2.Before installations, prepare the required tools, such as Blade screwdriver, Adjustable wrench, step ladder, wire cutter.
 3.All electrical connections nust be in accordance with the National Electrical Code. Qualified licensed electricians are required to conduct the installation of electrical wiring.

4. The outlet box that is connected to the lighting must be directly supported by the building structure.


Care should be taken to avoid damage to the surface of lighting an wite, wearing gloves are remmended when installing.
