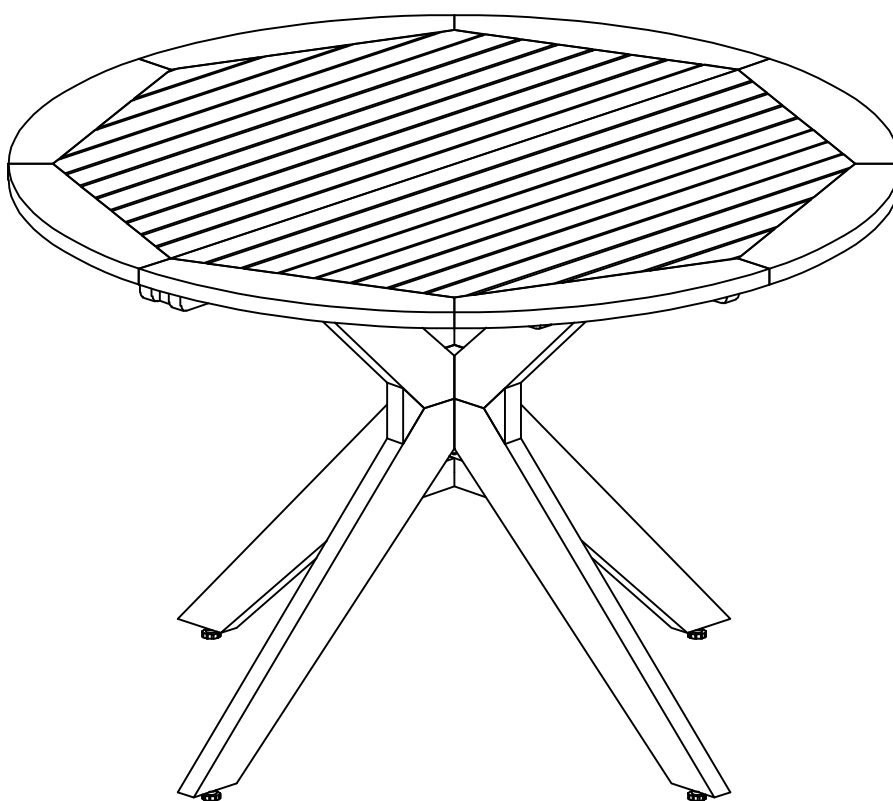

Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine.
Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.

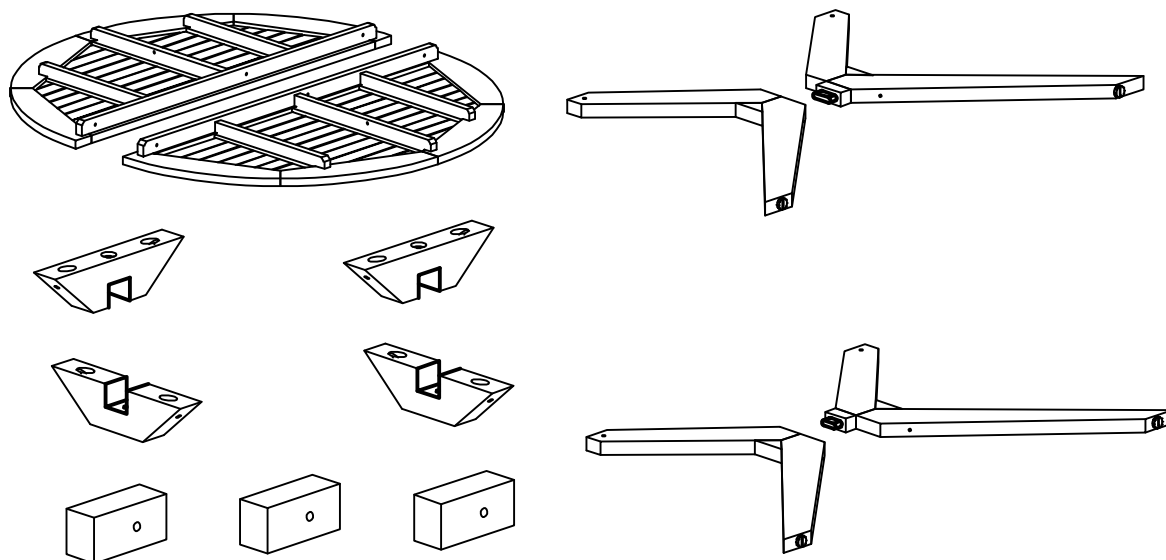
Assembly Steps

OVERVIEW



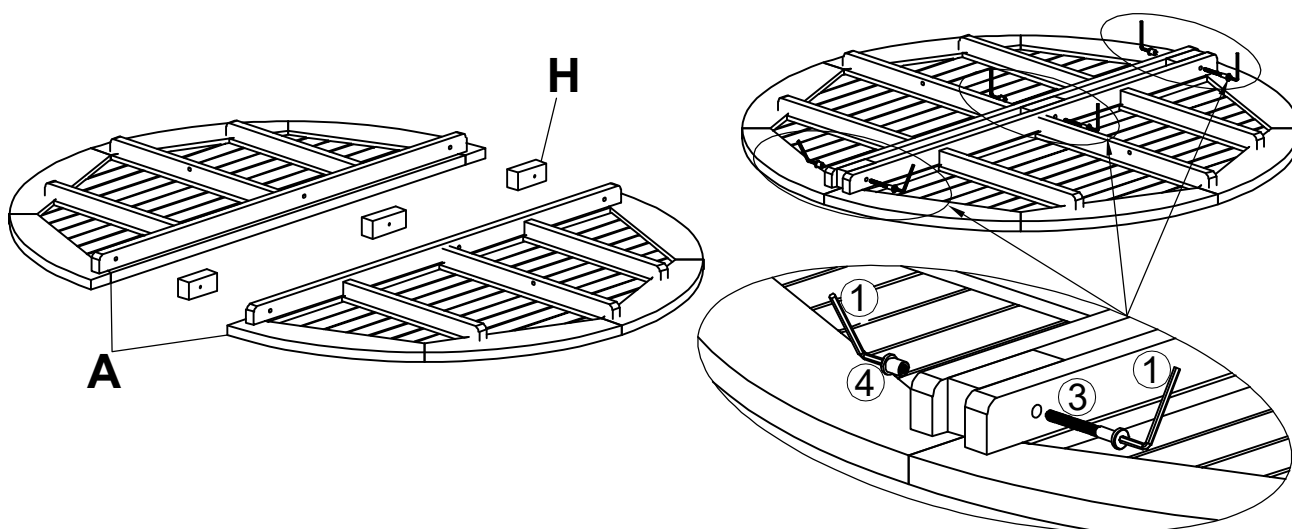
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

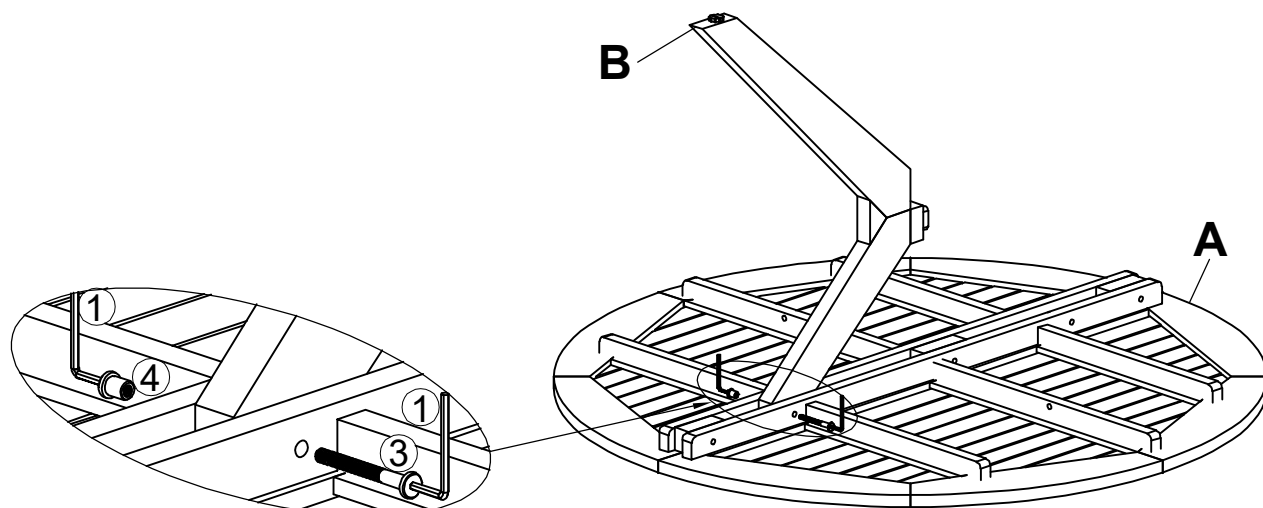
Step 2



To affix the two halves of the Table Top together, align the bolts mounting position of the Table Top (A) to the mounting position of the Block (H). Insert the Bolt (③) through the mounting position and affix the Table Top using Sleeve Nut (④) and 2 Allen Wrench (①), as shown as above picture.

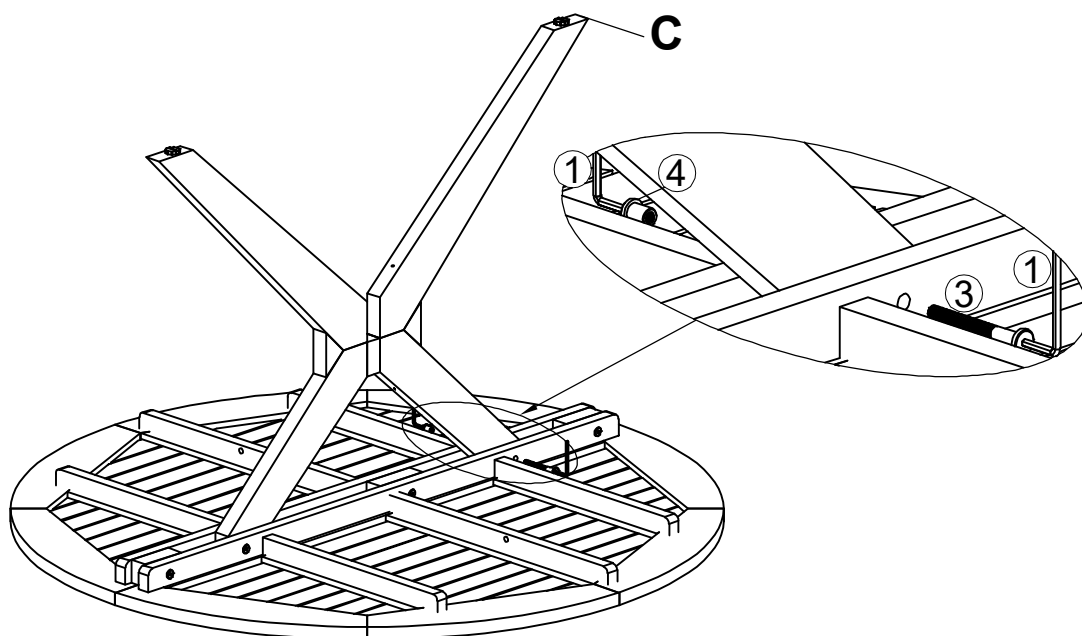
Fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



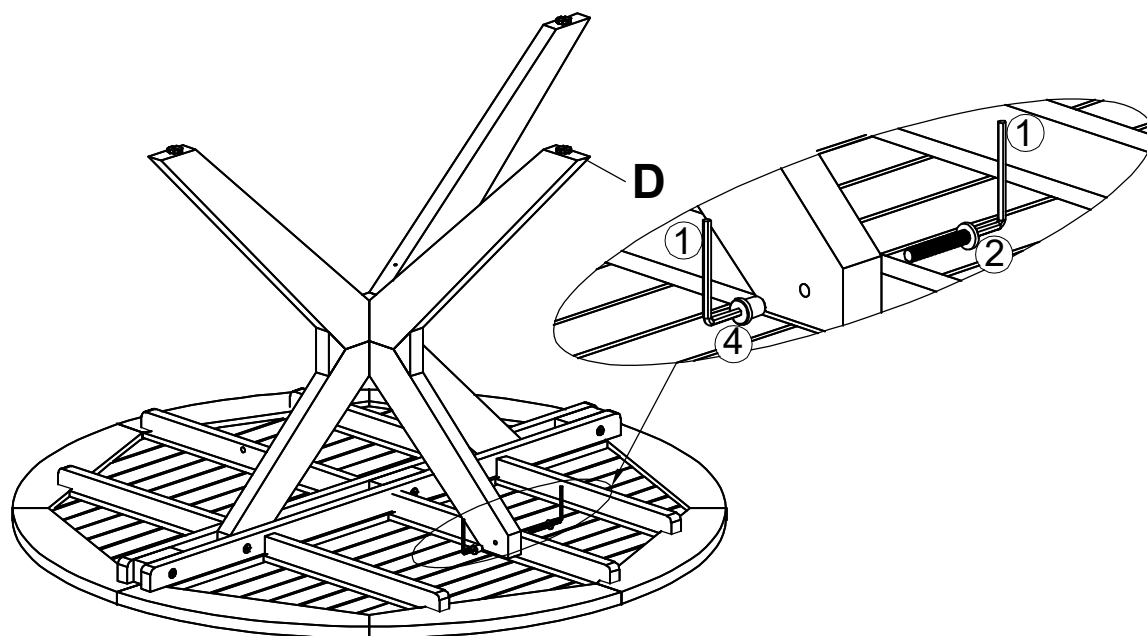
Position the First Leg (B) as shown above picture. To affix the First Leg (B) to the Table Top (A), using Bolt (③), Sleeve Nut (④) and 2 Allen Wrench (①) as above picture.
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



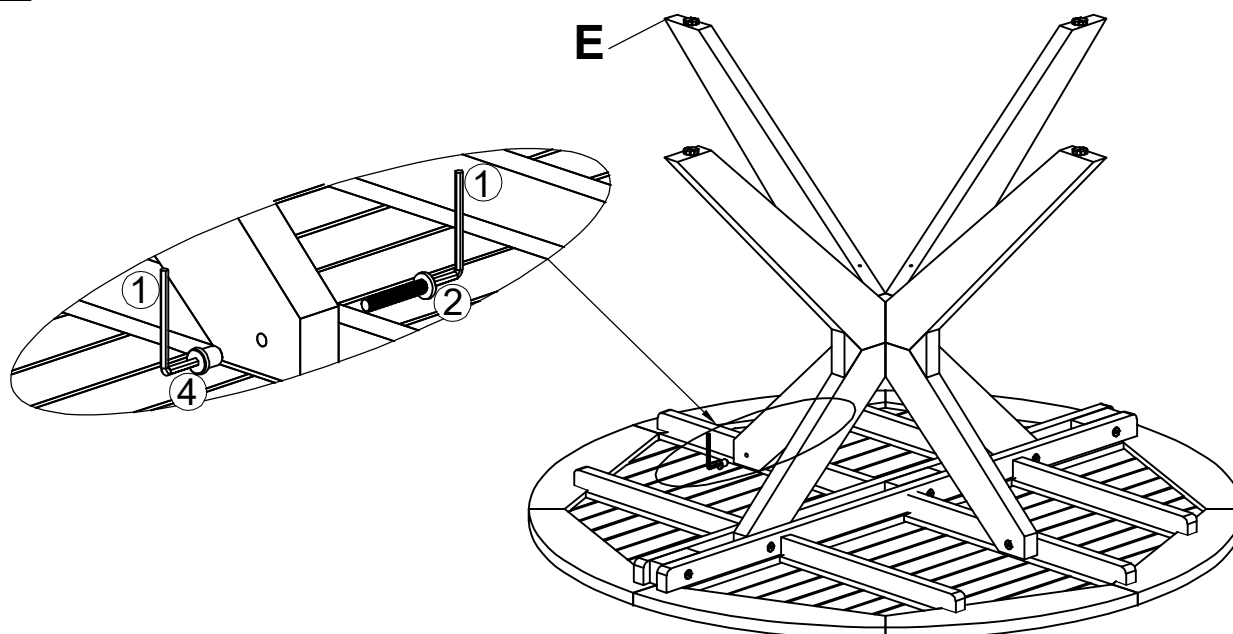
Repeat the same process as Step 3 to affix Second Leg (C) to Table Top (A), using Bolt (③), Sleeve Nut (④) and 2 Allen Wrench (①) as shown above picture.
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



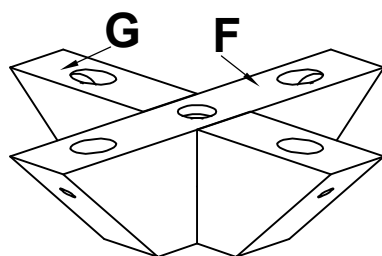
Position the Third Leg (D) as shown above picture. To affix the Third Leg (D) to the Table Top (A), using Bolt (②), Sleeve Nut (④) and 2 Allen Wrench (①) as above picture. **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 6

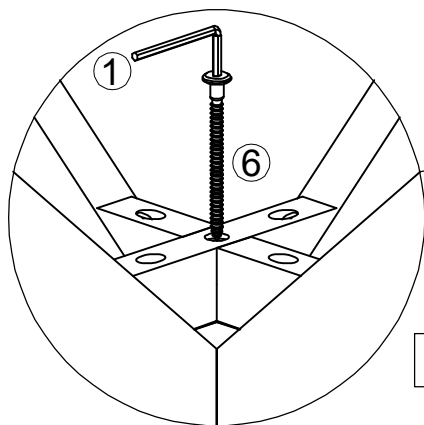


Repeat the same process as Step 5 to affix Fourth Leg (E) to Table Top (A), using Bolt (②), Sleeve Nut (④) and 2 Allen Wrench (①) as shown above picture. **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

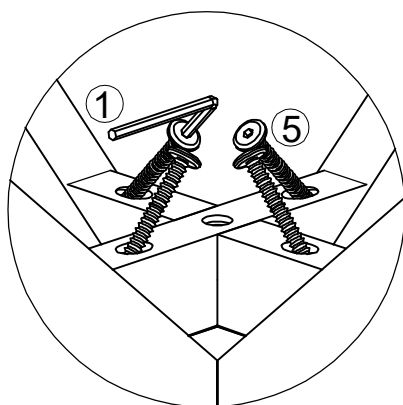
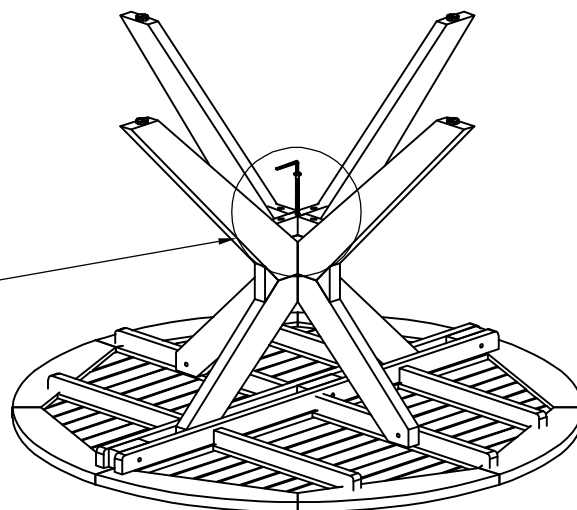

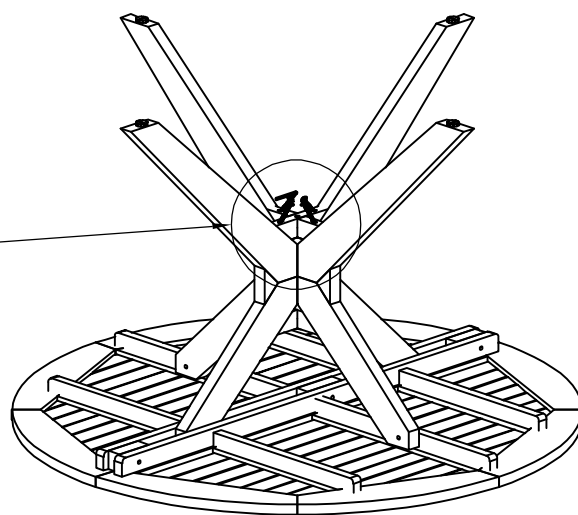

With assistance from your adult partners

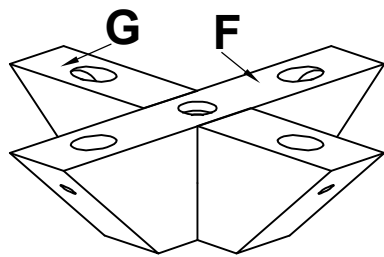
7.1) Attach Upper Cross Block (F) and Lower Cross Block (G) as shown above.

7.2) Place the block installed in step 7.1 in place as pictured and use Bolt (⑥) with Allen Wrench(①) to secure.

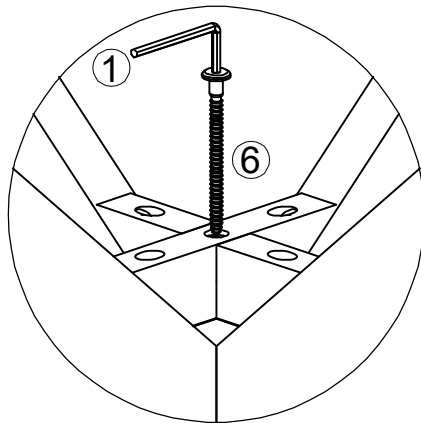
7.3) Using 4 Bolt (⑤) with Allen Wrench (①) to secure Block and Legs as pictured.

When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

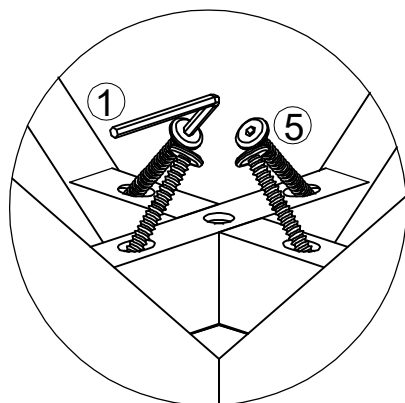
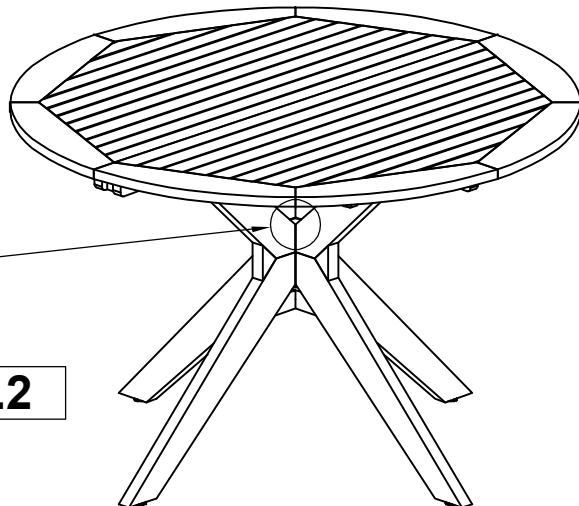

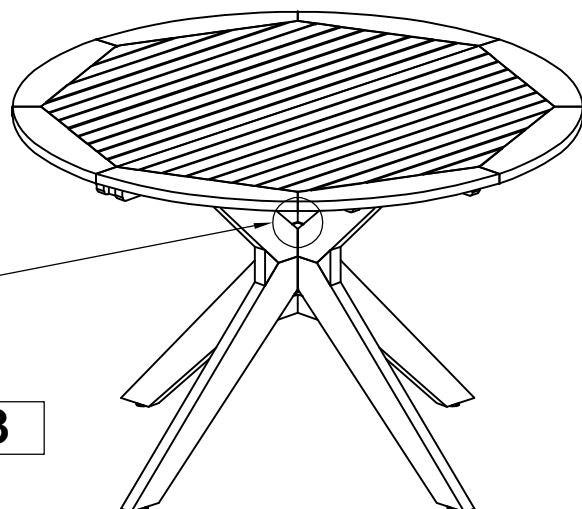

With assistance from your adult partners, turn right side up the Table.

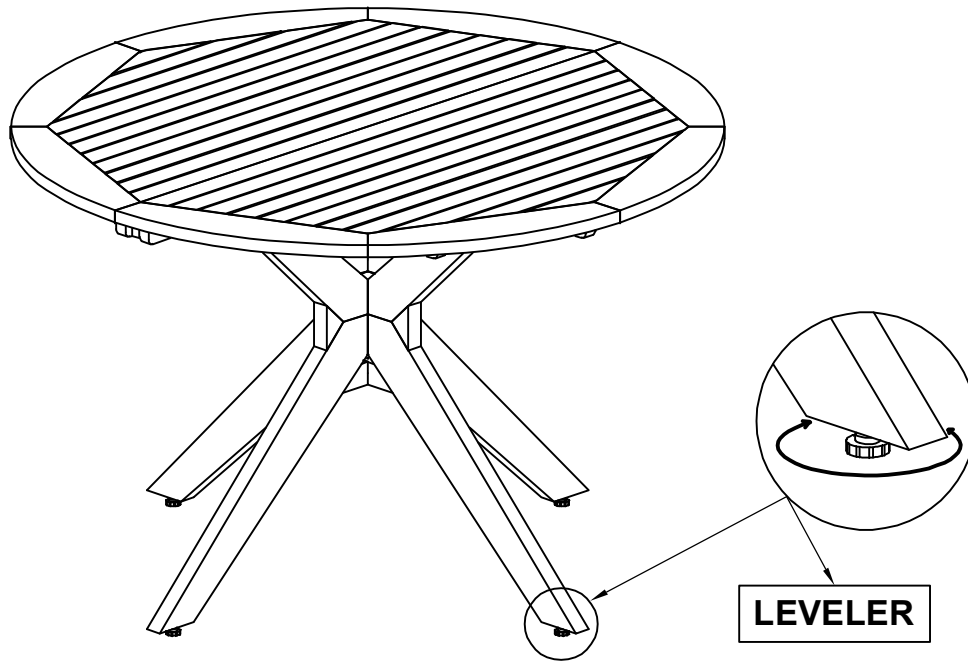
8.1) Attach Upper Cross Block (F) and Lower Cross Block (G) as shown above.

8.2) Place the block installed in step 8.1 in place as pictured and use Bolt (⑥) with Allen Wrench (①) to secure.

8.3) Using 4 Bolt (⑤) with Allen Wrench (①) to secure Block and Legs as pictured.

When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

Step 9



Stand the Table up, with assistance from your adult partner.
Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.
This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.
If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially.
Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.
If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and excute the same above process.
Your Table is ready for use.
This Table can only be used on the flat, level surface.
