

## Cleaning & Care

### FABRICS & ECO-LEATHER

Clean eco-leather and microfiber surfaces with a soft dry cloth; so, do not rub excessively to avoid damages. Do not use cleaning products on eco-leather and microfiber under any circumstances.

### MATERIC SURFACES and HIGH GLOSS PANELS

In the case of stains, we recommend the use of pure water or mild liquid detergent (neutral PH soap) or refer to a professional according to the attached table:

*\*\*\* Cleaning instruction are not valid for persistent or dried stains: the dirt must be immediately cleaned after its affection to the surface. \*\*\**

#### Notes:

- Do not use powder detergent, abrasive products, bleach or highly chlorinated substances, acids and strong bases;
- Avoid the use of products sprayed directly on the surface because this can leave stain rings, better applying the detergent on a damp soft cloth, clean and rinse;
- **Smooth or slightly embossed surfaces:** Make a preliminary cleaning with a soft cloth using the detergents of the above table. If this cleaning would not be sufficient to remove the dirt from the deepest veins of the embossing, we suggest you to gently treat the affected part with a melamine sponge (on the market like "Magic Sponge" after having damped it with warm water and well squeezes);
- Avoid the use of abrasive sponges that can flatten the surfaces.

## **Recommendations**

- Do not drag objects through the surfaces; always lift objects.
  - Avoid placing glasses or cups directly to the surface. Cold, wet or hot drink containers can damage the finish and leave stains. Please always use leather coasters and pads (never silicone or rubber covered coasters).
  - If liquids are accidentally spilled on the surface, please wipe immediately with a damp cloth and later dry it with a soft lint-free cloth.
  - Prevent the furniture to be exposed directly to the sunlight as the finish can vary its colour tones to light or dark. This is an inevitable natural process but avoiding the direct sunlight can prevent this prompt aging of the furniture and colour tones variation
  - Protect furniture to be exposed to high temperatures or humidity both in the transportation and in the workspace where it is installed.
