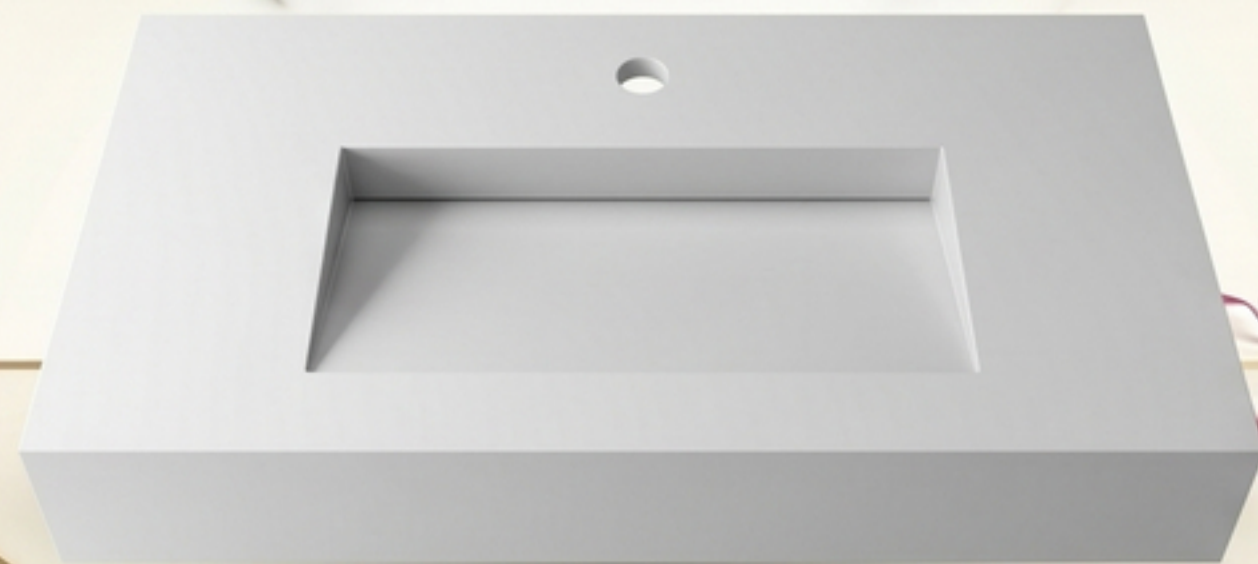


CARE & CLEANING GUIDE FOR SOLID SURFACE WALL MOUNTED SINKS



DAILY CARE



Rinsing after each use
(wiping away toothpaste and
soap scum)

Wiping with a microfiber
cloth to prevent water
spots and lime buildup

REGULAR CLEANING



Use mild soap & warm water

Apply a non-abrasive
countertop cleanser for
deeper cleaning

Avoid harsh chemicals
(like acetone or drain cleaner)

Tough Stains on white sinks:



For tough stains (e.g., hair dye,
makeup): Lightly sand the area with
sandpaper, using a circular motion.
This will gently remove surface
imperfections. Thoroughly rinse
and dry the sink. Follow by buffing
with a high-quality polishing
compound to restore the smooth,
uniform finish.

DO'S & DON'TS



DO'S

Soft sponges
Microfiber cloths
pH-neutral detergents
Regular wipe-downs

DON'TS

Abrasive cleaners
Steel wool
Harsh acids/bases (e.g., bleach)
Cutting directly on surface
(for kitchen sinks)
Excessive heat (near basin edge)
