
# **Assembly Instructions**

Keep your child / children at bay in the process of assembly.


For turning the Chair and to prevent damage to the Chair, 02 persons may be needed to execute this action.

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-


## Assembly Steps



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Attach Backrest Panel (D) to Left Leg Panel With Pre-installed Leveller (A), secure by using Screw (②) with Allen Key(③)

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

### Step 3




With assistance from your adult partners, lay down the Chair Attach mortise of Seat Panel (C) to tenon of the Left Leg Panel With Preinstalled Leveller (A)



Attach mortise of Right Leg Panel With Pre-installed Leveller (B) to tenon of the Seat Panel (C)

Secure by using Screw (1) with Allen Key(3)


#### **Loosely tighten the Screws**



Insert Seat Support Bar (E) and Leg Support Bar (F) to Left Leg Panel With Pre-Installed Leveller (A) and Right Leg Panel With Pre-installed Leveller (B)


Secure Right Leg Panel With Pre-installed Leveller (B) to Seat Support Bar (E) and Leg Support Bar (F) by using Screws (1) and Allen Key (3)

Do not fully tighten the Screws.



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Chair right side up Secure Seat Support Bar (E) and Leg Support Bar (F) to Left Leg Panel With Preinstalled Leveller (A) by using Screws ( 1) and Allen Key (3)


Do not fully tighten the Screws.



Inspect the Chair and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints


With assistance from your adult partners, adjust the Levellers to desired height to avoid wobbles



Place Seat Cushion(G) and Backrest Cushions (H) on to the Chair using the velcro straps as shown above.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.



Note: This is optional step in case we want to connect all chairs in a set together and should be done before placing cushion

With assistance from your adult partners, up side down the chairs and using pre-fixed clip ti connect the chairs together

#### Care & Maintenance



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface




Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.

 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor prodcts, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.





To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



Keep away from sources of ignition.



Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

#### Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
