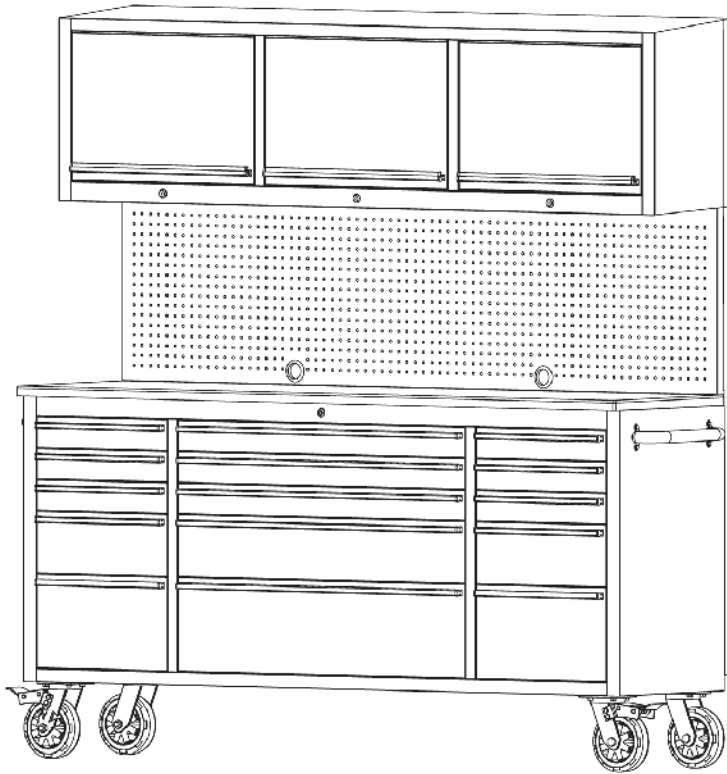

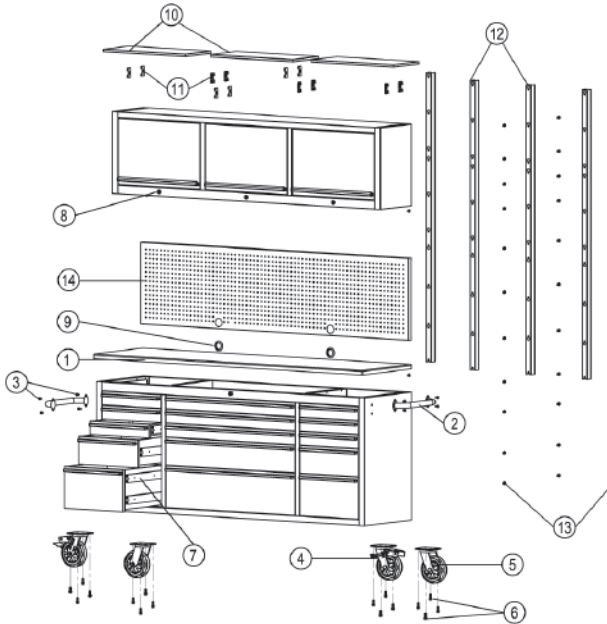

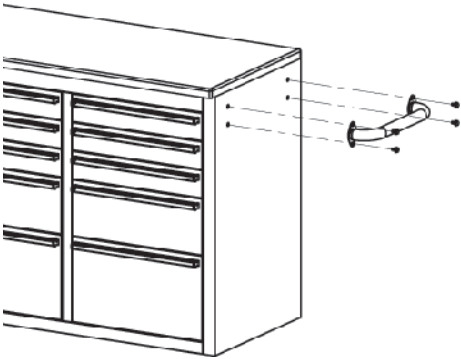
## ASSEMBLY

### NECESSARY TOOLS REQUIRED FOR ASSEMBLY

- 10 mm socket (for cabinet side handles)
- 12 mm socket
- screwdriver

### INSTALL THE HANDLE

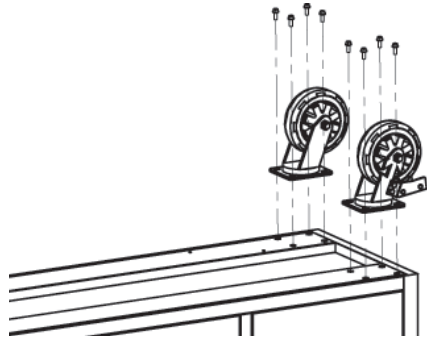
Position the handle over the holes and attach with the 1/4" x 14 mm hex bolts provided. Tighten securely using a 10 mm socket.



### INSTALL THE CASTERS

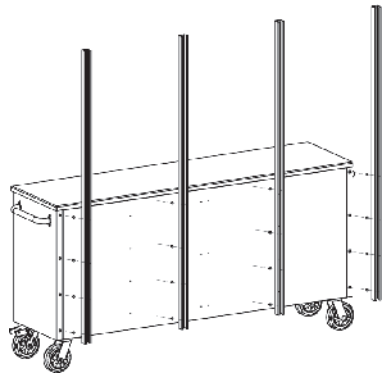
Carefully lay the cabinet on its back using a soft mat under the back for protection. Position two swivel casters on the bottom of the cabinet, on the right side (same side as the

handle). Insert 3/8" x 25 mm hex bolts through the casters and into the bottom of the cabinet. Tighten securely using a 12 mm socket. Repeat for the two rigid casters on the other side of cabinet.



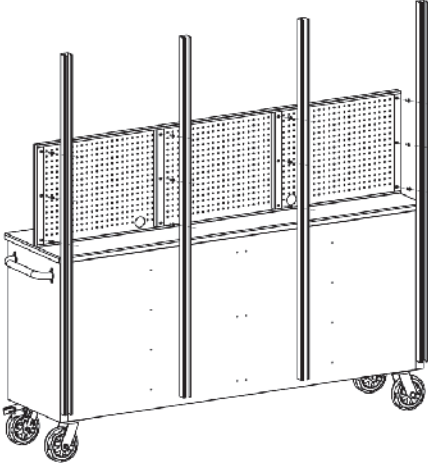
### RAIL, PEGBOARD AND UPPER CABINET INSTALLATION

Attach the four rails to the tool cabinet with four 1/4" x 14 mm hex bolts each.



## ASSEMBLY

Attach the pegboard to the rails with twelve 1/4" x 14 mm hex bolts.



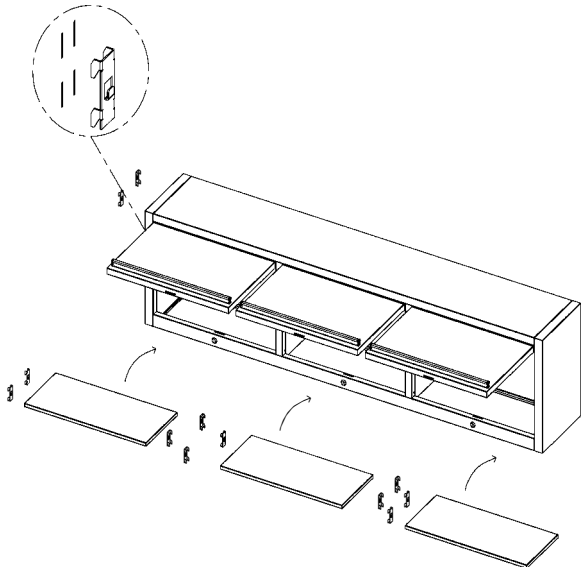
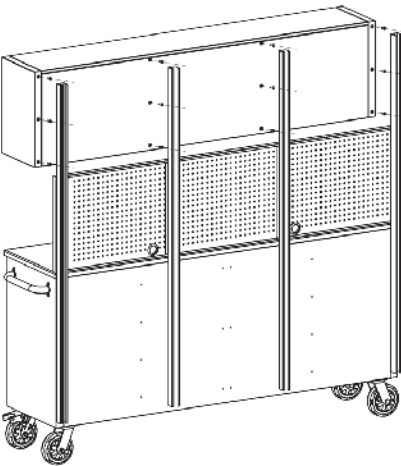
### NOTE:

Depending on the thickness of the countertop, The rear support is raised upward to the hole position connection of the back plate.

### SHELF ASSEMBLY

Insert four hooks inside the upper cabinet at the desired height. Place the shelf on the shelf supports. Repeat for the other shelves

Attach the upper cabinet to the rails with twelve 1/4" x 14 mm hex bolts.

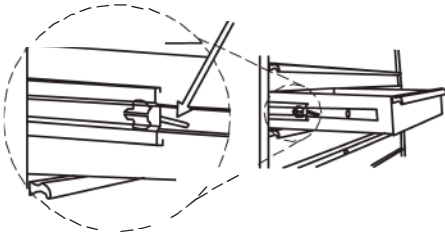


## ASSEMBLY AND OPERATION

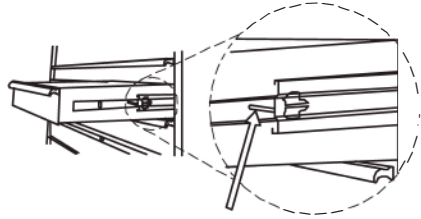
### TO REMOVE DRAWERS

Pull the drawer out so it is almost fully extended. **PUSH UP ON THE LEFT** hand black release lever, while **PULLING DOWN ON THE RIGHT** hand black release lever. While holding the levers in the positions as instructed above, pull the drawer outward until it is released from the drawer slide.

PUSH UP (LEFT HAND SIDE)



PULL DOWN (RIGHT HAND SIDE)



### TO REPLACE DRAWERS

Extend the drawer slides from the tool chest. Insert the brackets on each cabinet slides, being careful that they are positioned properly. Once properly inserted, completely close the drawer to set the slides in their proper positions.

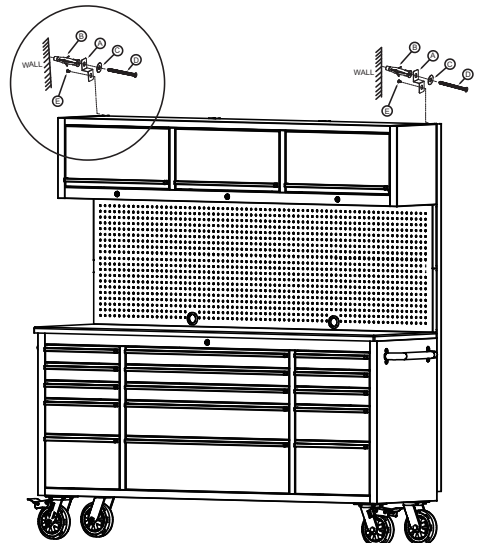
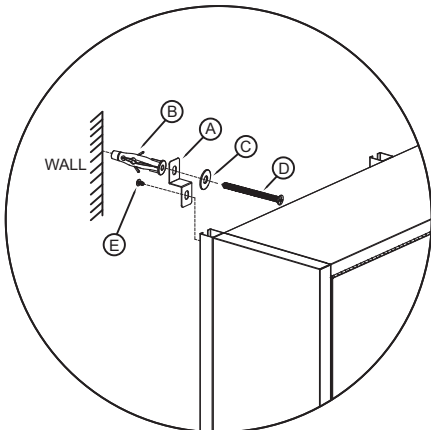

# MAINTENANCE

## MAINTENANCE

For casters, use high quality bearing grease(annually/yearly).

Lubricate the slides (twice a year) with a product like WD40 or other quality lubricant. This is especially important when the temperature decreases, as the bearing can become stiff.

Periodically the drawer fronts, drawer trim, and other surfaces should be cleaned with mild detergent and water.

Using solvents of any kind on the wood top may damage the finish. Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Using a soft clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.

### WARNING

Lock the

drawers before moving this product. The drawers could come open and make the product unstable and tip, which may cause personal injury or product damage.

The maximum

weight for each drawer should be no more than 100 lbs.

The maximum product weight, including contents, should be no more than 2000 lbs for roller cabinets.
