8, Top Panel Connect Wires on roof Fix the dust-(Fix the screws on roof) proof cover




Oxygen Ionizer

Press the button to switch on/off.

When switch on, it releases negative ion to fresh the air inside the cabin.



Operation Instructions of Control Panel






Power Button (On/Off)

This button turns the sauna on or off.



Light Button (On/Off)

This button turns the reading light on or off.



Temperature Setting

button to increase or decrease the

sauna temperature. The heaters will turn off when the sauna reaches its desired temperature.

Temperature setting ranges from 64 to 149 ${\rm \hat{F}}$. Press Light Button 3 seconds to swift ${\rm \hat{F}}$ to ${\rm \hat{C}}$.



sauna timer. It will count down until 00 and shut down the heaters.

Tips: Time setting ranges from 1 to 99 minutes.

Blue-tooth function: Source SAUNA BT on your mobile phone or other devices with Blue-tooth, connect with it when the sauna turns on, then you can play music etc. via blue-tooth. To adjust volume, change playing turns, pause or stop via your mobile phone.
