- Pencil


PACKAGE CONTENT:

- Door catches




1 UNPACKING AND CHECKING ALL PARTS:


Carefully unpack the interior door and verify that all parts are included and in good condition.



2 CONNECTING JAMBS WITH THE DOOR:


- A. Align the door slab with the door jamb. Leave a small gap (1/32 inch to 1/8 inch) between the door and the top jamb.
- B. Secure the hinges to the door jamb using screws.









3 REMOVE THE PIN WHICH HOLDS TWO PARTS OF HINGES





4 REPEAT STEPS 2 AND 3 WITH THE SECOND DOOR SLAB









5 ASSEMBLING THE FRAME:

Use nails and screws to assemble the frame of the door.

6 PLACING THE FRAME INTO THE ROUGH OPENING (RO):

- A. Insert the assembled door frame into the Rough Opening (RO).
 - Make sure jamb leveled and straight (not bent or curved).
- B. Secure the frame in place by nailing it to the surrounding structure at the top, bottom, and sides.








7 HANGING THE DOORS:


- Hang the doors on the hinges that are attached to the door jambs.
- Check that the doors swing freely and close properly.





8 COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION:

- A. Make any necessary adjustments to ensure that the doors open and close smoothly.
- B. Add any finishing touches, such as installing door handles or locks.
