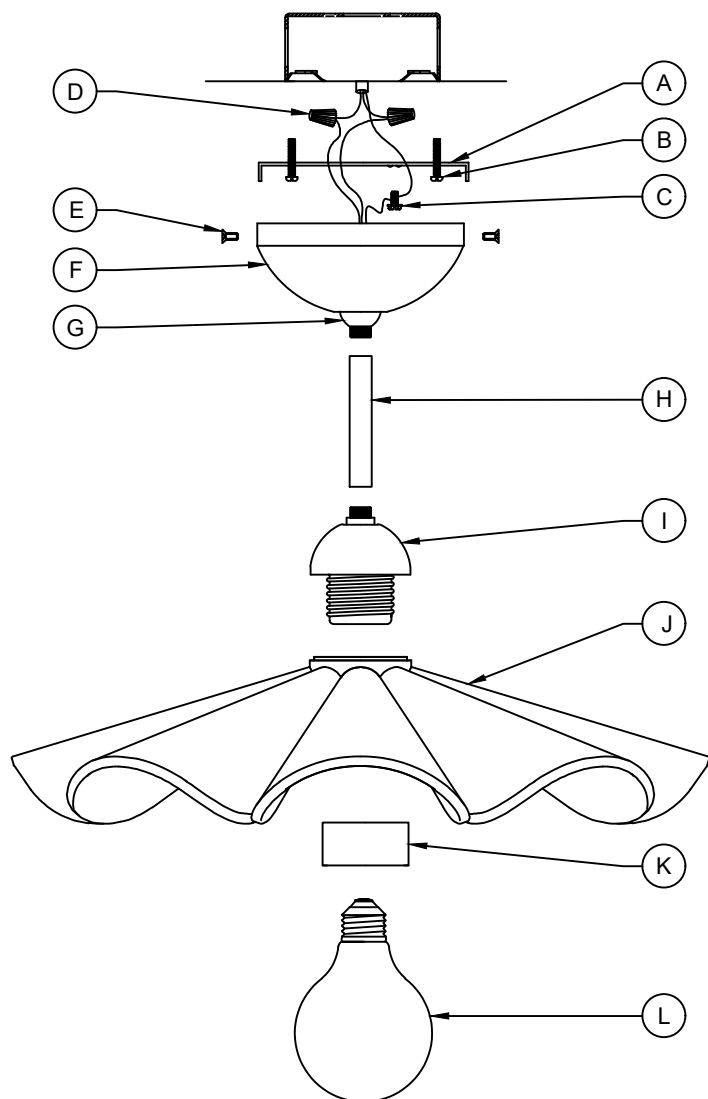


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Adjust Hanging Height

Thread the wires through the suspension rod (H). Add extension rods as needed to achieve desired height, then securely tighten with the threaded coupling (G).

2. Align the Canopy:

Slide the ceiling canopy (F) onto the top of the suspension rods (H), aligning it with the locking tabs.

3. Secure the Mounting Plate:

· Secure the mounting plate (A) to the junction box using the screws (B).

· This fixture is designed for installation in standard round or octagonal junction box. Ensure that the junction box is securely mounted to the building structure.

4. Connect the Ground Wire:

Connect the ground wire (silver) to the grounding terminal inside the junction box or to the grounding screw (C) on the mounting plate (A).

5. Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire connectors (D):

· Note: Connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire.

· Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box. Wrap the connections tightly with electrical tape.

6. Secure the Canopy:

Place the electrical wire back into the junction box. Align the canopy (F) with the mounting plate, and secure it with the decorative nuts (E).

7. Install the Lampshade:

Position the lampshade (J) onto the light fixture (I) and secure it with the retaining ring (K).

8. Install the Bulb:

Screw the bulb (L) into the socket (Bulb Not Included).

9. Restore Power:

Restore power at the circuit breaker or fuse box.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
