

# WING SPRING CURTAIN TIEBACK

## Installation Guide

---

### What's Included

#### In Your Package:

- 1 or 2 × Wing spring tiebacks (depending on selected quantity)
- Modern wing design elements (3.8" × 3" × 2.5" each)
- Spring-loaded bracelet-style closure system
- Available in your selected finish: Silver, Gold, White, or Black

#### Your Finish Selection:

Your wing tieback(s) come in the sophisticated finish you selected. Each finish features the same premium construction and flexible spring-loaded system.

- **Silver:** Modern, sleek finish - perfect for contemporary and minimalist spaces
- **Gold:** Luxurious, warm accent - ideal for upscale and designer interiors
- **White:** Clean, minimalist style - excellent for modern and Scandinavian decor
- **Black:** Bold, contemporary look - perfect for dramatic and architectural designs

#### Tools Needed:

- None required - no drilling or hardware installation needed!
- Clean, dry cloth (for initial cleaning if desired)

### Important Safety Information

- Keep away from children under 3 years - spring mechanism could cause injury
- Handle with care when opening and closing the spring mechanism
- Do not over-stretch the spring to avoid damage
- Handle wing elements gently to maintain finish
- Check curtain weight capacity before use

# Step-by-Step Installation

## 1 Prepare Your Curtains

Ensure your curtains are clean and properly hung. The wing tieback works beautifully with contemporary fabrics and complements modern, architectural decor themes.

*Tip: If curtains are new, let them hang for 24 hours to settle before installing tiebacks.*

## 2 Determine Tieback Position

Choose where you want the tieback positioned on your curtain:

- **High position:** 1/3 from the top - sleek, modern drape
- **Middle position:** Center of curtain - balanced, contemporary look
- **Low position:** 2/3 down - relaxed, casual modern style

## 3 Gather the Curtain Fabric

Pull your curtain to one side and gather the fabric at your chosen position. The gathered fabric should be no more than 2 inches thick for optimal fit within the 2.5" diameter wing design.

**Spring Advantage:** The bracelet-style spring mechanism provides flexible fit while the architectural wing design adds contemporary flair to your curtains.

## 4 Position the Front Wing

Place one wing element on the front-facing side of your gathered curtain where you want it to be visible. The modern wing design becomes a striking architectural accent.

Consider the angle - the wing can be positioned to complement your curtain's natural drape and your room's contemporary aesthetic.

## 5 Open the Spring Mechanism

Gently open the spring-loaded bracelet by pulling the wing elements apart. The spring mechanism allows the tieback to expand to fit around your gathered curtain.

The flexible spring design accommodates various curtain thicknesses within the 2.5" diameter range.

## 6 Wrap Around Curtain

Place the opened tieback around the gathered curtain fabric, positioning the decorative wing on the front. The spring mechanism will naturally adjust to the curtain thickness.

**Caution:** Handle gently when positioning to avoid over-stretching the spring mechanism.

## 7 Release and Secure

Allow the spring mechanism to close around the curtain. The spring tension will hold the tieback securely in place while maintaining a comfortable fit around your curtains.

## 8 Adjust and Perfect

Adjust the curtain draping and the position of the wing until you achieve the perfect contemporary look. The spring tension should hold securely while allowing natural curtain movement.

Ensure the wing element is positioned to showcase its modern architectural design and complements your room's contemporary aesthetic.

### Pro Installation Tips

- For optimal hold, ensure curtain gathering fits comfortably within the 2.5" diameter

- With a set of 2, install tiebacks at the same height for perfect symmetry
- For wide windows with multiple panels, use one tieback per panel
- The wing can be angled to create different shadow effects and visual interest
- Consider the wing as part of your room's architectural and design elements
- The compact design with spring mechanism is perfect for lighter, contemporary curtains

## Daily Use Instructions

### Opening Curtains

Simply pull the curtain toward the tieback. The spring tension will hold the gathered fabric securely in place with modern style.

### Closing Curtains

Gently open the spring mechanism and remove from curtain. Allow the curtain to fall naturally back into position.

## Maintenance & Care

### Regular Care:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe wing elements with a soft, damp cloth as needed
- **Spring Care:** Avoid over-stretching the spring mechanism to maintain elasticity
- **Storage:** When not in use, allow spring to rest in closed position
- **Finish Care:** Clean gently to preserve the color and finish quality
- **Inspection:** Check spring mechanism for wear and wing elements for any damage
