to the ceiling. Then, tighten the plastic screw on the strain relief to anchor the power cable.
- ⑧ Install an E27 LED bulb with a maximum power of 25W (bulb not included).

Turn on the electrical power.

The luminaire is ready for use.

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
