1. Product Overview

This inflatable party tent is made of high-strength, high-density materials and utilizes advanced inflation technology, providing a convenient and reliable solution for outdoor camping, temporary events and more. With a stable frame, the tent can be set up quickly after inflating and has excellent waterproof, windproof, UV protection and heat preservation properties.

2. Product Features

1. **Quick Setup:** The inflation system quickly fills the tent, significantly reducing setup time.
2. **Lightweight and Durable:** Made from lightweight materials, the tent is easy to carry and transport while maintaining high durability.
3. **Waterproof and Windproof:** The tent features waterproof fabric and a stable inflatable frame, effectively preventing intrusion from light rain and wind.
4. **Easy to Store:** The inflatable tent can be folded and stored, saving storage space.

3. Instructions for Use

1、Preparations:

- Check if the tent and accessories are complete and undamaged.
- Choose a flat surface free of sharp objects, and clear away debris to ensure the safety of the setup area.

2、Setup Steps:

- ① **Unfold the Tent:** Gently unfold the main body of the inflatable tent, ensuring there are no folds or twists to facilitate the subsequent inflation process.

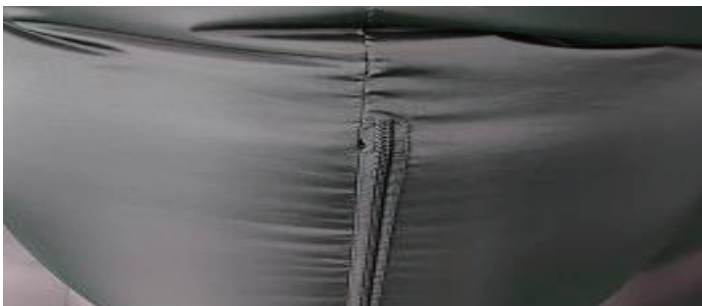

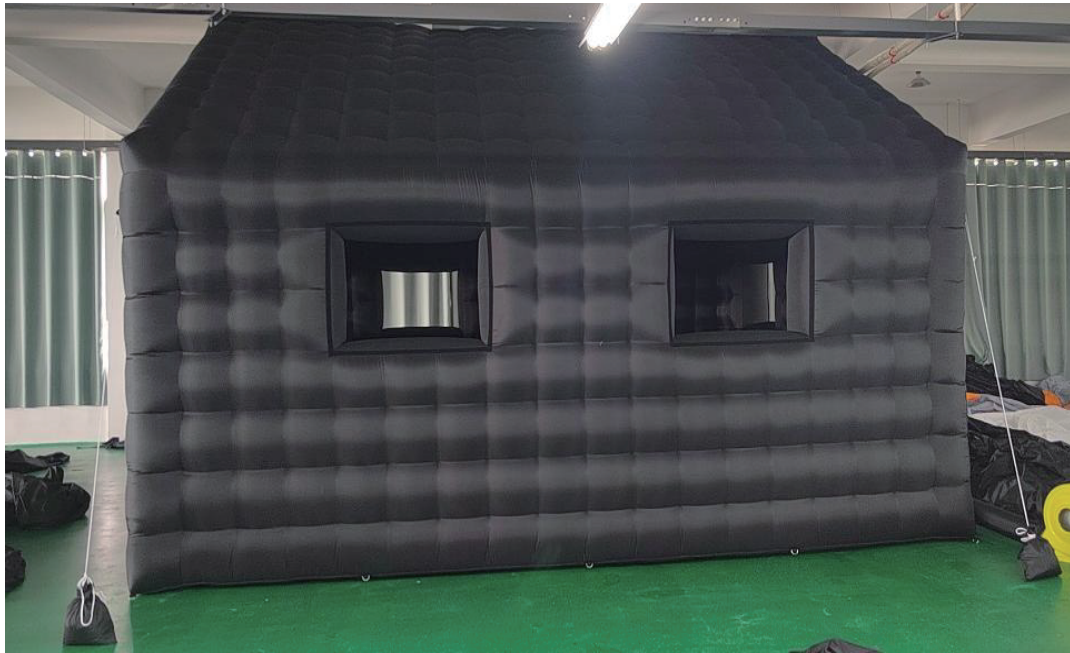
② **Connect the Air Pump:** Securely connect the air pump's outlet hose to the tent's inflation port. There are two inflation ports; one should be securely tied off while inflating with the other. Ensure the connection is firm and there are no air leaks. See diagram.



③ **Start Inflating:** Turn on the power switch of the air pump to begin inflating. During the inflation process, closely monitor the tent to ensure all parts are evenly inflated. Avoid overinflation or underinflation.



④ **Secure the Tent After Inflation:** Once inflation is complete, secure the tent. Use ground nails and guy ropes to anchor the four corners of the tent to the ground, ensuring that the tent remains stable and does not move or shake during inflation and use. See diagram.



⑤ **Window Installation Steps:** First align and attach the top edge, then align and attach both sides, and finally attach the bottom edge. .



4. Precautions

1. **Safety Check:** Before using the tent, recheck the tent's anchoring, inflation status, and the surrounding environment to ensure there are no safety hazards.
2. **Entering the Tent:** Once safety is confirmed, you can enter the tent, place your belongings, and enjoy your outdoor time.
3. **Weather Awareness:** During use, keep an eye on weather changes. In case of strong winds, heavy rain, or other severe weather conditions, promptly take reinforcement measures or remove the tent.

5. Storing the Tent

① **Turn Off the Air Pump:** Turn off the air pump and unplug it from the power source.



② **Deflating the Tent:** Before storing the tent, open the deflation valve to release all the air from inside the tent completely.



③ **Folding the Tent:** Following the instructions in the manual, fold the tent

into the specified shape and try to keep it as flat as possible.
After the tent has completely softened and laid flat, begin folding from one corner of the tent.



Fold the tent neatly, similar to folding a blanket, typically requiring two folds to complete.



Note: While folding, try to squeeze out as much air as possible from inside the tent to make it flatter.

Secure the folded tent with straps or ropes to prevent it from coming loose during transportation or storage.



Note: Pack the folded tent and all accompanying parts (such as the air pump, repair tools, etc.) into the bag together.

Storing the Tent: Store the folded tent in a dry, ventilated area to prevent dampness and mold.

6. Maintenance and Care

1. Regularly inspect the tent's inflation ports, connections, and other components to ensure they are undamaged and secure.
2. If any damage or air leaks are found, repair them promptly.
3. Clean the air pump regularly to prevent dust and debris from entering the pump and affecting its performance.

7. Safety Tips

1. When setting up and using the inflatable tent, adhere to relevant safety regulations to ensure personal safety.
2. Smoking and open flames are prohibited inside the inflatable tent.
