Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and/or place under patio or awings.



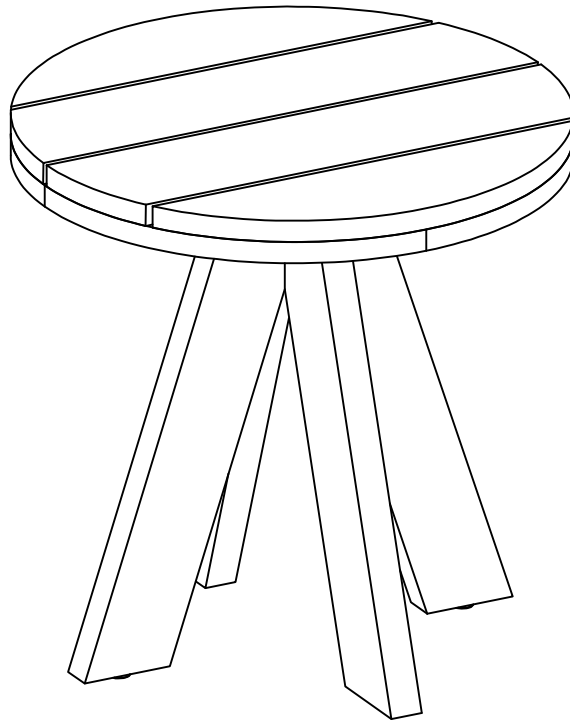
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

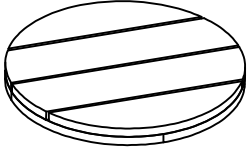
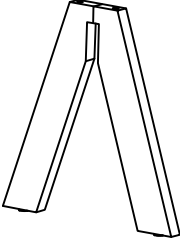
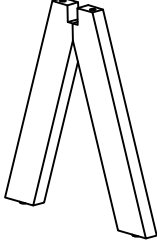

SIDE TABLE

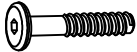


Caution: This Table is NOT a TOY.

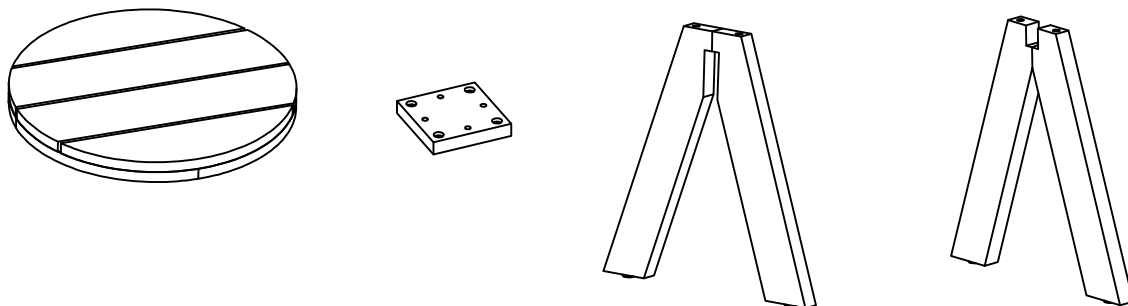
Assembly Preparation:

Overview



This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

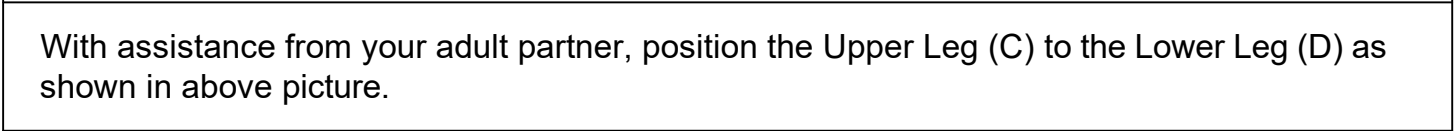
STEP 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

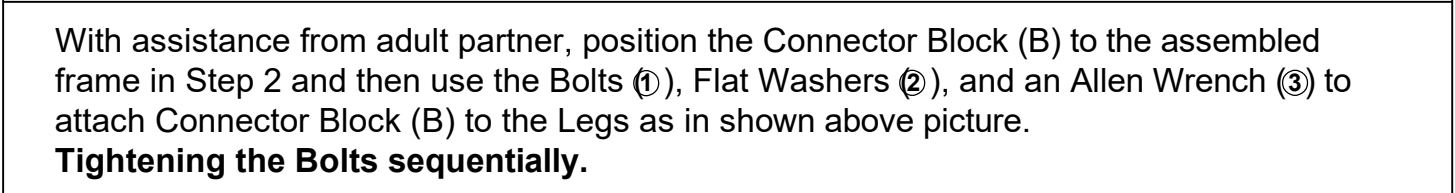
STEP 2

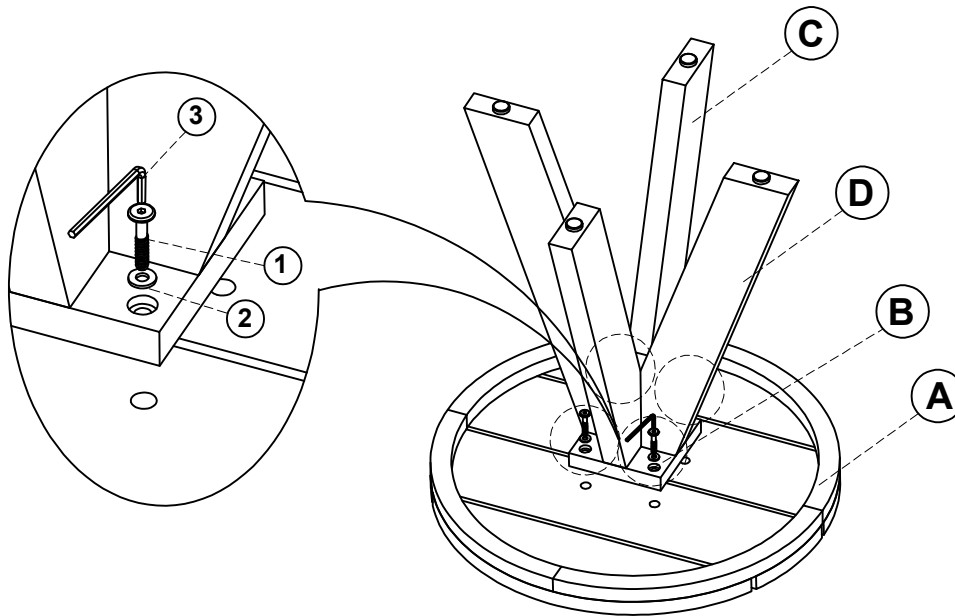
STEP 3

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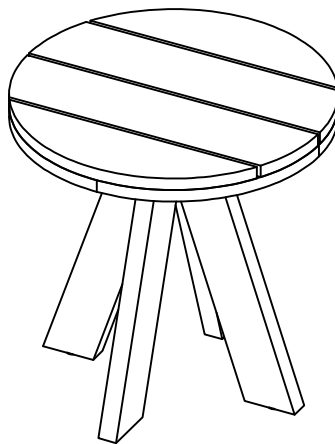
STEP 4



With assistance from another adult, place the Table Top (A) facing down and then attach the assembled frame in Step 3 to the Table Top (A) using Bolts (1), and Flat Washers (2), with Allen Wrench (3), as shown in above picture.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

STEP 5



Stand the Table up.

Exert pressure floorwards, on to the Table with bolt your hands.

This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.

Check for wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and excute the same above process.

WARNING!! IF TABLE IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
