
Sideboard




Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly:

Tools required: Phillips screwdriver(medium & large) 1.Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

- 2.Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- 3.Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- 4.Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- 5.During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- 6.Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- 7.Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- 8.Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- 9.To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.
- 10.Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- 11.Regularly check and ensure That all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.
- 12.Please do not place items that exceed the load capacity.

Care and maintenance


Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
