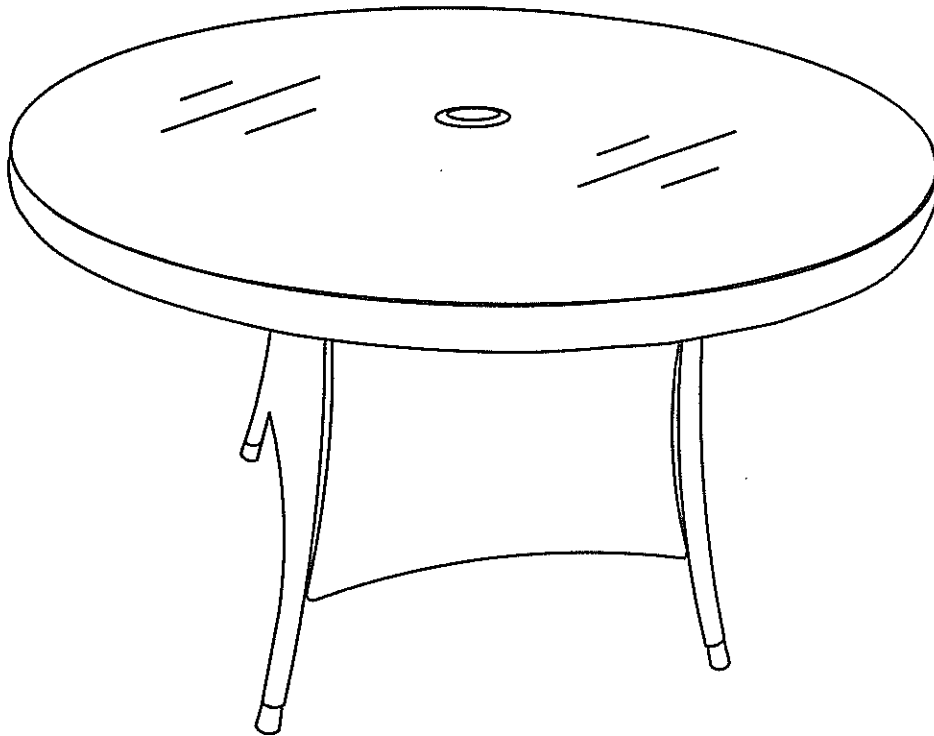

### Before you start



#### Warnings

Ensure that this product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.

This product should only be used on firm, level ground.

Keep small parts out of reach of children.

Do not stand or climb onto this product.

This product is intended for **domestic use** only.

Ensure the table is always placed on level ground.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly used. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrect use of this product.

**This table is not intended to support a parasol separately. A parasol base with suitable weight must be used to support your parasol.**



#### Dos

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on suitable surface to prevent scratching your product.

Check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts listed.

Check all screws and bolts and tightened and inspect regularly.

We recommend the use of furniture covers to protect your product when not in use.

During bad weather or in winter months, the product should be stored in a cool, dry place. Before storage, ensure that the product is clean and dry.

To clean, wipe down with a sponge and warm soapy water and wipe with a clean, dry cloth.

When cleaning glass panels use a damp cloth or leather with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary; do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives since these substances scratch glass.



#### Don'ts

Do not stand or climb onto the product.

Do not use power tools to construct this product.

Do not sit or lean onto the rims of this product.

Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaner.

Do not use this table as a ladder as this could lead to the table becoming unbalanced and overturning.

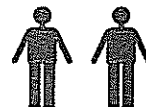
Do not place very hot or very cold items on the glass surface unless adequately thick table-mats are used to prevent such items from coming into contact with the glass.

Do not use the glass as a chopping surface. Do not strike glass with hard or pointed items.

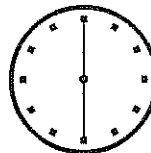
Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

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## Assembly Instructions



### Step by step assembly instructions

#### Step One

Place the Glass Top (C) on a soft, level place. Do not let the Glass Top hinder the assembly of other parts.

With the help of another person, place Table Top Frame (A) upside down on a flat, non-abrasive surface to avoid scratching the table surface or rim.

#### Step Two

Place the Table Legs/Base (B) onto the Table Top Frame (A), aligning all holes in each part. Loosely attach the Table Legs to the Table Top Frame (A) using Flat Washers (G), Spring Washers (F) and Bolts (E).

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### Step Three

Only tighten the bolts when all bolts and washers are in place and turn freely. Once you are satisfied with the alignment of the components carefully tighten all bolts using Spanner (H).

Do not over-tighten.

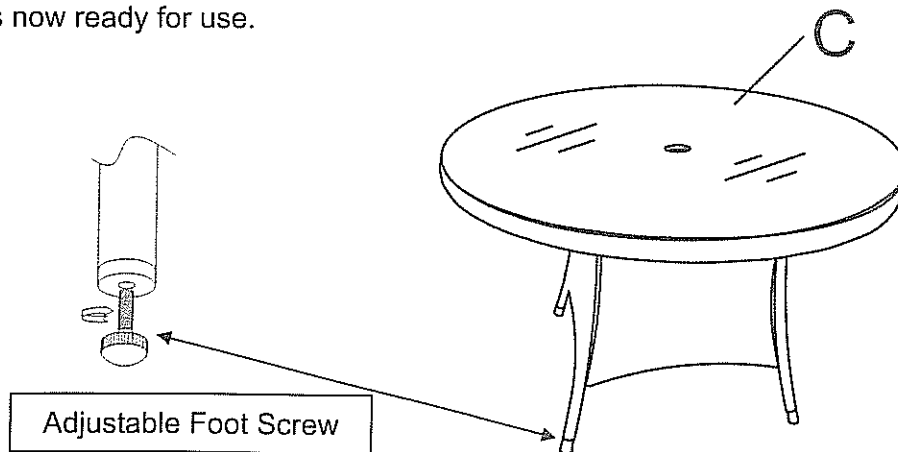
Cover each bolt with Bolt End Cap (D).

### Step Four

With the help of another person, carefully turn the table in the upright position. Level the table by adjustable feet screw.

Carefully place the Glass Top (C) on the Table Top Frame (A) and make sure they match each other. Make sure the glass top is fully inlaid in the Table Top Frame (A).

Your table is now ready for use.



Note: This table is not designed to hold the parasol separately.

Parasol base with suitable weight should always be used.
