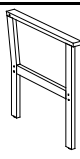
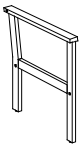
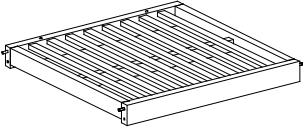
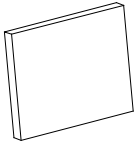
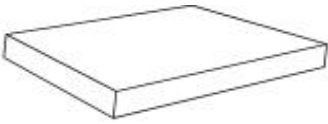
CAUTION: You must read this before you proceed.



CAUTION : This Armhair is NOT a TOY. Keep your child / children at bay in the process of assembly.

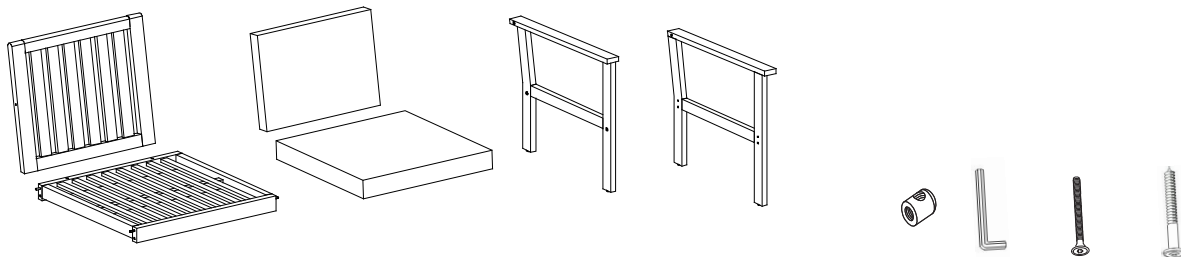
For turning the Armchair and to prevent damage to the armchair, 02 persons may be needed to execute this action.

Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:



Read instructions, cover to cover.



Have 2 adults on hand for assembly.



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.



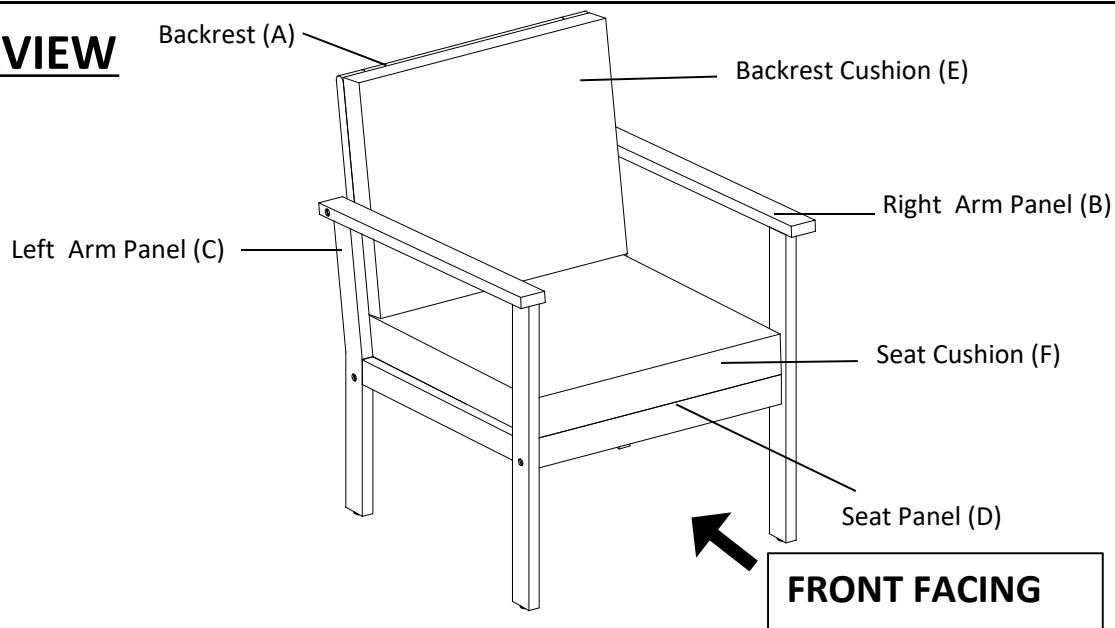
Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



Save all packaging until finished.

OVERVIEW

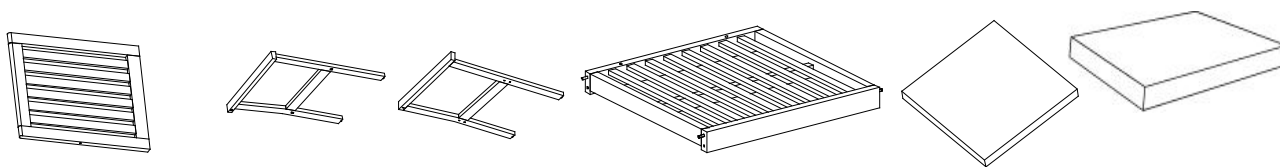


This **Armchair** has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the **Armchair** parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

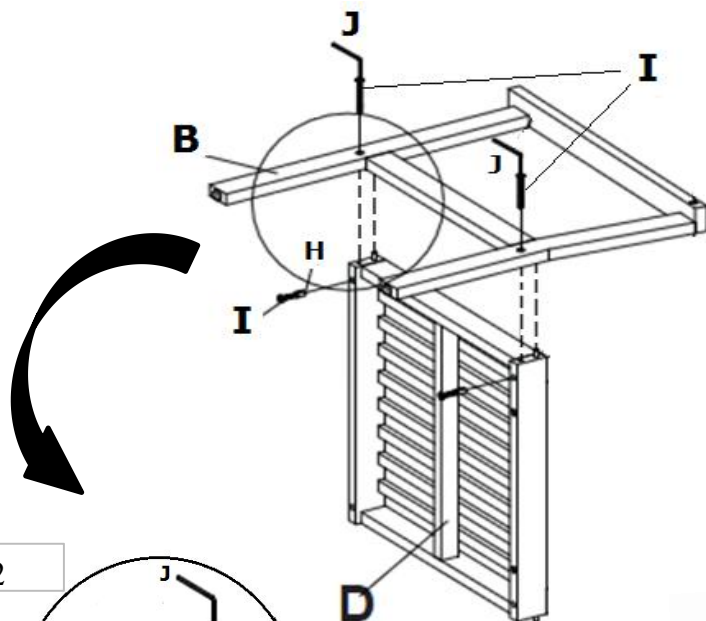
Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1

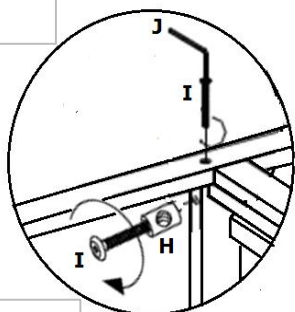


Unpack and place all parts on a clean non marring flat surface .

Position Seat Panel (D) and Right Arm Panel (B) as shown in picture above.

Align the iron dowels into the positions in the arms.

Then affix Right Arm Panel (B) (facing skywards) with Seat Panel (D).

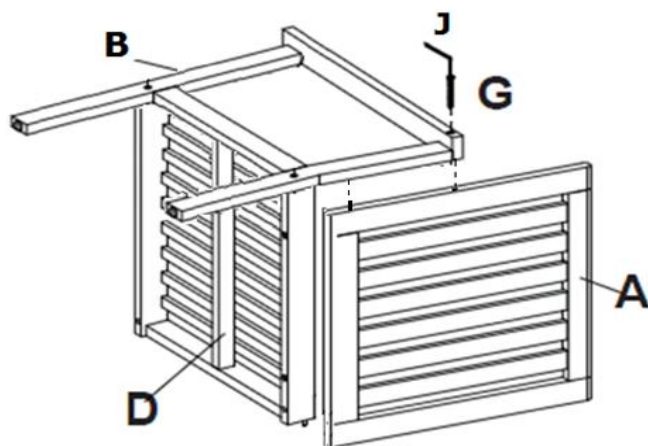
Step 2.1: Attach Bolt (I) to the top of Cross Nut (H) by hand, turning clockwise. Insert both into the housing position inside the Seat Panel (D).

Step 2.2: Insert Bolt (I) through the Right Arm Panel (B) into Cross Nut (H) inside the Seat Panel (D), tighten with the Allen Key (J) as shown in Pic.1

Remove the first Bolt (I) from step 2.1 by hand, as shown in Pic.2

LOOSELY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS up to 80%.

Step 3



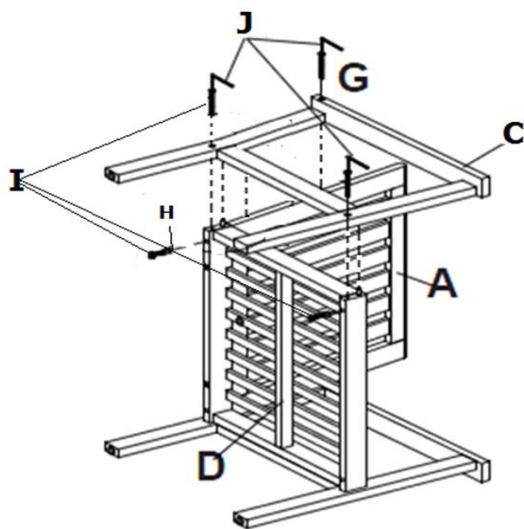
Then continue position Backrest (A) as shown in picture above.

Align the iron dowel into the positions in the arms.

Affix Right Arm Panel (B) (facing skywards) with Backrest (A) by using Screw (G) and Allen Key (J)

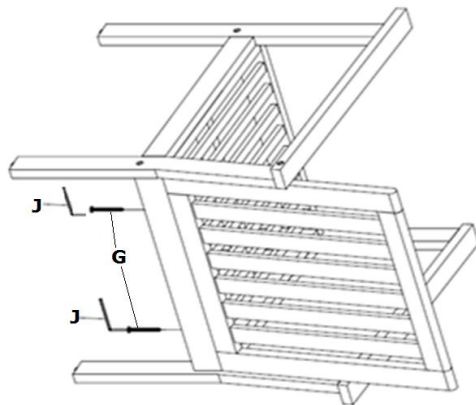
LOOSELY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS up to 80%.

Step 4



With the help from your partner, turn the Chair to rest on Right Arm Panel (B) so that Left Arm Panel (C) is now facing skywards. Repeat the same process by affixing Screw (G), Cross Nuts (H), Bolts (I) to designated points
LOOSELY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS up to 80%.

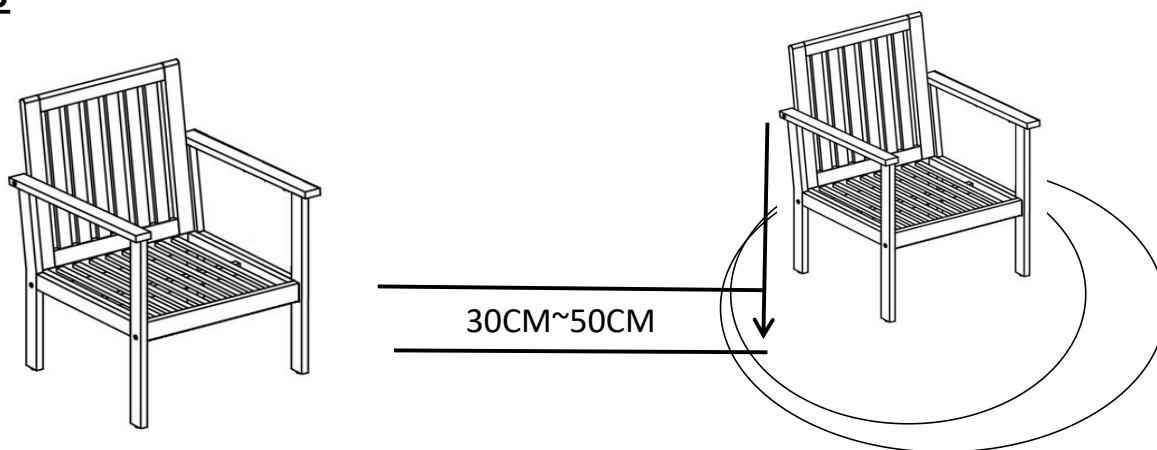
Step 5



Use Screw (G) and Allen Key (J) to attach Backrest Panel (A) and Seat Panel (D).

LOOSELY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS up to 80%.

Step 6



Turn the Armchair right side up
Place the Armchair on a **LEVEL SURFACE** to see if it wobbles.

If it wobbles, lift the Armchair to some 30cm to 50cm height from the ground.

Keep your feet and toes well away from the drop zone.

Drop the Armchair freely and vertically with the four legs, hitting the ground, at the same time.

This Drop Test will help to ensure that all the screws and gaps to all reach full alignment status.

Test again for evenness on a **LEVEL SURFACE**.

If no wobbles found, proceed to tighten all the screws.

CAUTION: When tightening these screws, tighten sequentially.

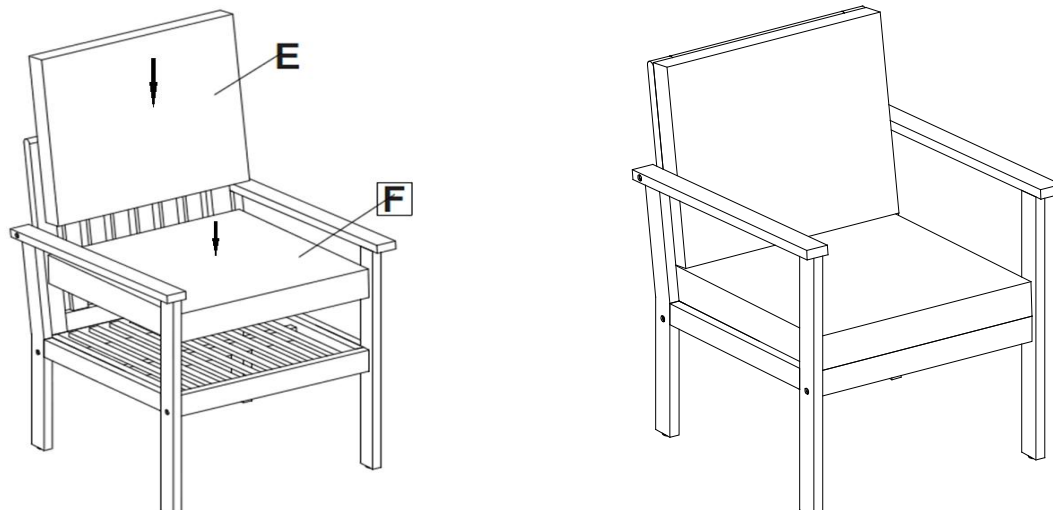
DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

This would cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the screws and execute this same drop tests.

WARNING ! IF CHAIR IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Step 7



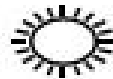
Inspect the chair to ensure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, ensure all screws, bolts are fully locked into position and secured.

Place Seat Cushion (F) & Backrest Cushion (E) into the seat of the Armchair.

The Armchair is ready to be used.

Care & Maintenance

-   ☒ Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-   ☒ Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
-   ☒ To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
-   ☒ Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-   ☒ Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-   ☒ To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
-   ☒ Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-   ☒ Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-   ☒ Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
