

- 3.As the exclusive remedy under this Warranty, we (at our sole option) will repair or replace any defective furniture component. We may require independent confirmation of the claimed defect and proof of purchase. Replacement parts will be warranted for only the remaining period of the original Warranty. SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY for ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND and all such damages are EXCLUDED FROM THIS WARRANTY, such as loss of use, disassembly,transportation,labor or damage to property on or near the product. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.
- 4. This Warranty applies only to warranted defects that first a rise and are reported to with in the warranty coverage period.
