

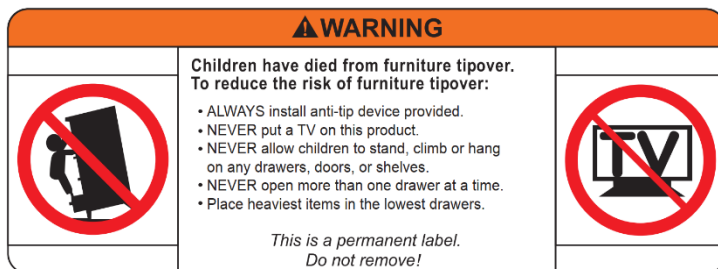
This Labeling Standard is designed to ensure that all warning labels are placed in the appropriate locations in accordance with the standards set in ASTM F2057-23 Standard Safety Specification for Clothing Storage Units (CSUs). Additionally, for those items that are not CSUs, if they include an Anti-tip kit, then a warning label is required.

- Each CSU must be tested and certified to pass each of the stability tests as described in ASTM F2057-23.
- To comply with the standard and to communicate to the consumer, 1 warning label must be placed in a specific location on the item as described below.
- Depending on the designation as set by Bernhardt Quality Control and Compliance, a label Not Designed for TV Use or Designed for TV Use must be placed on the item.
- Shallow drawer labels should be used on those drawers where the standard sizes are too tall for the drawer.

Label Designs – Standard Drawers and Panels

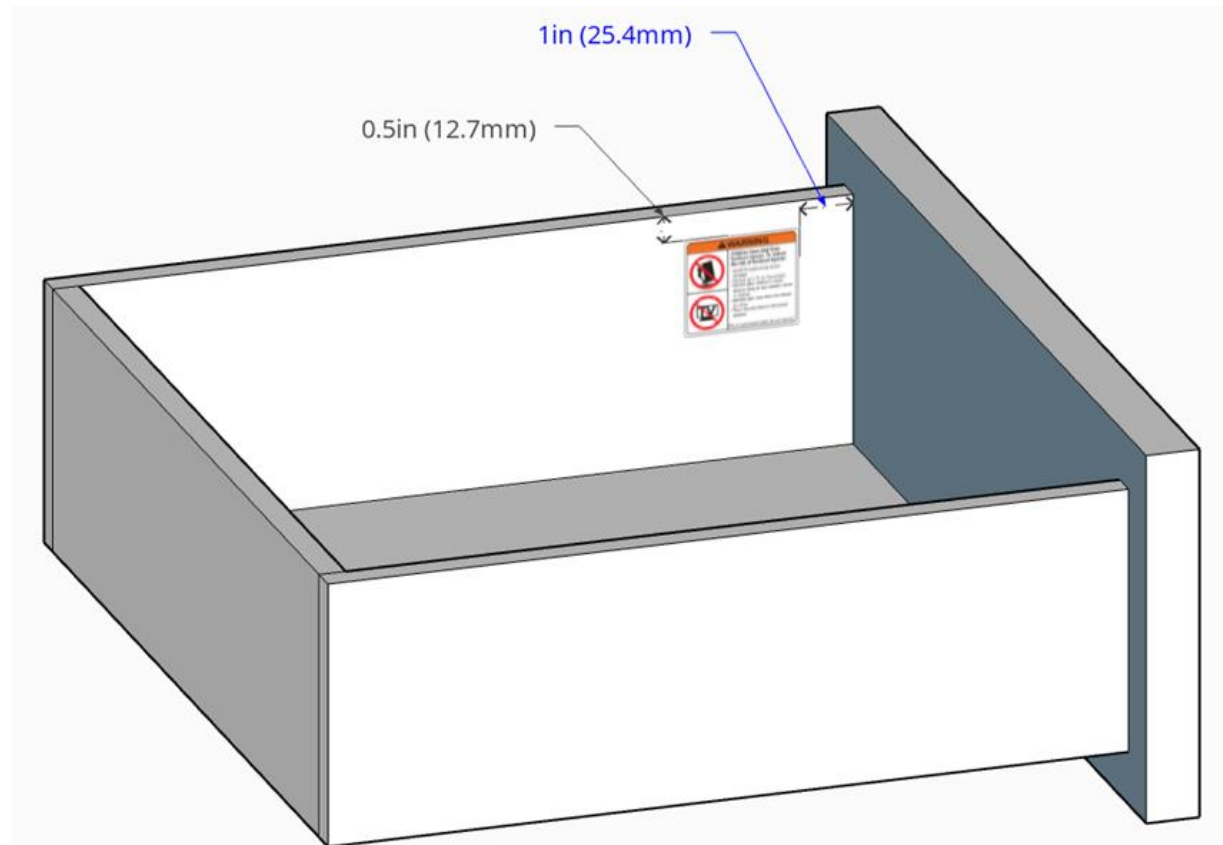


Label Designs – Shallow Drawers



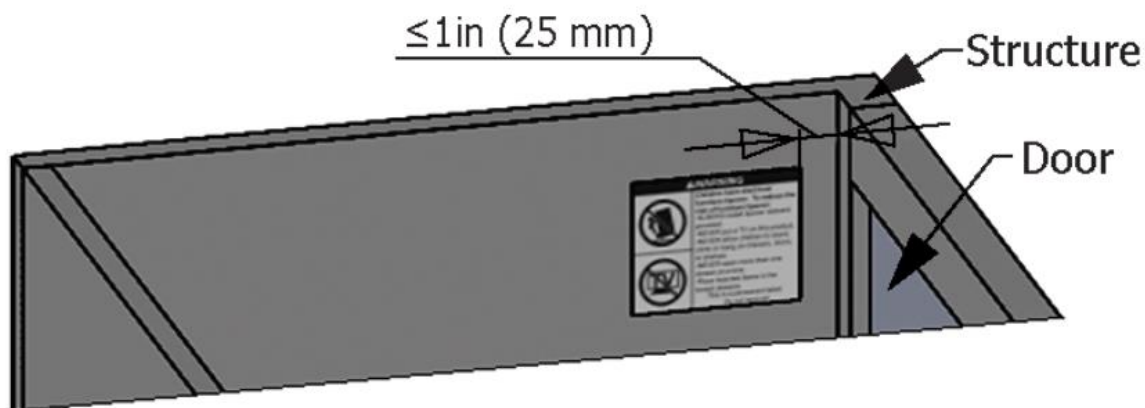
Label Placement – Items with Drawers

- Warning labels should be placed in the top left drawer on the right drawer side.
 - The label should be placed 0.5in (12.7mm) or less from the top of the drawer side.
 - The label should be placed 1in (25.4mm) or less from the drawer front.
- Label placement is the same regardless of whether the Not Designed for TV Use or Designed for TV Use labels are specified.
- Reminder: the warning label should be placed in the same drawer as the nameplate but placed on the opposite drawer side.



Label Placement – Items with Doors

- Items with doors have the option of having the warning label placed on the right-side end panel.
 - Right-side is designated with the consumer facing the item in its intended use position.
- The warning label should be placed 1in from the front structure of the unit when the door is closed.
