



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-




- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-

Assembly Steps




This Bar Cart has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the Bar Cart parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.


Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack all parts and place on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2




Attach Top Shelf Frame(C) to Left Frame(A) using Bolts(②) with Allen Key(①). **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 3 C A D D

Attach Bottom Frame(D) to Left Frame(A) using Bolts(\mathfrak{D}) with Allen Key(\mathfrak{D}). **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**




Attach Bottom Frame(D) to Left Frame(A) using Bolts(\Im) with Allen Key(\Im). **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**




Repeat **Steps 2** - **4** to assemble Right Frame(B).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.





Attach Wheels with Brakes(H) to Left Frame(A) using Spanner(4). Attach Wheels(G) to Right Frame(B) using Spanner(4).



Stand the Bar Cart up, as shown.

Step 8





Attach Glass Suction Cups(4) to Top Shelf Frame(C) and Bottom Frames(D), as shown.






Carefully, insert Top Glass(E) into Top Shelf Frame(C) and Bottom Glass(F) into and Bottom Frame(D).

Gently press down on the Glass Shelves after you put them into the frame.

Please pressure down on each corner to adjust the gap between glass and frame. Then, Tighten all bolts at all joints fully in a sequential manner.


Step 10



Your Bar Cart is ready for use.
