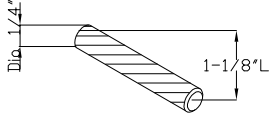
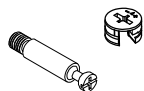
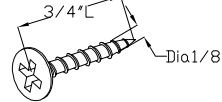
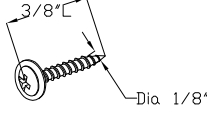
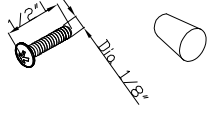
NOTE TO CUSTOMERS:

- For ease and speed of assembly we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly that you identify all the parts required to complete that step.
- We recommend that where possible you allow sufficient space to assemble the item as close as possible to the place where it will be once assembled.
- For the protection of your furniture we recommend that the product is placed on protected surfaces during assembly to prevent any damage.
- During assembly do not over tighten ,as this may damage the product.
- Please ensure you retain all the product packaging until the item completely assembled.
- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- Never allow any liquids to remain on your furniture as absorption can cause the wood to warp or the finish to de-laminate.
- It is recommended that this item should be assembled by two adults.

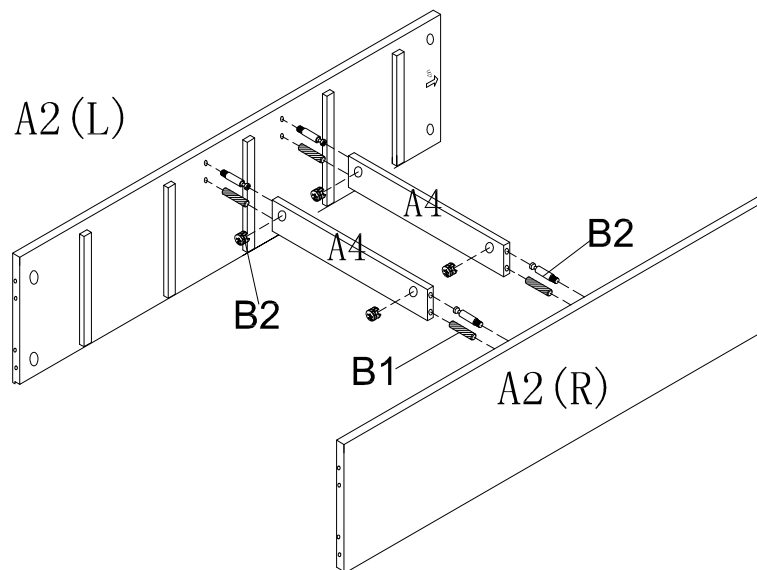
WARNING:

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over.
To help prevent tip-over:

- Place heaviest item in the lowest drawers.
 - Unless specifically designed to accommodate, do not set TVs or other heavy objects on top of this product.
 - Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
 - Never open more than one drawer at a time.(OR)
 - Do not defeat or remove the drawer interlock system.
- Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip-over.

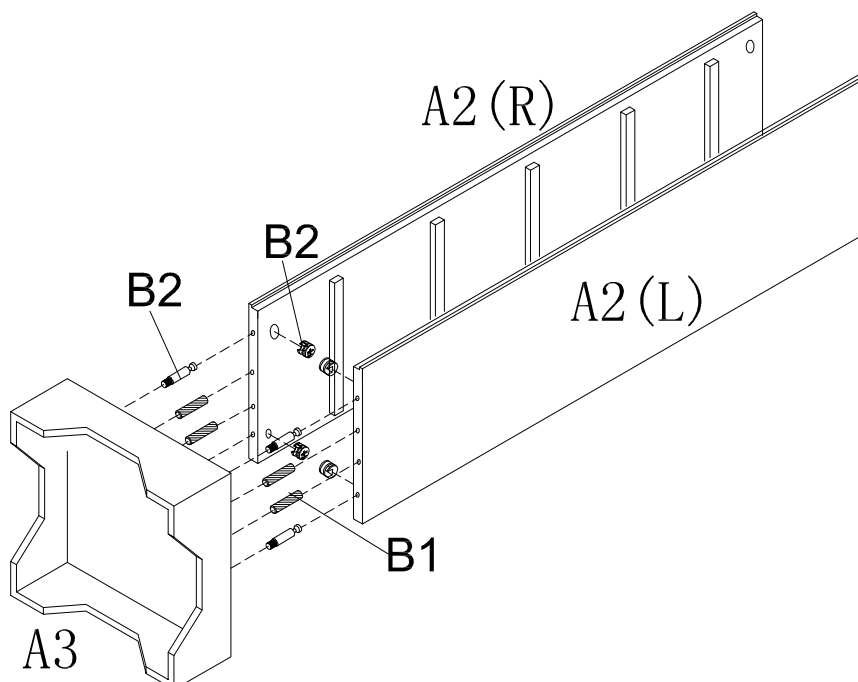

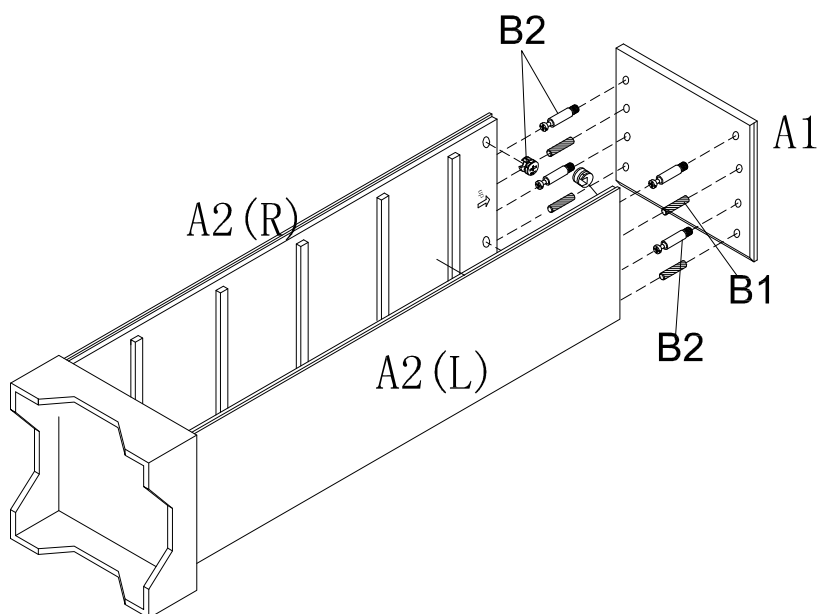

Step 3

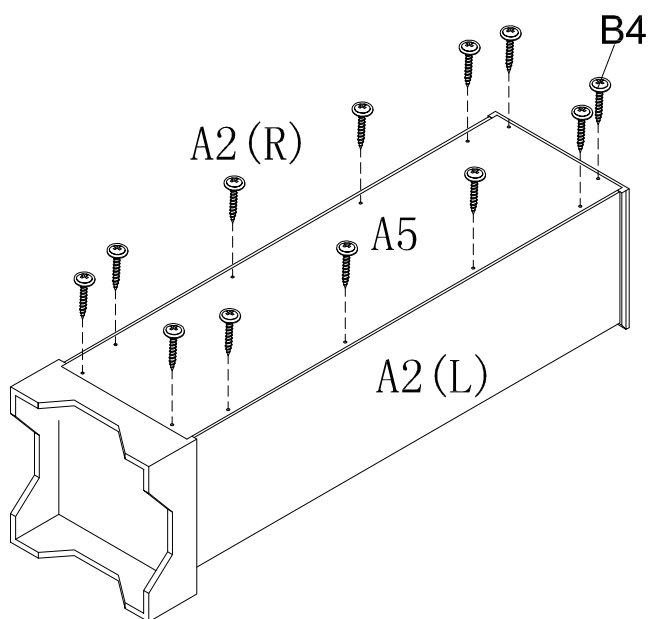

Attach Top Panel A1 to Side Panels A2(L&R) using Wood Dowels B1 and Cam-Locks B2.

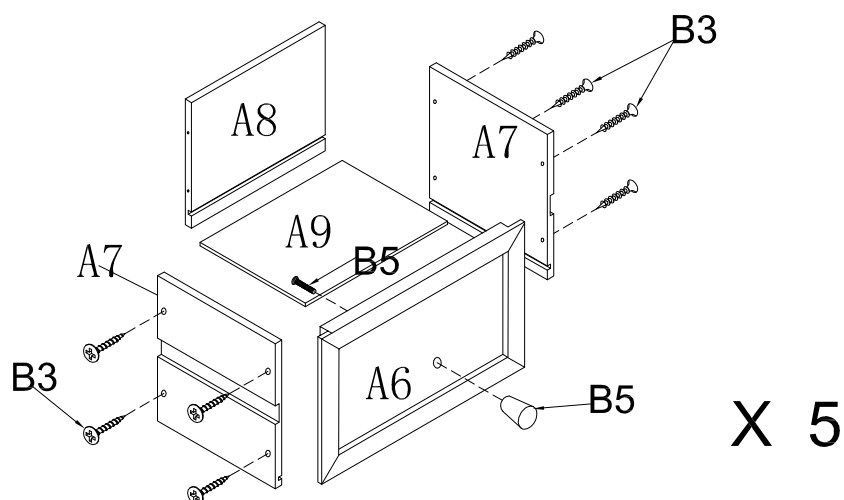

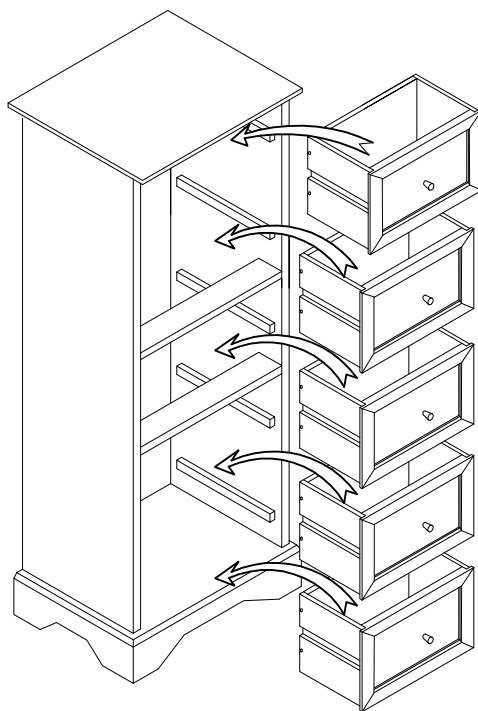
Attach Back Panel A5 to the back of the unit using Screws B4.

Step 5



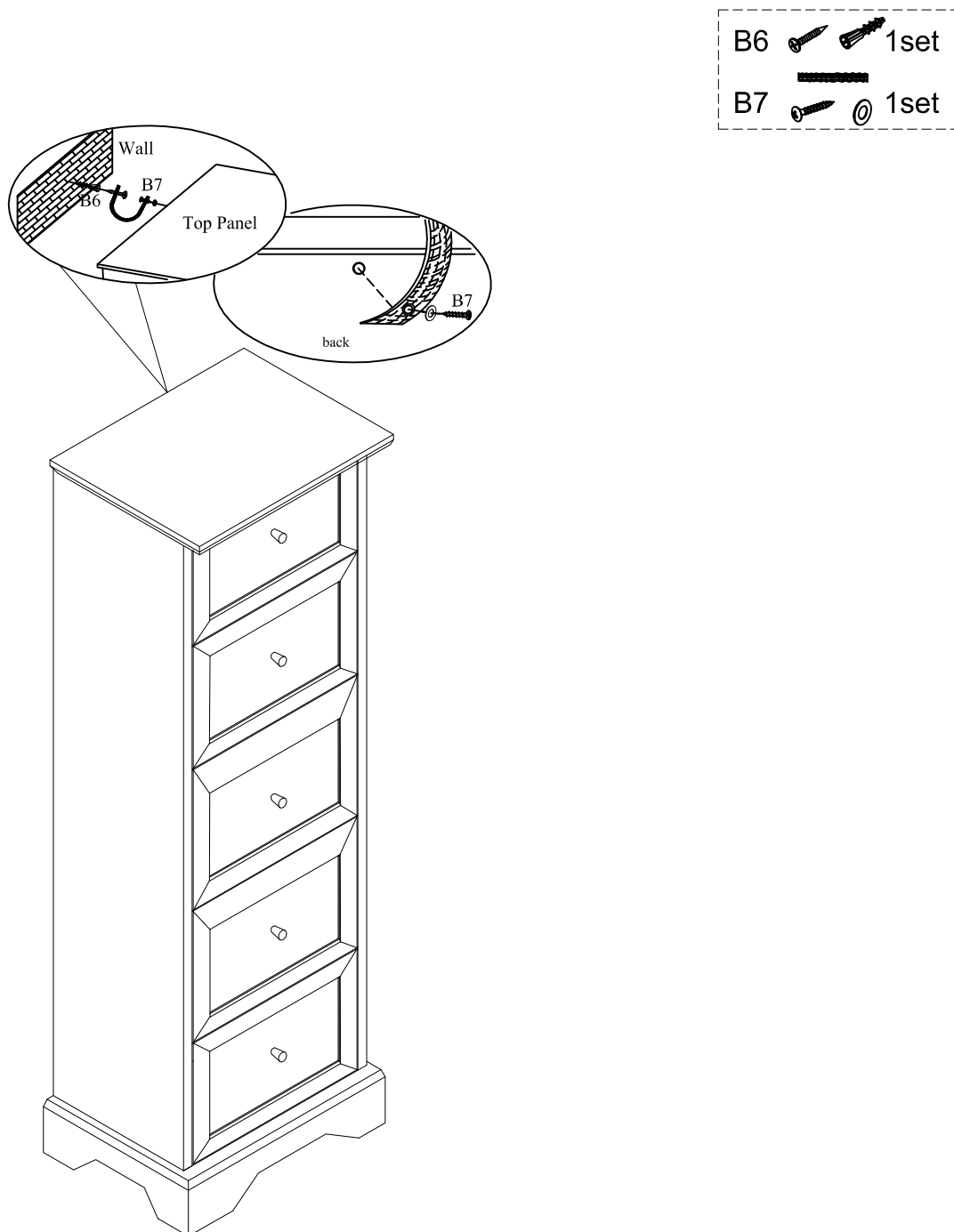
- 1). Assemble Drawer Side Panels A7 to Drawer Back Panel A8 using Screws B3.
- 2). Insert Drawer Bottom Panel A9 into the grooves on the Drawer Side Panels A7 and Drawer Back Panel A8.
- 3). Attach Handle B5 to Drawer Front Panel A6 using included bolt. Then attach Drawer Front Panel A6 to Drawer Side Panels A7 using Screws B3.

Insert Drawers into the cabinet.
