RECESS-MOUNT INSTALLATION

Make Rough Opening and Frame on all sides. Reference your Cabinet Model Dimensions and Rough in dimensions on Page **5**. Make sure the cabinet door has a clearance of at least 1" from the top of the faucet and 1" from the ceiling. **Electric wiring:** Be sure to provide enough wire to make the proper and safe connection to the Field/Power. Place cabinet in rough-in and make sure the cabinet is square, level and plumb. Secure the cabinet with the mounting screws into the framing studs. NOTE: Rough opening is not an exact measurement. The extra space allows cabinet to be inserted into the opening. Add shims to level and tighten space if necessary. Additional framing might be required.

Slide top brackets into channel at the top of the cabinet.





Make sure top brackets are locked in the grooves.

IMPORTANT:

Make sure cabinet is leveled and fully inserted into the grove of the bottom bracket.



IMPORTANT:

Top mounting brackets must be attached to furring strip/channel or wall studs.

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Test the fit of the cabinet before Final assembly.
