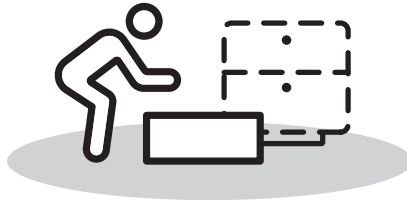
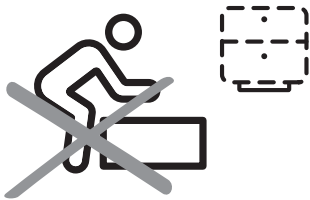
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



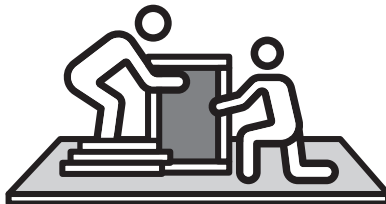
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



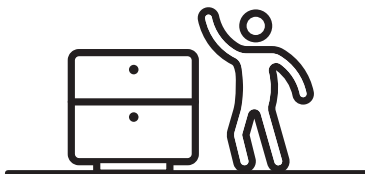
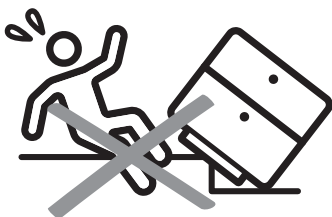
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

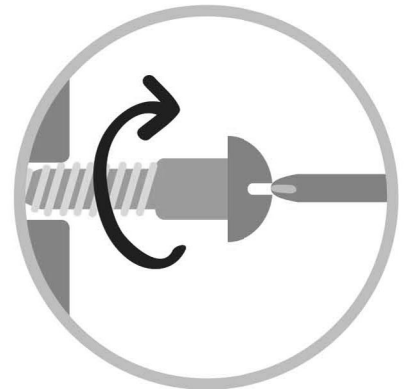
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



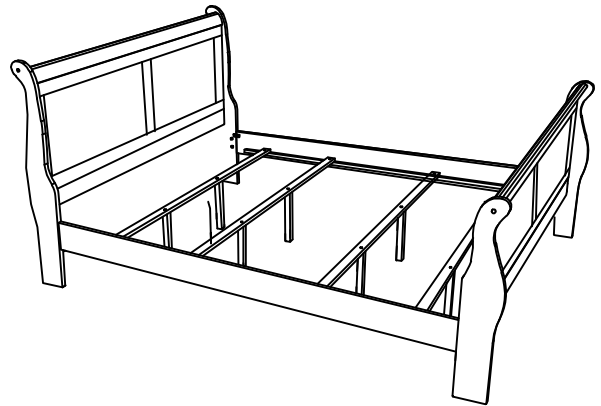
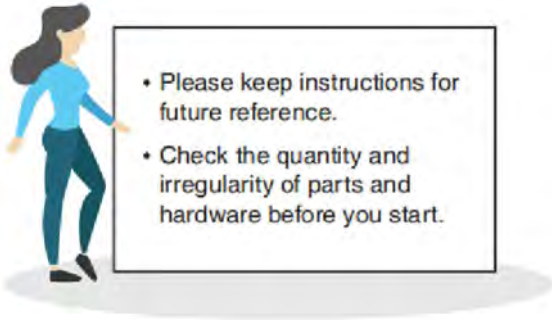
Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

Part #1 x1pc
 Part #3 x2pcs
 Hardware #A x2pcs
 Hardware #B x2pcs
 Hardware #C x4pcs
 Hardware #D x4pcs

 Hardware #G x2pcs

1) Insert dowels (#A) to the headboard (#1).

2) Align HB legs (#3) to the headboard (#1), then secure by using bolts (#C) with washers (#D,E).

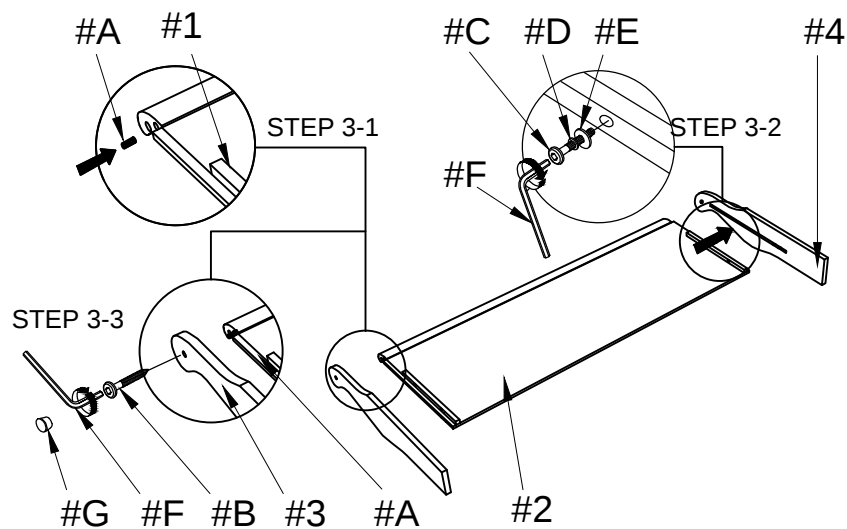


3) Secure HB legs (#3) onto headboard (#1) by using bolts (#B), then covering with caps (#G).

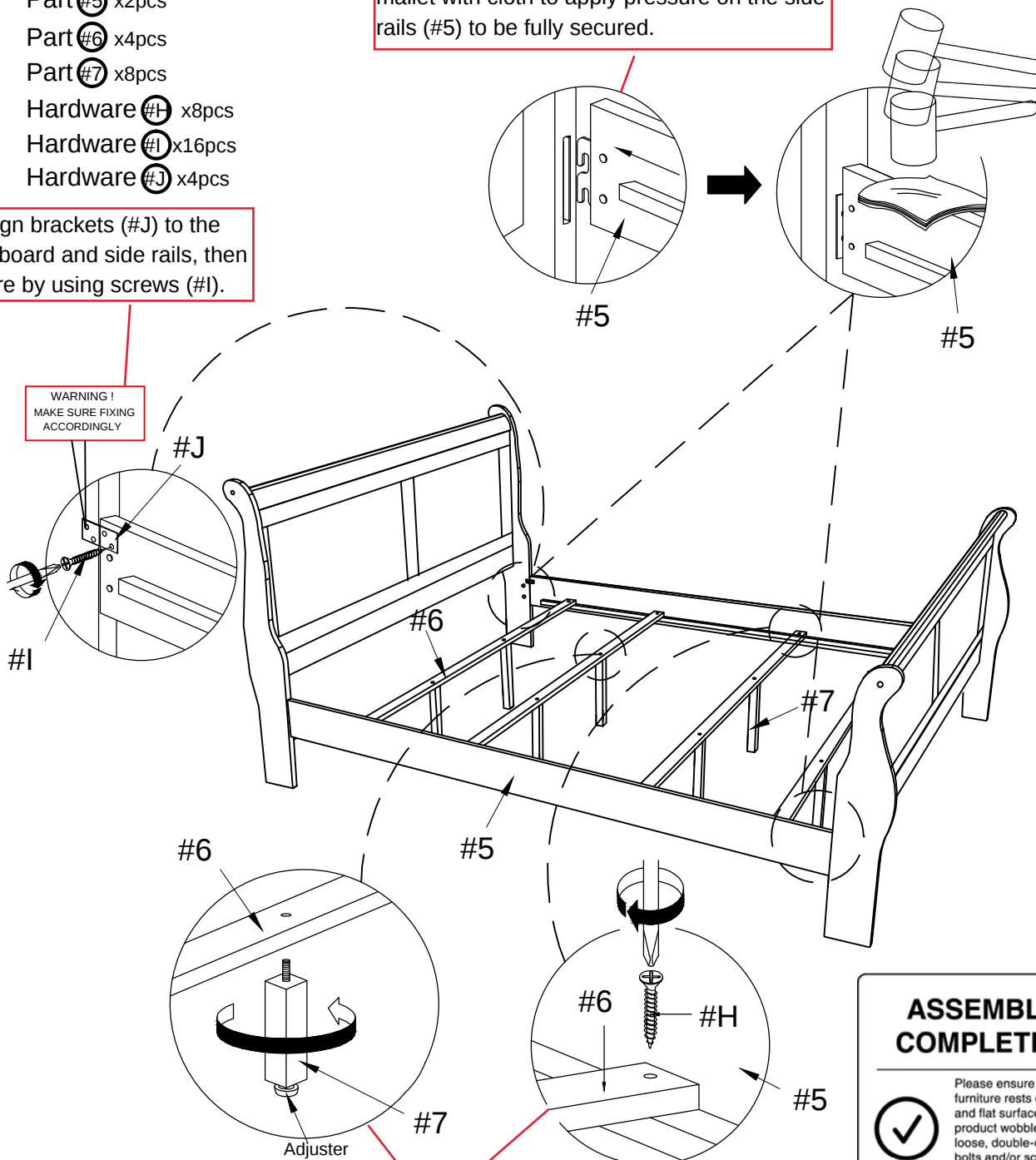

2) Align brackets (#J) to the headboard and side rails, then secure by using screws (#I).

1) Align and hook the side rails (#5) to the headboard and footboard, then using a rubber mallet with cloth to apply pressure on the side rails (#5) to be fully secured.



3) Attach support legs (#7) to the slats (#6), then align slats (#6) to the side rails (#5). Secure by using screws (#H).

ASSEMBLY COMPLETED



Please ensure the furniture rests on an even and flat surface. If the product wobbles or feels loose, double-check all bolts and/or screws are properly tightened and secured.
