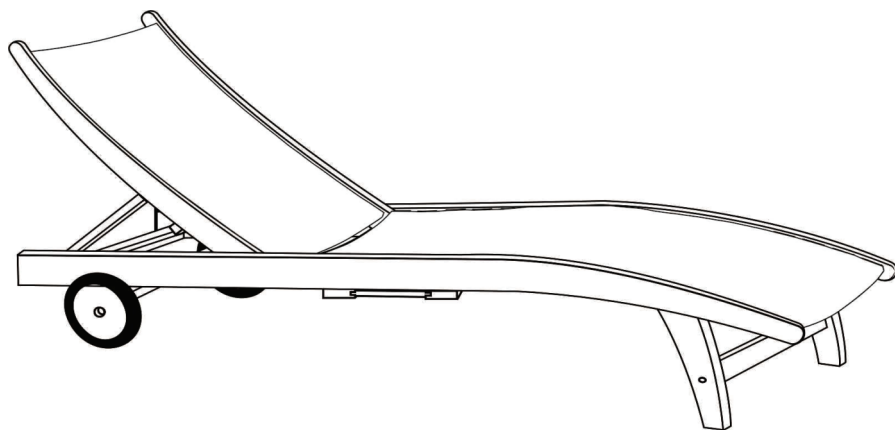

Assembly Guide



IMPORTANT: please read these instructions fully before starting assembly



**SAFETY AND
CARE ADVICE**



NO POWER TOOLS

- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fittings from their bags and separate into groups.
- We do not recommend use of power tools - this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (same room) as possible.
- Do not over tighten the nuts to avoid damage to the threads.
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time, check there are no loose screws in this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.
- Unless otherwise stated, this product is designed for domestic use and is not certified for commercial or contract settings.

IMPORTANT: MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Daily cleaning:

Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Use only clean water. Wipe dry with a clean soft cloth.

Do not use detergents, solvents or other chemicals on oiled surfaces, as this may cause discoloration. Color stains from eg. red wine or the like must be wiped off immediately.

Maintenance:

Furniture with an oiled surface must be treated with a suitable furniture oil as needed, but at least twice a year. Start by cleaning the furniture according to the above instructions for daily cleaning.

Smaller stains or scratches can be removed with sandpaper grain 180. Always sand along the wood's veins. Always use great care on veneered parts as the veneer is often less than 1 mm. in thickness. Avoid grinding on edges and corners.

The surface must be completely clean and dry before applying the oil.

Apply oil with a clean lint -free cloth. The oil must always be applied along the grains of the wood.

Let the oil soak for 15 minutes. The surface often feels rough after oiling. This is a natural reaction due to the wood's fibers rising. Sand easily with sandpaper grain 220- 280 and along the grains of the wood.

Remove excess oil and dust from sanding with a clean lint - free cloth. Rinse with a clean lint - free cloth until the desired surface is obtained. Let the furniture dry for at least 24 hours before using it again.

Storage of garden furniture and garden products

The best way to extend the life of your garden product is to clean it regularly and before storage.

Store the product in a cool, dry and ventilated place indoors or covered when the temperature is below 5 degrees Celsius or when weather conditions require it

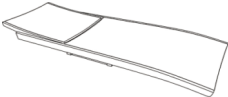
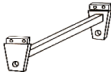
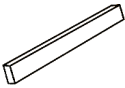

Note:

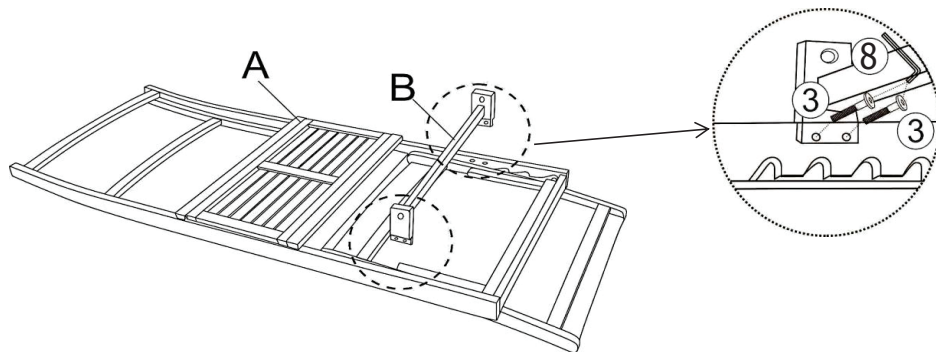
- Use a clear, flat surface to avoid bumps or scratches before assembling.
- Insert all fixings loosely at first to allow for alignment; only tighten them once everything is properly positioned, as some adjustment may be required.
- Avoid over-tightening, as this may damage the parts.
- Seek assistance when moving large or heavy parts.

STEP 1

Lay all your components and fixings out.

Place the lounger frame [A] upside down and align 1 x wheel frame [B] with the pre-drilled holes.

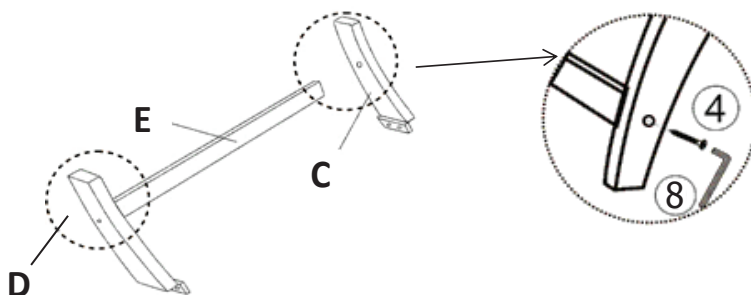
Attach using 2 x bolts [3] - 4 in total. Tighten with allen key [8].



STEP 2

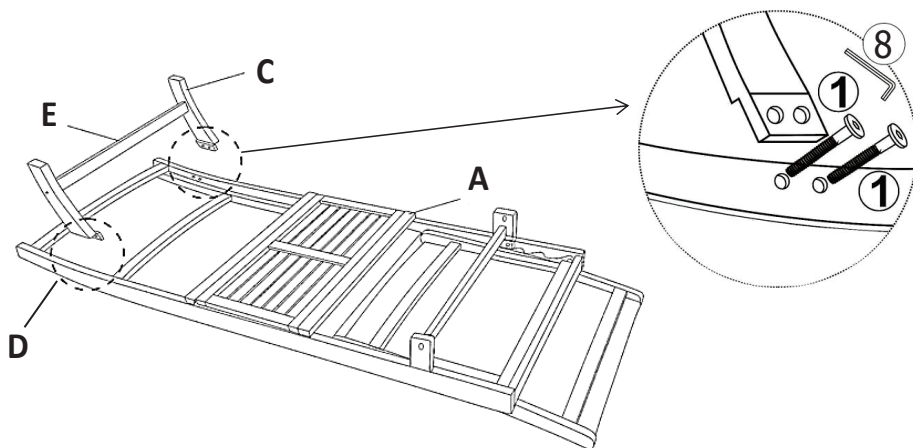
Align 2 x lounger legs [C + D] to the ends of support bar [E].

Attach using 2 x screw [4] and tighten with allen key [8].



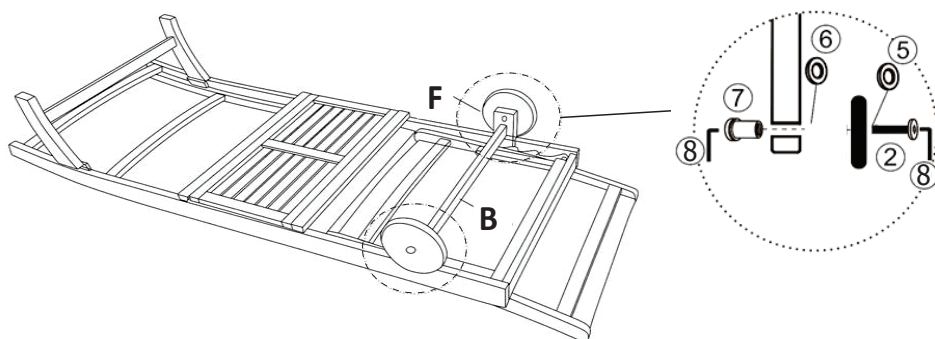
STEP 3

Align legs [C + D] to the pre-drilled holes on lounge frame [A] and secure using 4 x bolts [1]. Tighten with allen key [8].



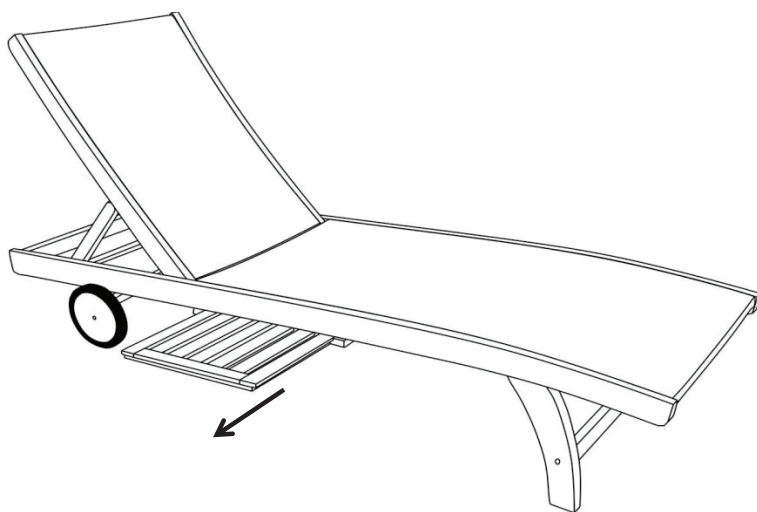
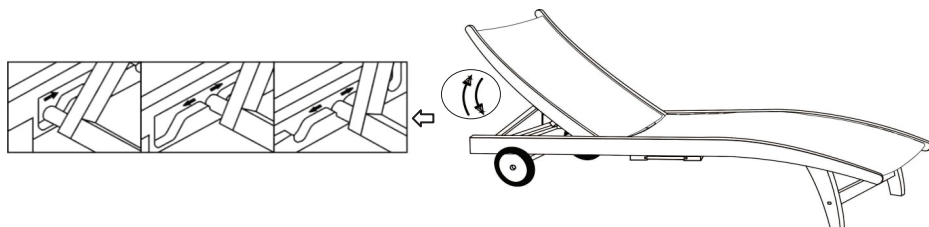
STEP 4

Attach 2 x wheels [F] to wheel frame [B] using 2 x sleeve nuts [7] + 2 x washers [5 + 6] and 2 x bolts [2]. Tighten both sides with allen keys [8].



STEP 5

Carefully, and with help, flip the lounger onto the wheels and leg stand. Lift and slot the back support to your desired position.

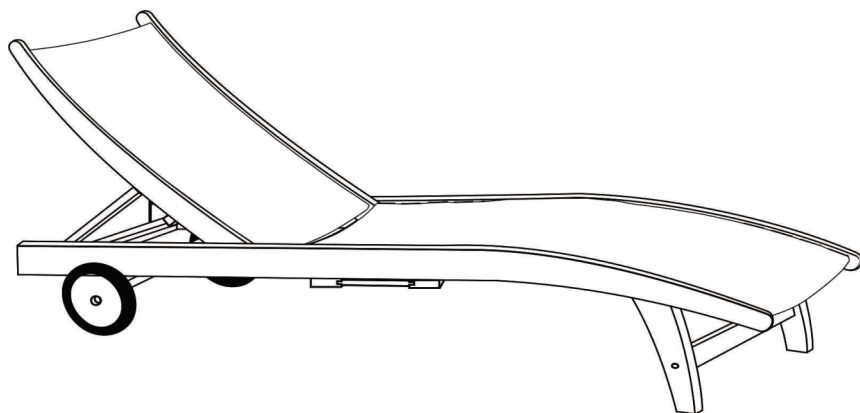

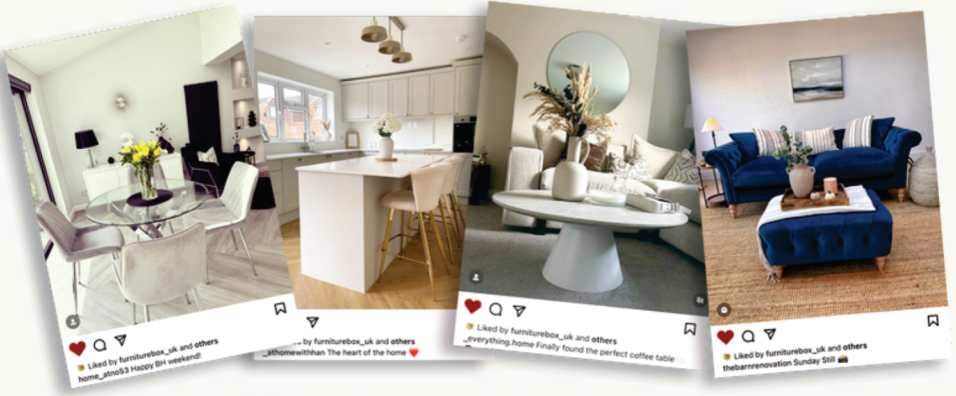
Please ensure any and all fixings and fittings are FULLY tightened before using this product.
