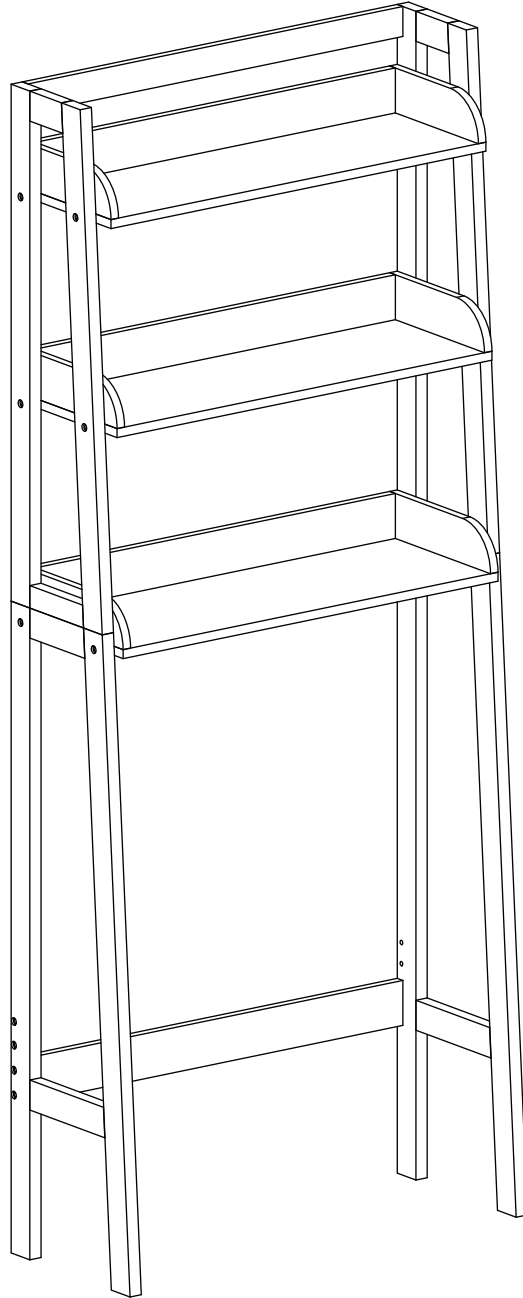

WARNING

- Please read instructions completely before assembling. Assemble on a soft, smooth area. Adult assembly required.
- Important: when drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc.
- Make sure that the screw and wall plugs used are suitable for supporting your unit. Consult a qualified professional if you are unsure.
- Failure of the product due to the use of incorrect fixing is the responsibility of the installer.
- Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tipping over.
- To prevent this furniture from tipping over:
 - It must be permanently fixed to the bearing wall with the included wall attachment devices.
 - Use on a level floor.
 - Load lower shelves first. Put heaviest items on bottom shelf only.
 - Do not let children pull or climb on this product.
- To prevent strangulation:
 - Do not allow children to insert head into bins or rails.
 - Heads can become stuck in bins or over rails.
 - Do not let children climb into or on storage unit.

- Check occasionally that screws are not loose, fasten the screws if any are loose.

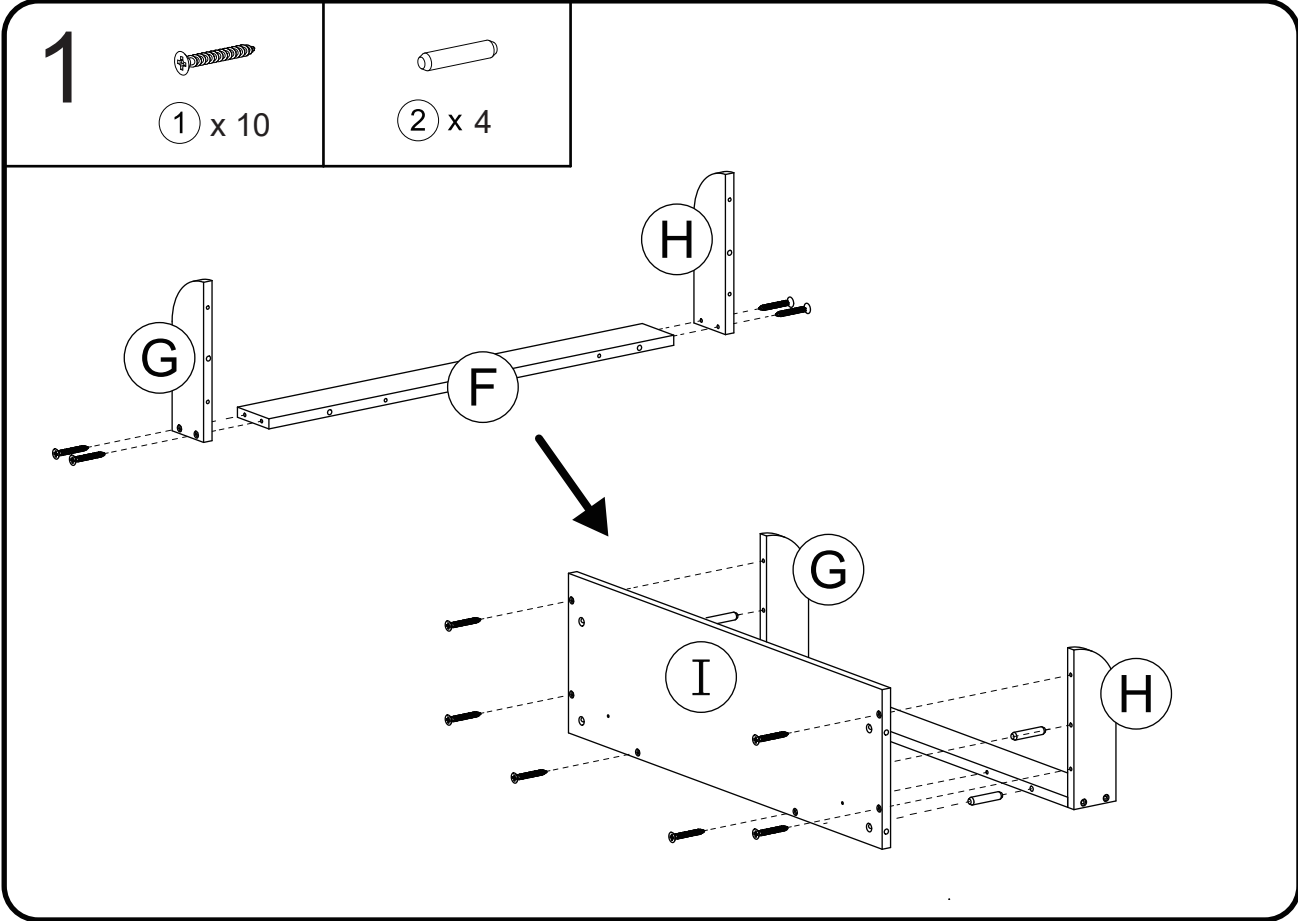
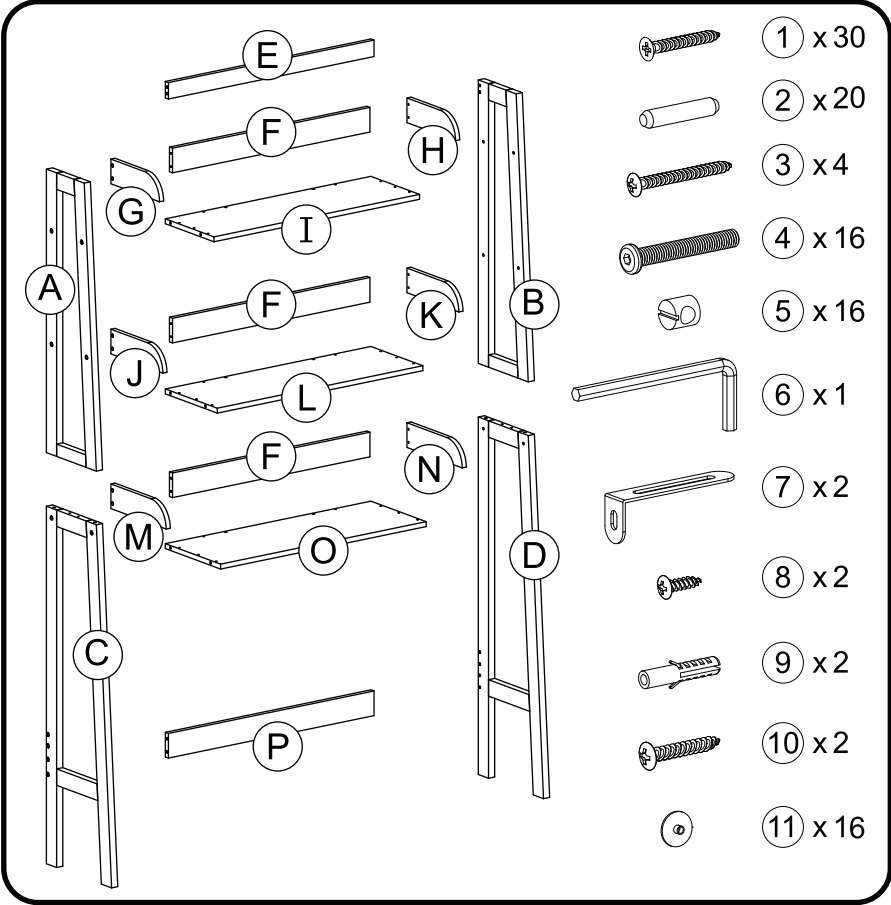
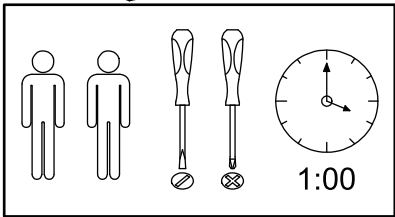
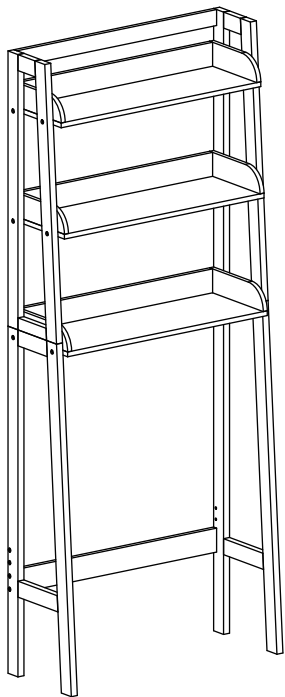
Maximum recommended distributed load
